

1. Junior to counsel for the petitioner present. Mr. Umair Azam, Additional Advocate General alongwith Mr. Safi Ullah, Focal Person for the respondents present.

The judgment is very clear that the appellant was not permitted to performe the duties, therefore, contention of the respondents that she could not be allowed Health Professional Allowance for the period she had not performed duties, is not tenable, rather seems to be exploiting the terms of judgment. Respondents are given last chance to submit order showing complete compliance with the judgment, within a week. This case be fixed in the next week i.e. on 30.05.2024, and in case of failure of the respondents in submission of compliance report, coercive measures shall be taken against them. To come up for implementation report on the date fixed, before S.B. P.P given to the parties.
