> According to the appellant while controverting the impugned 2. order, he had produced all the education testimonial and the requisite training certificates within the prescribed period but those were not considered by the department and he was terminated. On the other hand, the learned Deputy District Attorney states that according to the department these certificates were not produced at the relevant point of time, that is why the impugned order was passed. As the appellant was in the possession of the documents which he had allegedly produced at this relevant time but respondents are denying their receipt, we while, disposing of this appeal, would like to direct the respondents to receive copies of the documents alongwith originals and in order to satisfy themselves get all these documents verified. After such verification, if the stance of the appellant is found correct his grievance should be considered in accordance with law and in case otherwise, an appropriate detailed order shall be passed. The exercise shall be completed within sixty days of receipt of this order. The appellant is directed to facilitate the respondents by providing all the necessary documents. Consign.
