

APPEAL U/S 4 OF SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974,

Prayer:

- (a) By accepting this appeal and setting aside the impugned seniority list dated 01-03-2013 (Annex "E") of Associate Professors (Female, BPS-19) and placing the appellant at her proper place of seniority, below Akhtar Nagina d/o Muhammad Mir (S.No.79) and above Respondent No.4.
- (b) Any other relief deemed appropriate may also be granted in addition to the relief prayed above.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH

- 1. Being qualified and eligible, the appellant was selected and appointed as Lecturer (BPS-17) on 23-01-1988. She was promoted as Assistant Professor (BPS-18) on 21-02-2004. She was then granted promotion to (BPS-19) as Associate Professor on 26-05-2010. (Copy annexed hereto marked "A").
- 2. That the posts of Associate Professors (B-19) were lying vacant since 2009, as evident from the notification No. SO (COLLEGES) XI-11/2009, dated 09-06-2009. (Copy annexed hereto marked "B").

The Directorate of Higher Education through letter dated 07-11-2009, requisition the total strength / number of vacancies available with the Higher Education Department for promotion of Assistant Professors (BPS-18) to the post of Associate Professors (BPS-19). Resultantly, on the basis of the availability of strength, working paper for Provincial Selection Board was prepared. (Copies annexed hereto marked "C" & "C1").

- 3. The appellant was lawfully entitled to be promoted as Associate Professor (BPS-19) since the date of the availability of substantive vacancy i.e., 09-06-2009. She was however promoted vide notification dated 26-05-2010 with immediate effect against the 80% quota reserved for the promotions to the post of Associate Professors (BPS-19) in accordance with the service rules notified vide No. SO (AO) HE/XIII-1/06/SSRC dated 17-03-2011. (Copy annexed hereto marked "D").
- 4. That the higher Education Department advertised posts of Associate Professors (BPS-19), vide advertisement No. 07/2009 (S.No. 28) through Public Service Commission. Resultantly respondents' No. 04 to 21 were selected and appointed as Associate Professors. (Copies are annexed hereto marked "E").
- 5. The respondent department issued final seniority list dated 01-03-2013 of Associate Professors (BPS-19) (Female College Teachers) as it stood on 31-10-2012 (Copy annexed "F"). That prior to the impugned seniority list, a final seniority list of Associate Professors (BPS-19) was issued and circulated vide notification number SO(FC)HE/4-1/06 dated 15-10-2010 (Copy annexed "J"). That Akhtar Nagina was placed at S.No.96 of the said seniority list and the Associate Professors promoted along with the appellant were placed right below her. The department has placed the Respondents No.4 to 21 between Mst Akhtar Nageena S.No.96 and the appellants' batch with malafide intent without prior notice and showing any sufficient cause and in complete violation of the seniority rules detailed in Section 17 of "The North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989.

The appellant was arbitrarily placed below the respondents' No. 04 to 21, at serial No. 114, in complete violation of rules, without issuing prior notice or showing any valid cause or reason.

6. That immediately after having the knowledge about the impugned seniority list, the appellant submitted her departmental appeal dated 15-03-2013, requesting the authority to grant her seniority at her proper place. (Copy annexed hereto **marked "G"**).

The appellant's departmental appeal was regretted vide impugned order dated 15-04-2013. (Copy annexed hereto **marked "H"**).

Feeling aggrieved and finding no other remedy, the appellant has been constrained to approach the Hon'ble Service Tribunal for the redress of her grievance, respectfully granting her the seniority at her proper place, above all the respondents No.4 to 21, inter-alia, for the following.

Grounds;

- (a) The respondent department has acted in haste full and arbitrary manner while issuing the impugned seniority list dated 01-03-2013. The appellant being promoted as Associate Professor (B-19) on 26-05-2010 was lawfully entitled to be placed above all those who were appointed directly through Public Service Commission.
- (b) The respondent No.4 was appointed through initial recruitment in BPS-19 on 17-9-2010 after the promotion of the petitioner i.e. 26-05-2010. Similarly rests of the respondents were initially recruited on different dates in the year 2011, as evident from the impugned seniority list. (Annex "G").

The petitioner being promoted prior to the selection of the respondents was required to be placed senior to them in the impugned seniority list, under the law and rules regulating the service.

(c) The appellant was entitled to be promoted w.e.f the date of availability of vacant post i.e. 07-11-2009 (Annex "B"). The superior courts had laid down the dictum in 1985 SCMR 1158, 1988 SCMR 88, PLD 1993 SC 10, 1993 SCMR 2258 and 1994 SCMR 1957, that the promotees shall be considered for promotion from the date when vacancies in their quota became available and there after a joint seniority list of officer directly recruited and those promoted shall be issued according to the rules. The department has failed to follow the instructions issued by the Supreme Court regarding the matter in question.

The Supreme Court has further held in 1990 SCMR 1623 that, the question whether promotees could be considered and appointed on a promotion post from the date when the vacancies occurred <u>was final and binding and not open to questioning</u>.

(d) The Supreme Court of Pakistan vide its decision reported in PLD 1990 SC 447 has held, that amongst appointees of same year, irrespective of the fact whether it is against substantive vacancy or temporary, the promotee has been given preference over the direct recruits.

The respondent department in order to accommodate some blue eyed officials has completely over looked the law and rules' regarding the fixation of seniority of promotees and directly recruited officials, which is subject to correction by this Hon'ble Tribunal.

- (e) The appellant was promoted against the 80% quota reserved for promotion of Assistant Professor (B-18) to the post of Associate Professor (B-19) in view of the service rules (Annex "D"). The appellant was entitled and to be placed senior to the Associate Professor (B-19) appointed by initial recruitment, however she was denied of her legal right.
- (f) The appellant has served the department honestly and diligently during her entire period of service to the utmost satisfaction of her superiors at different places of postings. Neither any adverse remarks have ever been communicated to her, nor were any disciplinary proceedings initiated against her. The appellant has a clean and continuous service record till date.
- (g) The impugned omission on the part of respondent department is arbitrary, discriminatory against the principle of equity, justice and proprietary, which requires immediate attention and interference by this Hon'ble Tribunal.

In view of the above, it is requested that by accepting this service appeal, the appellant may be granted her seniority by placing at her proper place of seniority w.e.f the date of her promotion as Associate Professor (BPS-19), 26-05-2010, below Akhtar Nagina (S.No.79) and above Respondent No.4.

Any other relief deemed appropriate may also be granted in addition to the relief prayed above.

FINAL SENIORITY LIST OF ASSOCIATE PROFESSORS BPS 19 (FEMALE) ISSUED ON 1-3-2013

With due respect and humble submission I beg to lay down the following few lines as a representation/objections against the subject sited final seniority list issued by the Higher Education Department vide SO(C-1/HE/1-12/13/S.list B-19(F) dated 1-3-2013.

- A. That in accordance with the provision of the Khyber Pakhtunkhawa Higher Education Archives and Libraries Department Service Rules as Notified vide No. SO (Colleges)XI-II/2000 dated, 10.1.2002, 80% posts of Associate Professor B-19 are reserved for promotion from amongst the Assistant Professors B-18 while 20% of the posts are allocated to the initial recruitment quota.
- B. That while the cases of Promotion were processed through the Provincial Selection Board during the year 2009 simultaneously a requisition for initial recruitment was sent to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission to meet the requirement of the Service Rules.
- C. That while the Provincial Selection Board considered the cases of forty four Assistant Professors for promotion against 80 % quota, the Public Service Commission advertised thirty seven posts of Associate Professors B-19 in different subjects vide their advertisement No.07/2009 against 20% quota for initial recruitment.
- D. That the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhawa Higher Education Department on the recommendations of Provincial Selection Board notified the promotion of forty four Associate Professors on regular basis vide Notification No. SO (FC) HE/4-1/09/ Promotees BS-18-19 dated, 26th May 2010.
- E. That in the tentative seniority list Associate Professors BPS-19 (female) corrected upto 31th August, 2012 the appellant was placed on serial No.______ senior to the initial selectees against the post of Associate Professors. The appellant was amazed and astonished to note that in the final seniority list of Associate Professors B-19 as stood on 31th December, 2012 and notified vide No. SO(C-1)HE/1-12/13/S.listB-19(F) dated 1-3-2013 where in all the initial selectees of Associate Professors have been placed senior to the promotees and as a consequence the appellant has been relegated to seniority No.
- F. That the appellant is at last to understand that which yardstick has been applied by the Department in placing the promotees junior to the initial recruits. That in accordance with the procedure in vogue in Federal Government and the Provincial Government the share,

(RUE COP)

of initial recruits and promotees are worked out in accordance with the provision of the less. The vacancies falling to the share of initial recruits are referred to the Public Service mmission through proper requisition while the cases of promotees are processed through the Department and the Provincial Selection Board.

- G. That the cases of promotees were finalized by PSB on 9-3-2010 while the Public Service Commission sent their recommendation in bits and pieces subject to communication of their final seniority list subsequently.
- H. That a perusal of the seniority list will reveal that certain Associate Professors though appointed earlier yet in the overall seniority of initial recruits stood junior.
- 1. That in order to protect the seniority rights of the promotees as well as initial selectees govt. issued proper rules where in it has been clearly mentioned that the vacancies of initial recruits and promotees in a calendar year will be calculated in accordance with their share and the promotees will rank senior to the initial recruits.
- That since these vacancies occurred during the year 2009 and the cases were processed accordingly, the promotees as a class will stand senior to the entire batch of the initial recruits irrespective of their joining the post which is quite immaterial and irrelevant.
- K. That the entire exercise of placing the promotees junior to the initial recruits is motivated with the consideration to extend undue and unreasonable favour to the direct recruits in the likely promotions of B-20 in the four tier formula expected soon. Therefore, it will be just, fair and equitable that future promotions to B-20 against the post of Professors in the case of female cadre may be kept pending till the decision is taken on our seniority case as a class.

In view of the foregoing it is requested that the final seniority list may kindly be corrected by placing the promotees senior to the initial recruits as a batch.

PARA WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE RESPONDENTS NO 5, 6, 12 to 15, 17, 19, 21

Respectfully Sheweth:-

Preliminary Objections:-

- 1. That the Appellant has no locus standi to file the Appeal in hand.
- 2. That the appeal in hand is not maintainable.
- 3. That the appellant on her promotion issued vide notification dated 26.5.2010 never agitated for ante-dation of her promotion nor objected on it or made any representation against it, thus she has waived her right and thus estopped by her conduct to question the final seniority list at this stage.
- 4. That the appeal in hand is hopelessly barred by time, when time is calculated from the notification dated 26.5.2010.
- 5. That in accordance with section 8 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 read with Rule 17 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointments, Promotions & Transfer) Rules, 1989 " The Inter-se-Seniority of the Civil Servants appointed to a service, cadre or post shall be determined:- (a) In the case of persons appointed by initial recruitment, in accordance with the order of merit assigned by the Commission, thus the replying respondents are senior to the appellant in all respects.

- 6. That initiation of promotion / appointment process always takes time and it can under no circumstances be claimed promotion from the date when the post was available, the same principle is equally applicable to the case of the replying respondents.
- 7. That the replying respondents having been recommended for appointment prior in time similarly were issued appointment on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission prior in time would be considered senior, any appointment order issued later in time to the appellant was on account of the Govt and it was not the fault of the replying respondents since they belong to same batch their seniority would be determined in the order of merit and would rank senior to the appellant.

ON FACTS.

- 1. Contents of Para 1 need no reply. It is however added that the appellant felt herself satisfied with the promotion and never asked for ante-dation of her promotion.
- 2. Contents of Para 2 and misleading and incorrect. It may be submitted that the 4-tier formula of the College Teachers was upgraded vide Notification dated 09.06.2009 and the total number of new posts of (BPS-19) was raised from 379 to 420. It is however added that the requisition for appointment to the Public Service Commission was sent much prior, similarly the vacant posts were available for the direct recruit.
- 3. Contents of Para 3 and misleading and incorrect. The Appellant was not entitled to promotion to the post of Associate Professor (BPS-19) wef 09.06.2009, the date from which the 4-tier formula has been upgraded. Promotion to these new posts was to be made in the prescribed manner as provided in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989. The process of placing the promotion cases before Provincial Selection Board is time consuming job and the regular promotion could be made only in consultation with the Provincial Selection Board, and after the approval of the Competent Authority. It is only therefore that the Notification of Promotion is issued with prospective / immediate effect. The Appellant has rightly been promoted wef on 26.05.2010.
- 4. Contents of Para 4 need no reply.
- 5. Contents of Para 5 and misleading. The Final Seniority List of Associate Professors (BPS-19) has been issued on 01.03.2013 as it stood on 31.10.2012. However, it is stated that no Final Seniority List as alleged has been issued on 05.10.2010.

Furthermore, no Final Seniority List can be issued without prior approval of the Establishment Department. The Final Seniority List issued on 01.03.2013 according to Law / Rules and without any irregularity. Thus no malafide is reflected at all. selectees of the Public Service Commission have been placed from S No 80 to 98 of the Seniority List as it stood on 31.10.2012. The selectees of the Public Service Commission have arrived and appointed vide various Notification ie M/S Ghazal Kiran Awan vide Notification No SO (FC)HE/3-2/Recruitment of F Association Professor dated 22.01.2010, M/S Imrana Ghafoor and Seema Gul vide Notification No SO (FC)HE/3-9/Recruitment of Associate Professor 01.04.2010, M/S Tasneem Tahman, M/S Salma Ghani, Bushra Fatima and M/S Rozeena Rahman SO (FC) HE / 3-9 / Recruitment of Associate Professor dated 17.05.2010 and other selectees vide Notification No SO (FC)HE/3-9/Recruitment of Associate Professor dated 18.08.2010, No SO (FC)HE/3-10/Recruitment of F Association Professor dated 22-01-211, No SO (FC)HE/3-9/Recruitment of F Association Professor 28.05.2011, No SO (FC)HE/3-9/Recruitment Associate Professor dated 21.06.2011, No SO (FC)HE/3-10/Recruitment of Associate Professor dated 20.01.2010 and No SO (FC)HE/3-10/Recruitment of Associate Professor dated 29.01.2011. The revised Inter-se-Merit of the Female Associate Professors (BPS-19) in various subjects was furnished on 28.06.2012 vide letter No SR-VII-No 03479, dated 02.07.2012. It is pertinent to be mentioned that M/S Ghazala Kiran Awan, M/S Imrana Gahafoor and Seema Gul, M/S Tasneem Rahman, M/S Salma Ghani, Bushra Fatima and M/S Rozeena Rahman have been appointed earlier than the other selectees and promotes, but they have been placed at S No 5, 10, 12, 15. 17. 19 and 20 of the Inter-se-Seniority List furnished by the Public Service Commission. Accordingly the names of the selectee Associate Professors (BPS-19) have been correctly placed / inserted at S No 80 below Akhtar Nagina at S No. 79 of the Seniority List, which is in accordance with the spirit of Rule 17 (I) (a) Part-VI and Explanation-III Para (2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989. Thus the seniority list so finalized is in accordance with law and rule governing seniority.

6. Contents of Para 6 misleading and incorrect, the appeal is false, based on concealment of facts hence denied. It may be submitted that the Directorate of Higher Education letter No 8104-28 dated 15.04.2013 was substituted by another letter vide letter No 9042-66, dated 25.04.2013, whereby the appellant has been informed that her appeal regarding Seniority list has been sent to the Provincial Govt for necessary action.

GROUNDS OF APPEAL: -

The grounds taken in Writ Petition are legal and in view of the above narrated facts will be replied at the time of arguments.

- a. Contents incorrect. The Seniority List issued on 01.03.2013 is in line with the provision of Explanation-III Para (2) of Rule 17 Part-IV of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989 and the appellant does not have any edge over the Respondents who have been recruited / selected directly.
- b. Contents incorrect. The Respondent No 4 and others have been recruited on the recommendation of the Public Service Commission in response to advertisement No 07/2009 and Inter-se-Seniority List of the recruited Associate Professors Supra has been furnished by the Public Service Commission as explained in Para 5 above. Consequently, Respondents No 4 to 21 have been appointed by initial recruitment on different dates prior to the promotion of the appellant. The Inter-se-Seniority List of the recruited / selected Associate Professors has been correctly maintained in accordance with the provision of sub Rule 17 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989. No exception could be taken against the seniority list maintained in this Department. further be submitted that the Inter-se-Seniority List prepare by the Public Service Commission cannot be disturbed under the Rule.
- c. Contents incorrect. The promotion always take effect from the date of promotion, ante dation can only be claimed if the civil servant is deferred for promotion at any stage, which is not the case in hand, thus the appellant has rightly been placed in the seniority list. The judgment so referred have no application to the case in hand.
- d. Contents incorrect. The Judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan is distinguished from the case of the appellant and is not attracted to the case in hand. The judgment of the apex Court in respect of Federal Civil Servants and it has relief upon the rule 6 of the Civil Servants (Seniority) Rules, 1993, however in this province section 8 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 read with rule 17 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointments, Promotions & Transfer) Rules, 1989

govern the principles of seniority, thus the judgment so referred is not attracted to the case in hand.

- e. Contents incorrect, hence denied. As explained in reply to Ground D above.
- f. Contents vague and misleading. The same is the case of the replying respondents, however it is stated with respect that seniority is governed under the law and rules and not upon performance.
- g. Contents misleading and incorrect. The replying respondents were allowed seniority in accordance with law.

It is therefore prayed that on acceptance of this para-wise comments the appeal in hand be dismissed with costs.

REPLY TO APPLICATION

Preliminary Objections:

- A. That the Petitioner has got no cause of action.
- B. That the relief asked in this application is in fact the main relief prayed in the appeal, and allowing the relief at this stage will amount to decision of the case before its trial.
- C. That the staying the promotion process without there being any such initiation of the process is uncalled for and the application in hand is thus pre-mature.
- D. That the necessary ingredient for the grant of interim relief is lacking in the instant case, hence the application is liable to summary rejection.

ON FACTS: -

- 1. Contents of Para 1 is Correct.
- 2. Contents of Para 2 The Comments of accompanying Para-wise Comments may kindly be read as part and parcel of this reply.
- 3. Contents of Para 3 Incorrect and misleading. The Respondents No 4 to 21 have been correctly placed senior to the Appellants in view of Rules 17 (I) (a) Part-IV and Explanation-III Para (2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989. Hence the Appellants have no Prima facie case.

- 4. Contents of Para 3 Incorrect and misleading. The Respondent No 20 Mst Ghazala Kiran has been promoted vide Notification dated 22.01.2010 whereas, Respondents No 18 & 21 have been promoted vide Notification dated 01.04.2010, Respondents No 8, 13. 15 and 17 have been appointed vide Notification dated 17.05.2010. It may further be submitted that the revised Inter Se Merit of the Respondents Female Associate Professors have been furnished by the Public Service Commission on 02.07.2012. It is pertinent to be mentioned that M/S Ghazala Kiran Awan, M/S Imrana Ghafoor and Seema Gul, M/S Tasneem Rahman, M/S Salma Ghani, Bushra Fatima and M/S Rozeena Rahman have been appointed earlier than the other selectees and promotes, but they have been placed at S No 5, 10, 12, 15. 17. 19 and 20 of the Interse-Seniority List furnished by the Public Service Commission. THE NORTH-WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE CIVIL SERVANTS (APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION & TRANSFER) RULES, 1989.

PART-I

GENERAL

1. Short title and commencement: - (1) These rules may be called the North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

Definitions:-(1) in these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- (a) "Appointing Authority" in relation to a post, means the persons authorized under rule 4 to make appointment to that post;
- (b) "Basic Pay Scale" means the Basic Pay Scale for the time being sanctioned by Government, in which a post or a group of posts is placed;
- (c) "Commission" means the North West Frontier Province Public Service Commission;
- ²⁹(d) "Departmental Promotion Committee" means a committee constituted for making selection for promotion or transfer to such posts under a Department, or offices of Government, which do not fall within the purview of the Provincial Selection Board;
- 30 (dd)"Departmental Selection Board" means a Board constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial recruitment /appointment to posts under a Department or office of Government in Basic Pay Scale 17 not falling within the purview of the Commission:

Provided that more than one such committees may be constituted for civil servants holding different scales of pay".

- (e) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a committee constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial appointment to posts under a department, or office of Government [in Basic Pay Scale 17 and below not falling within the purview of the Commission];
- (f) "Post" means a post sanctioned in connection with the affairs of the Province, but not allocated to all Pakistan Unified Grades; and
- ³¹(g) "Provincial Selection Board" means the Board constituted by Government for the purpose of selection of civil servants for promotion or transfer to posts in respect

whereof the appointing authority under rule 4 is the Chief Minister and shall consist of such persons as may be appointed to it by Government from time to time.

- (2) Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them in the North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act,1973(N.W.F.P act XVIII of 1973) or any other statutory order or rules of Government for the time being in force.
- 3. Method of Appointment:- (1) Appointment to posts shall be made by any of the following methods, namely:-
 - (a) by promotion or transfer in accordance with the provisions contained in Part-I of these rules; and
 - (b) by initial recruitment in accordance with the provisions contained in Part-III of these rules.
 - (2) The method of appointment, qualifications and other conditions applicable to a post shall be such as laid down by the Department concerned in consultation with the Services and General Administration Department and the Finance Department.
- 4. Appointing Authority:- The authorities competent to make appointment to posts it various basic pay scales shall be as follows:-

Posts S.No. Appointing Authority Chief Minister (a) Posts in Basic Pay Scale 18 and above including posts in Basic Pay Scale 17 borne on any of the following services; (i) Former Provincial Civil Service (Executive Branch); (ii) Former Provincial Civil Service (Judicial Branch); (iii)Provincial Civil Secretariat Service. Posts in Basic Pay Scale 17 (b) Chief Secretary other than those covered by(a) Posts in Basic Pay Scale 16. 2. In the case of Secretariat of the Government of NWFP, the Chief Secretary. (b) In case of High Court, the Chief Justice; and In the case of Attached Department:

Substituted by Notification No. SOR-I(S&GAD)4-1/75/Vol-I, dated 22-08-1991.

/5. <u>Probation.</u> ---- (1) Persons appointed to posts by initial recruitment, promotion or ransfer shall be on probation for a period of one year.

- (2) The appointing authority, if considers necessary, may extend the probation period for one year as may be specified at the time of appointment.
- (3) On the successful completion of probation period, the appointing authority shall, by specific order, terminate the probation:

Provided that if no specific order is issued on the expiry of the first year of probation period, the period of probation shall be deemed to have been extended under sub-rule (2):

Provided further that if no specific order is issued on the expiry of the extended period of probation, the period of probation shall be deemed to have been successfully completed.

16. Confirmation:-After satisfactory completion of the probationary period, a civil servant shall be confirmed; provided that he holds a substantive post, provided further that a civil servant shall not be deemed to have satisfactorily completed his period of probation, if he has failed to pass an examination, test or course or has failed to complete successfully a training prescribed within the meaning of sub-section (3) of Section 6 of the North West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act, 1973.

PART-V

SENIORITY

- 17. Seniority:-(1) the seniority inter se of civil servants ⁵⁵(appointed to a service, cadre or post) shall be determined:
 - in the case of persons appointed by initial recruitment, in accordance with the order of merit assigned by the Commission ⁵⁶[or as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee;] provided that persons selected for appointment to post in an earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection; and
 - (b) in the case of civil servants appointed otherwise, with reference to the date of their continuous regular appointment in the post; provided that civil servants selected for promotion to a higher post in one batch shall, on their promotion to the higher post, retain their inter se seniority as in the lower post.

Explanation-I:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post temporarily in the public interest, even though continuing later permanently in the higher

post, it would not adversely effect the interest of his seniors in fixation of his seniority in the higher post.

Explanation-II:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post by superseding a senior person and subsequently that senior person is also promoted the person promoted first shall rank senior to the person promoted subsequently; provided that junior person shall not be deemed to have superseded a senior person if the case of the senior person is deferred for the time being for want of certain information or for incomplete record or for any other reason not attributing to his fault or demerit.


Explanation-III:- A junior person shall be deemed to have superseded a senior person only if both the junior and the senior persons were considered for the higher post and the junior person was appointed in preference to the senior person.

- (2) Seniority in various cadres of civil servants appointed by initial recruitment vis-à-vis those appointed otherwise shall be determined with reference to the dates of their regular appointment to a post in that cadre; provided that if two dates are the same, the person appointed otherwise shall rank senior to the person appointed by initial recruitment.
- ⁵⁷(3) In the event of merger/restructuring of the Departments, Attached Departments or Subordinate Offices, the inter se seniority of civil servants affected by the merger/restructuring as aforesaid shall be determined in accordance with the date of their regular appointment to a cadre or post.
- The inter-se-seniority of civil servants in a certain cadre to which promotion is made from different lower posts, carrying the same pay scale shall be determined from the date of regular appointment/promotion of the civil servants in the lower post.

Provided that if the date of regular appointment of two or more civil servants in the lower post is the same, the civil servant older in age, shall be treated senior.

- 18. General Rules: In all matters not expressly provided for in these rules, civil servants shall be governed by such rules as have been or may hereafter be prescribed by Government and made applicable to them.
- 19. Repeal:- The North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1975, are hereby repealed.

PART-V

- /5. <u>Probation.</u> ---- (1) Persons appointed to posts by initial recruitment, promotion or ransfer shall be on probation for a period of one year.
- (2) The appointing authority, if considers necessary, may extend the probation period for one year as may be specified at the time of appointment.
- (3) On the successful completion of probation period, the appointing authority shall, by specific order, terminate the probation:

Provided that if no specific order is issued on the expiry of the first year of probation period, the period of probation shall be deemed to have been extended under sub-rule (2):

Provided further that if no specific order is issued on the expiry of the extended period of probation, the period of probation shall be deemed to have been successfully completed.

16. Confirmation:-After satisfactory completion of the probationary period, a civil servant shall be confirmed; provided that he holds a substantive post, provided further that a civil servant shall not be deemed to have satisfactorily completed his period of probation, if he has failed to pass an examination, test or course or has failed to complete successfully a training prescribed within the meaning of sub-section (3) of Section 6 of the North West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act, 1973.

SENIORITY

- 17. Semiority:-(1) the seniority inter se of civil servants ⁵⁵(appointed to a service, cadre or post) shall be determined:
 - in the case of persons appointed by initial recruitment, in accordance with the order of merit assigned by the Commission ⁵⁶[or as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee;] provided that persons selected for appointment to post in an earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection; and
 - (b) in the case of civil servants appointed otherwise, with reference to the date of their continuous regular appointment in the post; provided that civil servants selected for promotion to a higher post in one batch shall, on their promotion to the higher post, retain their inter se seniority as in the lower post.

Explanation-I:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post temporarily in the public interest, even though continuing large permanently in the higher

post, it would not adversely effect the interest of his seniors in fixation of his seniority in the higher post.

Explanation-II:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post by superseding a senior person and subsequently that senior person is also promoted the person promoted first shall rank senior to the person promoted subsequently; provided that junior person shall not be deemed to have superseded a senior person if the case of the senior person is deferred for the time being for want of certain information or for incomplete record or for any other reason not attributing to his fault or demerit.

Explanation-III:- A junior person shall be deemed to have superseded a senior person only if both the junior and the senior persons were considered for the higher post and the junior person was appointed in preference to the senior person.

- (2) Seniority in various cadres of civil servants appointed by initial recruitment vis-à-vis those appointed otherwise shall be determined with reference to the dates of their regular appointment to a post in that cadre; provided that if two dates are the same, the person appointed otherwise shall rank senior to the person appointed by initial recruitment.
- ⁵⁷(3) In the event of merger/restructuring of the Departments, Attached Departments or Subordinate Offices, the inter se seniority of civil servants affected by the merger/restructuring as aforesaid shall be determined in accordance with the date of their regular appointment to a cadre or post.
- The inter-se-seniority of civil servants in a certain cadre to which promotion is made from different lower posts, carrying the same pay scale shall be determined from the date of regular appointment/promotion of the civil servants in the lower post.



- 18. General Rules: In all matters not expressly provided for in these rules, civils servants shall be governed by such rules as have been or may hereafter be prescribed by Government and made applicable to them.

- 1. Correct.
- 2. The Comments of accompanying Para-wise Comments may kindly be read as part and parcel of this Reply.
- 3. Incorrect. The Respondents No. 4 to 21 have been correctly placed senior to the Appellants in view of Rule 17(I)(a) Part-VI and Explanation-III Para (2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989 (Annex-A). Hence the Appellant have no Prima Facie case.
- 4. Incorrect. The Respondent No. 20 Mst. Ghazala Kiran has been promoted vide Notification dated 22-01-2010 (Annex-B) whereas, Respondents No. 18 & 21 have been promoted vide Notification dated 01-04-2010 (Annex-C), Respondents No. 8, 13, 15 and 17 have been appointed vide Notification dated 17-05-2010 (Annex-D). It may further be submitted that the revised Inter Se Merit of the Respondents Female Associate Professors have been furnished by the Public Service Commission on 02-07-2012 (Annex-E). It is pertinent to be mentioned that M/S Ghazala Kiran Awan, M/S Imrana Ghafoor and Seema Gul, M/S Tasneem Rahman, M/S Salma Ghani, Bushra Fatima and M/S Rozeena Rahman have been appointed earlier than the other selectees and promotees, but they have been placed at S.No. 5, 10, 12, 15, 17, 19, and 20 of the Inter Se Seniority List furnished by the Public Service Commission. Accordingly the names of the selectees Associate Professors (BPS-19) have been correctly placed/inserted at S. No. 80 below Akhtar Nagina at S. Respectfully Sheweth: -

- 1. Correct.
- 2. The Comments of accompanying Para-wise Comments may kindly be read as part and parcel of this Reply.
- 3. Incorrect. The Respondents No. 4 to 21 have been correctly placed senior to the Appellants in view of Rule 17(I)(a) Part-VI and Explanation-III Para (2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989 (Annex-A). Hence the Appellant have no Prima Facie case.
- 4. Incorrect. The Respondent No. 20 Mst. Ghazala Kiran has been promoted vide Notification dated 22-01-2010 (Annex-B) whereas, Respondents No. 18 & 21 have been promoted vide Notification dated 01-04-2010 (Annex-C), Respondents No. 8, 13, 15 and 17 have been appointed vide Notification dated 17-05-2010 (Annex-D). It may further be submitted that the revised Inter Se Merit of the Respondents Female Associate Professors have been furnished by the Public Service Commission on 02-07-2012 (Annex-E). It is pertinent to be mentioned that M/S Ghazala Kiran Awan, M/S Imrana Ghafoor and Seema Gul, M/S Tasneem Rahman, M/S Salma Ghani, Bushra Fatima and M/S Rozeena Rahman have been appointed earlier than the other selectees and promotees, but they have been placed at S.No. 5, 10, 12, 15, 17, 19, and 20 of the Inter Se Seniority List furnished by the Public Service Commission. Accordingly the names of the selectees Associate Professors (BPS-19) have been correctly placed/inserted at S. No. 80 below Akhtar Nagina at S. No. 79 of the Seniority List, hence the Seniority of the Selectee has come in the aforesaid block, which cannot be disturbed. The Inter Se Seniority List furnished by Public Service Commission is to be kept intact and cannot be disturbed under Rule 17(I)(a) Part-VI and Explanation-III Para (2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989 (Annex-A) supra.
- 5. Incorrect, hence denied.



The Appellant have not raised the question of balance of convenience in their applications, which is one of the 03 pre-requisites for maintaining an application for status quo, hence the Application in hand is not maintainable and cannot be granted under the law.

Prayer: -

Annex-A. [PP3-6

Section 5 of Civil Servants Act, 1973 - Appointment to a civil service of the Province or to a civil post in connection with the affairs of the Province shall be made in the prescribed manner by the Governor or by a person authorised by the Governor in that behalf.

THE NORTH-WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE CIVIL SERVANTS (APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION & TRANSFER) RULES, 1989.

PART-I

GENERAL

- 1. Short title and commencement: (1) These rules may be called the North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions:-(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) "Appointing Authority" in relation to a post, means the persons authorized under rule 4 to make appointment to that post;
 - (b) "Basic Pay Scale" means the Basic Pay Scale for the time being sanctioned by Government, in which a post or a group of posts is placed,
 - (c) "Commission" means the North West Frontier Province Public Service Commission;
 - ²⁹(d) "Departmental Promotion Committee" means a committee constituted for making selection for promotion or transfer to such posts under a Department, or offices of Government, which do not fall within the purview of the Provincial Selection Board,
- 30 (dd)"Departmental Selection Board" means a Board constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial recruitment /appointment to posts under a Department or office of Government in Basic Pay Scale 17 not falling within the purview of the Commission:

Provided that more than one such committees may be constituted for civil servants holding different scales of pay".

- (e) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a committee constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial appointment to posts under a department, or office of Government [in Basic Pay Scale 17 and below not falling within the purview of the Commission];
- (f) "Post" means a post sanctioned in connection with the affairs of the Province, but not allocated to all Pakistan Unified Grades; and
- ³¹(g) "Provincial Selection Board" means the Board constituted by Government for the purpose of selection of civil servants for promotion or transfer to posts in respect
