


Service Appeal No. 1554/2022 titled "Ajmal Khan versus Capital City Police Officer, Peshawar and others".

ORDER

18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 **Kalim Arshad Khan, Chairman**: Learned counsel for the appellant present and has been heard.

2. This appeal is filed against the order dated 04.06.2014 modified on 18.12.2014, against which (04.06.2014) the appellant had filed departmental appeal on 10.07.2014. The appellant has not disclosed whether that was decided or not. There is, however, a review petition filed by the appellant before the Inspector General of Police on 27.05.2022, which too was not responded as is evident from the available record. Under Section-4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974, the appellant was required to file departmental appeal within 30 days after waiting for 90 days of filing the departmental appeal but in this case the appeal has been filed on 27.10.2022 i.e. after quite long time. Though there is an application for condonation of delay, filed in this appeal but the grounds taken in the application are the alleged ailment of the appellant and his mother with no supporting documents, therefore, the application does not merit acceptance. The appeal is hopelessly barred by time, therefore, it is dismissed in limine. Costs shall fallow the events. Consign.
