the same were rejected. The appellants again submitted representations, but the same were not responded, hence, the present service appeals.

- 3. On receipt of the appeals and their admission to full hearing, the respondents were summoned, who put appearance and contested the appeal by filing written reply raising therein numerous legal and factual objections. The defense setup was a total denial of the claim of the appellant.
- 4. We have heard learned counsel for the appellants and learned Deputy District Attorney for the respondents.
- 5. The learned counsel for the appellants reiterated the facts and grounds detailed in the memo and grounds of the appeal while the learned Additional Advocate General controverted the same by supporting the impugned order.
- 6. It appears from the impugned order dated 23.06.2021 that the appellants were removed from service on the basis of alleged absence from duty, reported by the Education Monitoring Authority (EMA). The same shows that there are some flaws in it. There is nothing available on the files which could show that any inquiry was conducted, whereas, the proceedings appear to be for absence of the appellants but the relevant rules have not been followed before imposition of penalty. It is otherwise a well settled legal proposition that regular inquiry is must before imposition of major penalty which includes provision of full opportunity of defense to be provided to the civil servant which however was not done in the case of appellant. Reliance is placed on 2009 PLC (CS) 650.
