



<u>JUDGMENT</u>

MUHAMMAD AMIN KHAN KUNDI, MEMBER: This appeal has been filed under Section-4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 against the order dated 01.10.2014 whereby the appellant was dismissed from service as well as against the order dated 28.11.2014 whereby his departmental appeal was also rejected.

2. Facts of the case as per memo of the appeal are that the appellant was appointed in Police Department as Constable on 27.08.2010 and was performing his duty to the satisfaction of the superior. However, during his service he was removed from service








since 12.06.2014 to 11.08.2014 for about two months. He also filed departmental appeal but the same was also dismissed hence the present service appeal.

- 3. The respondents were summoned who contested the appeal by filing written reply/comments.
- 4. Learned counsel for the appellant contended that the respondents has removed the appellant from service vide order dated 01.10.2014 for the reason that he was absent from duty from 12.06.2014 to 11.08.2014. It was further contended that as per impugned order statement of allegation and charge sheet was framed on 18.06.2014 therefore, the disciplinary proceedings was initiated against him just after five days. It was further contended that infact the appellant was scriously ill and the medical officer also issued prescription and advised him for bed rest and the photo copy of the said prescription and advise of the doctor is available on record. It was further contended that respondent No. 3 District Police Officer Nowshera has also treated the absence period of the appellant as leave without pay. It was further contended that the respondents have imposed major penalty by dismissing him from service, therefore, the same is illegal and is not commensurate with his alleged absence period, therefore, prayed for acceptance of appeal.
- 5. On the other hand, learned Deputy District Attorney Mr. Ziaullah opposed the contention of learned counsel for the appellant and contended that the appellant was willfully absent from duty for a period of two months and thereafter charge and statement of allegation was served upon him and proper inquiry was conducted and thereafter he was rightly dismissed from service. It was further contended that the appellant has not denied the absence from duty nor he has justified the same, therefore, the respondents have rightly dismissed him from service and prayed for dismissal of appeal.
- 6. We have heard the arguments on both side and gone through the record available on file.
- 7. Perusal of the record reveals that as per impugned order the appellant was dismissed from service mainly for the reasons that he was absent from 12.06.2014 to 12.08.2014 for a period of two months but as per impugned order statement of allegations and charge sheet





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departmental proceeding was initiated against him. Moreover, the competent authority has also treated his period of absence as leave without pay therefore, he has regularized his absence period. Though a proper inquiry was conducted against the appellant but the punishment imposed by the respondents upon the appellant of dismissal from service is harsh and is not in commensurate with the alleged absence period, therefore, we are constrained to partially accept the appeal and modify/convert the major punishment of dismissal from service into reduction of three stages in time scale for a period of three years and the period during which the appellant remained absent as well as the period during which the appellant remained out of service shall be treated as leave of kind due. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.


