AGAINST THE SENIORITY LIST OF INSPETOR FOR
THE YEAR 2015 WAS REJECTED.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Brief facts of the case are following:-

1. That, the appellant was appointed as Inspector Cooperative Department after passing written test and interview vide respondent No.2 order No.3595-3631/RCS/KC/E-5 dated 02.06.1985 and he started his 15 month training in the office of Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies Abbottabad . **(Copy of Registrar order No.3595-3631/RCS/KC/E-5 is attached as Annexure "A")**

2. That, after completion of 15 months mandatory training which included seven months class training the appellant was posted as Inspector cooperative societies at Kohistan vide respondent No.2 letter No.8261-8321/RCS/E-5 (A) dated 10.11.1986 **(Copy of registrar order No. 8261-8321/RCS/E-5 (A) attached as Annexure "B")**

3. That, appellant alongwith respondents No.3-6 appeared in examination in the session 1985-86 after completion of seven months class trainings at Govt Cooperative Training Collage, Peshawar but appellant alongwith respondents 3-6 could not get

through the exams. ***(Copy of result card session 1985-86 is attached as Annexure "C")***

4. That, the appellant alongwith respondents 3-6 reappeared in the said examination in 1988 and appellant alongwith respondent No.6 passed the examination but respondent 3-6 once again failed respondent No.6 passed the exam in a lower grade than the appellant ***(Copy of result card session 1988 is attached as Annexure "D")***

5. That, the respondent No. 3-6 finally got through the exams in the year 1991 three years after the appellant.. ***(Copy of result sheet 1991 is attached as Annexure "E")***

6. That, according to appointment letter the criteria of seniority was according to standings in the result of prescribe examination as mentioned at the SL No.8 of appointment letter. Text is given below.

" Their seniority inter see shall be based on merit as a result of examination after the inspector's training class which they will attend". (Copy of appointment letter already attached Para No 2 as Annexure "B")

7. That, the inspite of clear cut criteria for seniority the appellant is always declared / considered junior to respondent No. 3-6 as evident from the current sonority list which is clear violation of the terms and conditions of service of the appellant as well as the rules. *(Copy of seniority list is attached as Annexure "F")*

8. That, the appellant preferred so many appeals to the Respondent No.2 as well as to the Secretary to the Govt of KPK Agriculture Department but Respondent No 2 has rejected the appeals but Respondent No 1 gave no answers and recently against the seniority list of 2015 appellant submitted an appeal before respondent No.2 which was turned down by the respondent No.2. *(Copy of appeals and decisions are attached as Annexure "G")*.

9. That, decision of respondent No.2 is illegal, void and liable to be quashed inter-alia, on the following:-

GROUND:-

- a. That, inspite of a very clear criteria for making seniority list i.e (the standings in the result) after class training the respondent No.2 deliberating

violated the law and placed the appellant junior to respondent No. 3-6..

- b. That, according to the provision of Civil Servant Act the services of civil servant may be dispensed with if he fails to pass prescribed examination but instead of taking disciplinary action against the respondent 3-6 they were placed senior to the appellate which is against violation of substantive law.
- c. That, although respondent No 6 passed the exams alongwith appellant in 1988 but his date of arrival was later than the arrival of appellant and he passed the exams at a junior level / grade so he may not be placed senior to the appellant.
- d. That, according to prevailing law of that time seniority list can only be prepared according to criteria of the order of passing exams and not on the basis of date of arrival so the act of the respondent No.2 is against the law.

PRAYER:-

It is therefore requested that by accepting the instant appeal the respondent may graciously be ordered to place the appellant senior to respondent No. 3-6

(3) There shall be no confirmation against any temporary post.

(4) A civil servant who, during the period of his service, was eligible to be confirmed in any service or against any post retires from service before being confirmed shall not, merely by reason of such retirement, be refused confirmation in such service or post or any benefits accruing therefrom.

(5) Confirmation of a civil servant in a service or post shall take effect from the date of occurrence of permanent vacancy in that service or post or from the date of continuous officiation, in such service or post, whichever is later.

8. Seniority:- (1) For proper administration of a service, cadre or {post}¹, the appointing authority shall cause a seniority list of the members for the time being of such service, cadre or {post}¹ to be prepared, but nothing herein contained shall be construed to confer any vested right to a particular seniority in such service, cadre or {post}¹ as the case may be.

(2) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (1), the seniority of a civil servant shall be reckoned in relation to other civil servants belonging to the same service or {cadre}², whether serving in the same department or office or not, as may be prescribed.

(3) Seniority on initial appointment to a service, [cadre]³ or post shall be determined as may be prescribed.

⁴["(4) Seniority in a post, service or cadre to which a civil servant is promoted shall take effect from the date of regular appointment to that post:

Provided that civil servants who are selected for promotion to a higher post in one batch shall, on their promotion to the higher post, retain their inter-se-seniority as in the lower post."]

1["(5) The seniority lists prepared under sub-section (1), shall be revised and notified in the official gazette at least once in a calendar year, preferably in the month of January"].

9. **Promotion.**- (1) A civil servant possessing such minimum qualifications as may be prescribed shall be eligible for promotion to a [higher]² post for the time being reserved under the rule for departmental promotion in []³ the service or cadre to which he belongs.

(2) A post referred to in sub-section (1) may either be a selection post or a non selection post to which promotion shall be made as may be prescribed-

- (a) in the case of a selection post, on the basis of selection on merit; and
- (b) in the case of a non-selection post, on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness.

10. **Posting and Transfers.**-Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the province, in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or Local authority, or a corporation or body set up or established by any such Government:

Provided that nothing contained in this section shall apply to a civil servant recruited specifically to serve in a particular area or region;

Provided further that, where a civil servant is required to serve in a post outside his service or cadre, his terms and conditions of service as to his pay shall not be less favourable than those to which he would have been entitled if he had not been so required to serve.

11. **Termination of service.**-(1) The service of a civil servant may be terminated without notice--

- (i) During the initial or extended period of his probation:

1. Sub-section (5) of Section 8 added by NWFP Act No. 1 of 1989.
 2. The word "higher" inserted by NWFP Ordinance No. IV of 1985 Section 4.
 3. The words " the higher grade of " omitted by NWFP Ordinance No. IV of 1985 Section 4(b).

(2) If no orders have been made by the day following the completion of the initial probationary period, the period or probation shall be deemed to have been extended, and if no orders have been made by the day on which the maximum period or probation expires, the probationer shall, subject to the proviso to sub-section(3) of section 6 of the North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act, 1973, be deemed to have satisfactorily completed his period of probation.

16. **Confirmation:**-After satisfactory completion of the probationary period, a civil servant shall be confirmed; provided that he holds a substantive post, provided further that a civil servant shall not be deemed to have satisfactorily completed his period of probation, if he has failed to pass an examination, test or course or has failed to complete successfully a training prescribed within the meaning of sub-section(3) of Section 6 of the North West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act, 1973.

PART-VI

SENIORITY

17. **Seniority:**-(1) The seniority inter se of civil servants ¹(appointed to a service, cadre or post) shall be determined:-

- (a) in the case of persons appointed by initial recruitment, in accordance with the order of merit assigned by the Commission ²{or as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee;} provided that persons selected for appointment to post in an earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection; and
- (b) in the case of civil servants appointed otherwise, with reference to the date of their continuous regular appointment in the post; provided that civil servants selected for promotion to a higher post in one batch shall, on their promotion to the higher post, retain their inter se seniority as in the lower post.

Explanation.I:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post temporarily in the public interest, even though continuing later permanently in the higher post, it would not adversely effect the interest of his seniors in fixation of his seniority in the higher post.

Explanation.II:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post by superseding a senior person and subsequently that senior person is also promoted the person promoted first shall rank senior to the person promoted subsequently; provided that junior person shall not be deemed to have superseded a senior person if the case of the senior person is deferred for the time being for want of certain information or for incompleteness of record or for any other reason not attributing to his fault or demerit.

Explanation.III:- A junior person shall be deemed to have superseded a senior person only if both the junior and the senior persons were considered for the higher post and the junior person was appointed in preference to the senior person.

(2) Seniority in various cadres of civil servants appointed by initial recruitment vis-a-viz those appointed otherwise shall be determined with reference to the dates of their regular appointment to a post in that cadre; provided that if two dates are the same, the person appointed otherwise shall rank senior to the person appointed by initial recruitment.

18. **General Rules:-** In all matters not expressly provided for in these rules, civil servants shall be governed by such rules as have been or may hereafter be prescribed by Government and made applicable to them.

19. **Repeal:-** The North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1975, are hereby repealed.

PARA-WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO. 4

Preliminary objections

1. That the appellant has waived his right and his appeal is liable to be dismissed.
2. That the appellant his not come to this Hon`ble Tribunal with clean hands.
3. That the appeal in hand is incompetent and is not maintainable in its present form.
4. That the appellant has no cause of action.
5. That the appellant is stopped by his own conduct file the instant appeal.
6. That the appeal in hand is bad for mis joinder and non joinder of necessary parties.
7. That the appellant has no locus standii to file the instant appeal.
8. That the instant appeal is barred by law as well as time barred.

FACTS

1. The date of appointment mentioned by the appellant in para 1 is 02.06.1985, as per Tentative Seniority List of Inspectors (BS-11) of the Cooperative Department, working in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

annexed by the appellant with his appeal. But according to the mentioned seniority list date of entry of the appellant into the Government Service is 03.06.1985 and date of his regular appointment is 11.11.1986 on the other hand the Respondent No. 4 was appointed on 31.03.1985 and date of his regular appointment is 01.07/1986. This clearly shows that the arrival of the replying respondent is much prior to the appellant in the service.

6. In reply to para 6 it is submitted, that those who are appointed on the same date, their seniority inter se is based on merits as a result of examination, this para, therefore relates with those appointees who have been appointed on the same date with that of appellant, the replying respondent was appointed and regularized much prior to him. In this regard Rule 17(1) (a) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules 1989, is much clear which is as under:

Seniority;

(1) **The Seniority inter se of Civil Servants appointed a service, cadre or post shall be determined**

(a) **In case of persons appointed by initial recruitment in accordance with the order of the merit assigned by the commission or, as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee: provided that persons selected in earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection.**

7. In reply to para 7 it is submitted that as per seniority list annexed by the appellant the replying respondent was appointed on 31.03.1985 and dated of his regular appointment is

01.07.1986, while the appellant made his entry into the service on 03.06.1985 and date of his regular appointment is 11.11.1986. If the appellant was having any grievance regarding that he must have to agitate the same at that time. At this stage he can't be declared senior to the replying respondent.

8. In reply to para 8 it is submitted that as per available record on the file the department notified seniority lists of inspectors during the years 1994, 2002, 2005, 2006, 2008 and 2010 but no appeal was filed by the appellant, therefore appeal filed against the seniority list of 2015 is/was not maintainable in the light of precedents established by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan.

PARA-WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO. 5

Preliminary objections

1. That the appellant has waived his right and his appeal is liable to be dismissed.
2. That the appellant his not come to this Hon`ble Tribunal with clean hands.
3. That the appeal in hand is incompetent and is not maintainable in its present form.
4. That the appellant has no cause of action.
5. That the appellant is stopped by his own conduct file the instant appeal.
6. That the appeal in hand is bad for mis joinder and non joinder of necessary parties.

FACTS

1. The date of appointment mentioned by the appellant in para 1, is 02.06.1985, as per Tentative Seniority List of Inspectors (BS-11) of the Cooperative Department, working in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa annexed by the appellant with his appeal. But according to the mentioned seniority list date of entry of the appellant into the

Government Service is 03.06.1985 and date of his regular appointment is 11.11.1986, on the other hand the Respondent No. 5 was appointed on 18.12.1985 and date of his regular appointment is 01.07/1986. This clearly shows that the confirmation date of the replying respondent is much prior to the appellant in the service.

In reply to para 6 it is submitted, that those who are appointed on the same date, their seniority inter se is based on merits as a result of examination, this para, therefore it relates to those appointees who have been appointed on the same date with that of appellant, the replying respondent was regularized much prior to him. In this regard Rule 17(1) (a) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules 1989, is much clear which is as under:

Seniority;

(1) The Seniority inter se of Civil Servants appointed a service, cadre or post shall be determined

- (a) **In case of persons appointed by initial recruitment in accordance with the order of the merit assigned by the commission or, as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee: provided that persons selected in earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection.**

7. In reply to para 7 it is submitted that as per seniority list annexed by the appellant the replying respondent was regularized on 01.07.1986, while the appellant made his entry into the service on 03.06.1985 and date of his regular appointment is 11.11.1986. If the appellant was having any grievance regarding that he must

have to agitate the same at that time. At this stage he can't be declared senior to the replying respondent along with others.

8. In reply to para 8 it is submitted that as per available record on the file the department notified seniority lists of inspectors during the years 1994, 2002, 2005, 2006, 2008 and 2010 but no appeal was filed by the appellant, therefore appeal filed against the seniority list of 2015 is/was not maintainable in the light of precedents established by the Hon`ble Supreme Court of Pakistan.






