We are therefore inclined to accept the instant appeal and modify the impugned order dated 08.05.2014 to the extent that the extra-ordinary leave without pay shall stand converted into leave of the kind due. The appeal is accepted in the above terms. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.
