At the very outset, learned Additional Advocate General pointed out that against the impugned order a joint departmental appeal was filed by Uzair Khan and Muhammad Ashfaq on 12.05.2022, while this appeal was filed before this Tribunal on 17.01.2023. The period provided in Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 for filing appeal, after filing of departmental representation, is 30 days and that too after waiting for 90 days of filing of the departmental representation but this appeal is filed on 250<sup>th</sup> day, rendering this appeal barred by time. There is no application for condonation of delay on file
