PARAWISE COMMENTS BY RESPONDENTS.

Respectfully Sheweth:-

Preliminary Objections:-

- i. That the appellant has got no cause of action to file this instant appeal.
- ii. That the appellant due to his own conduct is estopped to file his appeal.
- iii. That the appeal is bad because necessary parties have not been arrayed.
- iv. That the appellant has not come to this Honorable Tribunal with clean hands.
- v. That the appeal is liable to be dismissed in limine.

On Facts:-

1. Pertains to adverse remarks recorded by the countersigning officer by using powers under rule 13.17 of Police Rules 1934, keeping in view performance of the appellant. As per the rules ibid, Deputy Inspector General of Police may amend the report regarding any Police officer according to his performance as former is the supervisory officer.
2. Incorrect, and misleading as the remarks have been recorded on his performance for the specific period and has no concern with his past history.
3. Incorrect, as already explained vide above para.
4. Incorrect, due to the conduct of the appellant, he was awarded adverse remarks by the respondent No. 2. After receipt of adverse remarks, instead of mending his conduct he started file frivolous and baseless appeals to the respondent No. 1 and thereafter to this Honorable Service Tribunal. His departmental appeal was duly considered by the respondent No. 1, but having found no substance, he was having no other option except to file / reject the appeal. Similarly, the instant appeal filed before the Honorable Service Tribunal is also without any substance and worth to be dismissed. Copy of order is **annexure A**.

5. Incorrect, as already explained vide above para- 2.
6. Incorrect, adverse remarks have been recorded as per law / rules.
7. This para is also incorrect and without foundation, because the appellant failed to substantiate his plea and thus his departmental appeal was rightly rejected by the respondent No. 1. Hence the appellant has got no cause of action to file the instant appeal before the Honorable Service Tribunal.


On Grounds:-

- a) Every Police officer is under obligation to perform duties with honesty and devotedly.
- b) Incorrect, the adverse ACR has been granted by the authority within his lawful jurisdiction.
- c) Incorrect, already explained vide above paras.
- d) Incorrect, adverse ACR has been recorded keeping in view performance of the appellant for the specific period.
- e) Incorrect, already explained vide above para.
- f) Incorrect, already explained vide above para.
- g) Incorrect, adverse remarks were recorded for the specific period.
- h) Incorrect, already explained vide above para.
- i) Incorrect, already explained vide above para.
- j) Incorrect, already explained vide above para.
- k) Incorrect, the departmental appeal of the appellant was rejected by the departmental appellate authority on merits. (Copy annexed).
- l) Incorrect, as submitted above, forwarding adverse remarks, complaint or perusal of the service record of the official / officer is not a pre requisite. Personal hearing is also not mandatory under the ACR rules and good entries are also irrelevant while awarding adverse remarks to an official / officer.
- m) Incorrect, adverse remarks awarded to the appellant are based on hard realities and sound reasons. The adverse remarks are neither based on assumption nor on presumptions. The adverse remarks being based on sound footings are quite sustainable in the eyes of law and cannot be called in question.
- n) Incorrect, for awarding adverse remarks, existence of departmental inquiry is not required. Hence, this para is misleading and of no legal consequence.
- o) Incorrect, the adverse remarks awarded to the appellant are neither outcome of the surmises nor conjectures.
- p) Incorrect, that the adverse remarks awarded to the appellant are not suffering from legal or factual defect, hence the adverse remarks cannot be called in question.

- q) Incorrect, the adverse remarks are neither harsh nor arbitrary. The adverse remarks commensurate with the performance of the appellant.
- r) Incorrect, adverse report has been given within the administrative jurisdiction of the authority and no human right has been violated.
- s) Incorrect, each and every case has its own merits. Hence reference to the cases already adjudicated by the Honorable Tribunal cannot prove beneficial to the appellant.
- t) The respondent department may also be allowed to advance additional grounds at the time of hearing before the Honorable Tribunal.

PRAYER:-

It is therefore, requested that the instant appeal deserves to be dismissed with costs while adverse remarks awarded to the appellant may kindly be upheld in the great interest of law, justice and fair play, please.

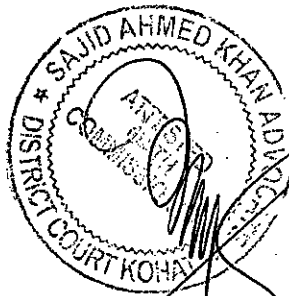



Respected Sir,

With profound regards, appellant submit representation for expunged of the Adverse Remarks recorded by countersigning Authority (RPO Kohat) for the period 14-06-2020 to 31-12-2020. The remarks were conveyed vide your good officer letter No. 753-54/22 dated 14-04-2022 through regional Police officer Kohat letter No. 226/cc dated 19.04.2022.

FACTS:

1. That appellant is serving Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police in the rank of Sub-Inspector under your kind command and control. Appellant is posted in district Karak of Kohat Region Police.
2. That during the period under review appellant was also posted in district Karak. The reporting officer rated appellant as good Police officer and held. The class of Report as "A" but unfortunately the countersigning Authority declared the appellant as " Below Average officer" and did not agree with remarks of Reporting officer for the impugned period. The remarks were conveyed as Adverse. Therefore this representation on those following grounds.

GROUND:

- a. That the remarks of countersigning officer is outcome of misunderstanding. The countersigning officer has not properly evaluated the performance of appellant for the impugned period. Law and rules emphasis objectives but not subjective assessment of the performance. The countersigning officer has not referred to any specific lapses and omission and source behind the impugned remarks. Therefore the remarks are herewith expunged.
- b. That appellant has earned good report from reporting officer who was immediate superior of the appellant and was directly supervising the working of appellant. Therefore the remarks of countersigning officer without advance of reasons of disagreement with assessment of reporting officers, suffered from vagueness.
- c. That the countersigning officer has not supplementary the adverse remarks with any material evidence. He has not referred to the weighing scale of performance evaluation. Therefore inconsistent remarks of countersigning officer with the reporting officer without any tangible evidence are against his was settled principles of performance evaluation.
- d. That counseling of an officer reported upon is must before recording was not ensured nor warning or advice notice was issued to appellant. The remarks were recorded at the back of appellant.



That a chain of reporting and countersigning officer have rated appellant as good officer throughout long span of service. Human conduct does not change abruptly which further support that the remarks are outcome of misunderstanding.

g. That the counter-signing officer has probably took the adverse notice of suspension of appellant during the period. Actually appellant was proceeded against departmentally during the period under review but was exonerated of the charges and re-instated from the date of suspension, thus the stigma of suspension was do away with on acceptance of the representation the impugned remarks may please be expunged.




