### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Clarification of Withdrawal of Request of LPR/Retirement

after Sanction/Notification.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the correspondence resting with M/o Defence(Defence Division)'s OM No.3/25/D-11(CSH0/2006 dated 01-04-2011 on the above subject and to clarify that:-

- i) After the withdrawal of Establishment Division OM No.14/2/2009-R-2 dated 25-08-1996 vide their OM No.14/2/2002-R-2 dated 14-07-2011, a Government servant may withdraw his option of voluntary retirement within the period of LPR and after retirement there is no option available to the Government servant for re-joining the duty.
- ii) An individual, who goes on 365 days LPR and after availing a part thereof, he rejoins his duty. In such cases, the period of leave availed by an individual be adjusted in the order of leave on full pay, leave on half pay and extraordinary leave (leave without pay. Later on, on attaining the age of superannuation, he again opts for 365 days LPR OR leave encashment of 180 days in lieu of 365 days LPR. Such option of an individual may be treated as a fresh case and will be allowed LPR or encashment thereof in toto.

- Para 14:- That as mentioned in para "8" above., the retirement orders of the appellant cannot be withdrawn under the rules.


#### **GROUNDS:-**

- A:- Incorrect, that retirement orders dated 30.06.2016, of the appellant was issued by the competent authority on his own option and has been notified. Hence cannot be withdraw or modified under the rules.
- B:- That there is no any rule under which the already notified retirement orders of any Governments Servant can be withdrawn, modified or set aside.
- C:- That the retirement orders of the appellant is under the rules and upon his own option, hence cannot be challenged.
- D&E:- Incorrect, that under Finance Department letter No. SOSR-III/4-92/81, dated 01.10.1981, the competent authority concerned has no power to cancel the already notified retirement orders.

- F:- That the orders of refusal of the appellant regarding withdrawal of retirement orders is under the Law and rules.
- G:- Relates to respondent No. 1.
- H:- Relates to respondent No. 1 to 5.
- I:- As mentioned in para "C" above.

Keeping in view the above mentioned facts, it is therefore, humbly prayed that the appeal in hand, having no merits, may be dismissed with cost.

### **PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:**

- 1. That the Petitioner has got no locus standi to file the present Petition. As the LPR was confirmed at the instance of the petitioner.
- 2. That the Petitioner is estopped by his own conduct to bring the constitutional Petition being a consent order.
- 3. The writ petition is pre-mature it is neither maintainable in law nor on facts.
- 4. That the Petitioner has come to the court with unclean hands. He has suppressed the material from this Honourable Court and tried to mislead the court.
- 5. That the appeal in hand is bad due to non-joinder & miss-joinder of necessary party.
- 6. That with due respect the Honourable Court lacks jurisdiction to adjudicate upon matter.

- 1. That para A,B is incorrect.
- 2. That para C is incorrect. The order is well in accordance with law.
- 3. That para D is incorrect. The petitioner applied for cancellation of his request after the decision of proper decision on his application.
- 4. That para E is incorrect as the order passed on consent cant be recalled by an authority under the law, hence, the order is well within the law.
- 5. That para F is incorrect, hence, denied.
- 6. That para G is incorrect, as the respondent decided the matter according to the wishes of the petitioner, hence, no question of violation of any law exists.
- 7. That para H is incorrect, as the cases referred to were distinguished from the case in hand.
- 8. That para I is incorrect, hence denied.
