1. Learned counsel for the appellant and Mr. Shoaib Ali, Assistant Advocate General alongwith Mrs. Samina Altaf, Directress Education (respondent No.2) and Mr. Ashfaq Khan Jadoon DEO (Male) Mansehra (Respondent No.3) present. Private respondents present through counsel.

2. Respondent No.2 produced copy of Minutes of DPC held on 08.04.2019 and stated at the bar that the appointments of the appellant and others, in response to the advertisement produced by her, on adhoc basis made under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers, Lecturers, Instructors and Doctors) Regulatory Act, 2011 which reads as under:

"4. Appointment of doctors, lecturers, instructors, subject specialists and teachers on adhoc basis.---(1) Government may, through the competent authorities make adhoc appointment on merit against the vacant posts of doctors, lecturers, instructors, subject specialists and teachers, falling within the purview of Commission, in a district concerned from the domicile holders of that district for a period of one year or till the arrival of recommendees of Commission, whichever is earlier after fulfilling the pre-requisites of giving wide publicity in the press. On assumption of charge of post by recommendee of the Commission, the services of such ad hoc appointee shall stand automatically terminated"

3. Therefore, the appointment was said by the Directress Elementary & Secondary Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa to be on Adhoc Basis. As regards the request for release of salaries of the respondents attached vide order dated 28.02.2024, it is directed that as the Directress and DEO have put appearance and clarified the point, therefore, salaries of all the respondents be released. To come up for arguments on 28.05.2024 before D.B at Camp Court,
