THE KHYBER **SECTION-4** OF UNDER SERVICE APPEAL PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 13.11.2023 PASSED BY RESPONDENT NO.2 THE APPELLANT WAS IMPOSED UPON MAJOR WHEREBY PENALTY OF COMPULSORY RETIREMENT FROM SERVICE AGAINST WHICH HE PREFERRED DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL TO RESPONDENT NO.1 ON 11.12.2023 BUT THE SAME WAS NOT **DISPOSED OF WITHIN STATUTORY PERIOD OF 90 DAYS.**

PRAYER:

On acceptance of the instant appeal, the impugned original order dated 13.11.2023 passed by Respondent No.2 and may graciously be brushed aside by reinstating the appellant into service with all back benefits.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:-

1. That the appellant joined the service of the Advocate General office way back on 19.11.2012 as Office Assistant (BPS-16). From the date of appointment till the impugned order, the appellant served dedicatedly and has thus put in more than 11 years valuable service wherein not even a minor penalty had ever been imposed on him.

- 2. That on 05.08.2023, the appellant was served with a Charge Sheet with Statement of Allegations (*Annex:-A*) containing the charges of habitual late-coming and leaving the office before the official timing and referring to the complaint of Additional Advocate General, Mingora Bench, Swat alleging therein not responding towards the duty.
- 3.

That since the charges were ill-founded, therefore, appellant denied the charges and explained his position through his detailed reply (*Annex:-B*) submitted on 16.08.2023. The reply to the Charge Sheet and Statement of Allegations may be treated as integral part of this appeal.

- 4. That through a separate order of even date (*Annex:-C*) two Additional Advocate Generals namely Mr. Umar Farooq and Mr. Danyal Khan Chamkani were appointed as Inquiry Committee. The Inquiry Committee conducted a summary inquiry and submitted their Report (*Annex:-D*) recommending the major punishment of compulsory retirement to the appellant.
- 5. That the Competent Authority thereafter served a final Show Cause Notice (Annex:-E) dated 02.09.2023 upon the appellant which was duly replied (Annex:-F) by him on 06.10.2023 thereby explaining his position to the Competent Authority. Reply to the Show Cause Notice may also be considered as an integral part of the instant appeal.
- 6. **That** finally vide impugned office order dated 13.11.2023 (*Annex:-G*), the Competent Authority was pleased to impose major penalty of compulsory retirement upon the appellant.
- 7. That the impugned order ibid was challenged through departmental appeal (Annex:-H) on 11.12.2023 before Respondent No.1 but the same was not disposed of within statutory period of 90 days, hence this appeal inter-alia on the following grounds:-

<u>Grounds:</u>

- A. That Respondents have not treated appellant in accordance with law, rules and policy on subject and acted in violation of Article 4 and 10A of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and unlawfully issued the impugned order, which is unjust, unfair and hence not sustainable in the eye of law.
- B. That the inquiry was not conducted in accordance with law. Neither appellant was properly provided opportunity of defence nor was any statement recorded in his presence providing him opportunity to crossexamine the witnesses. Similarly, the appellant was not confronted with any documentary evidence. Similarly, the requisite documents were also not requisitioned in support of the stance of the appellant. Major penalty cannot be imposed without holding regular inquiry. In this view of the matter, the impugned order is void ab-initio and thus not sustainable.
- C. That the appellant was also not provided a meaningful opportunity of personal hearing and thus the impugned order was passed in violation of the principle of natural justice, therefore, the same is void ab-initio, without lawful authority and therefore, liable to be set aside.
- D. That the charge(s) are not based upon sound footing. The appellant never remained absent from duty without permission. Whenever the appellant needed any leave, the same was properly applied for and in case of medical leave proper Medical Certificates of the authorized Medical Officer have been obtained. In this respect office order dated 21.05.2022 and 27.06.2022 (*Annex:-I*) allowing medical leave to the appellant under the Revised Leave Rules, 1981 are referred.
- E. That inspite of the allegation of absence of so many times, not a single explanation has ever been called from the appellant regarding the absence from duty as well as late coming and early leaving of the office.

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That the appellant has reservations on the conduct of inquiry proceedings as may be pointed out as under:-

- (i) The appellant was not reposing confidence in the Inquiry Officers as they were biased towards the appellant and he was not expecting justice from them. Application for transfer of inquiry was duly submitted to the Competent Authority on 28.08.2023. (*Annex:-J*)
- (ii) The statements of the Witnesses were subsequently altered which fact was duly brought into the notice of the Officers as well as Competent Authority vide letter dated 28.10.2023. (Annex:-K)
- (iii) During the course of inquiry proceedings, the appellant submitted application to the Competent Authority for requisition of original attendance record vide application dated 28.08.2023 but it was not provided till the conclusion of the inquiry proceedings. (Annex:-L)
- **That** the penalty imposed upon the appellant was against the principle of justice and fair-play. The findings of the Inquiry Committee with regard to the father of the appellant are misstated. In fact the appellant had pleaded before the Inquiry Officers that the father of the appellant was also a practicing lawyer of the High Court and that he is also part of the Lawyers' respectable Community.

That the appellant has been suffering from lower back neuro spinal issue since January, 2022 and is still under medical treatment from the Neuro Surgeon. The Medical Board has examined the appellant and advised him bed rest. The appellant applied for medical leave which application was processed while the appellant was bedridden. The application was later on, rejected whereas under the law medical leave cannot be refused, however, a second opinion of the Medical Board may be obtained which was not done. (Report of the Standing Medical Board with other documents alongwith rejected application for medical leave *Annex:*-M)

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That on account of long service of more than 11 years, the appellant has in leave account more than 370 days earned leave and therefore, his leave

could also be adjusted against the available leave in his account.

- That without prejudice to the grounds mentioned above but in addition thereto, the penalty imposed on the appellant, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case is highly excessive and does not commensurate with the so called guilt though not sustainable.
- K. That appellant would like to offer some other grounds during the course of arguments.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the instant appeal may graciously be accepted as prayed for above.

Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of case not specifically asked for, may also be granted to appellant.

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

ENQUIRY AGAINST MR. MOHAMMAD ASIM KHAN

The inquiry was entrusted to the undersigned officers through office order dated 5-8-2023 by the Worthy Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa against Mr. Muhammad Asim Khan Assistant (BPS-16) posted in office of the Addl: Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, at Swat. Mr. Zubair Muhammad Senior Administrative Officer BPS-19 was appointed as departmental representative to assist the Inquiry Committee.

BRIEF FACTS

A complaint against the accused Asim Khan was received from Addl: AAG, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa at Darul-Qaza, Swat. Accordingly a charge sheet was issued against the accused on 05-8-2023 which is as follows:-

It is to bring in your kind Notice that Mr. Asim Khan (Assistant) at the Office of Additional Advocate General Peshawar High Court Mingora Bench at Swat, is not responding towards his duty as is required. He used to come to office late as routine. So many times he remained absent from office without prior intimation or grant of leave.

He is also wasting time by spending a whole day out of office for a single and simple task.

2. And whereas, upon receipt of complaint from Additional Advocate General Swat on 12.07.2023 you were called by undersigned and you appeared on 26.07.2023 and in my presence, you used abusive language with Mr. Muhammad Nisar, Addl: Advocate General. At that time Mr. Ayaz Khan (Administrative Officer), Mr. Zubair. Gul (peon) and Mr. Munib-ur-Rehman (peon) were also present in the Office.

Due to above reasons, you appear to be guilty of gross misconduct and inefficiency under Rule 3(a) and 3(b) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 and have rendered yourself to all or any of the penalties specified in Rule 4 of the Rules ibid.

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3. And whereas in presence of Mr. Muhammad Nisar, Addl: Advocate General, you told Advocate-General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa that your father is a lawyer and you will file many cases against Advocate General office. This indeed amounts to gross insubordination and misconduct as provided under Rule 3(b) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 and have rendered yourself to all or any of the penalties specified in Rule 4 of the Rules ibid.

4. And whereas, your past conduct is also not satisfactory. Series of written notices shows your lack of interest in the performance of your duties, Vide order No. 9095-9096/AG, dated 20/08/2022 your explanation were also called because you were allowed one (01) month leave on medical grounds w.e.f 27.06.2022 to 26.07.2022. At the expiry of the leave, you were required to attend the office on 26.07.2022 but instead you sent an application for extension in the medical leave without annexing any medical documents to support your claim. The sanctioning authority declined to accede to your application which was also communicated to you. However in spite of that, you remained absent / away from duties till 20.08.2022. You were, therefore, directed to explain reasons of willful absence from 26.07.2022 to 20.08.2022

You appear to be guilty of habitually absenting yourself from duty under Rule 3(d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 and have rendered yourself to all or any of the penalties specified in Rule 4 of the Rules ibid;

5. And whereas, previously a complaint was received against you vide letter No. 10311 Admn: dated 16/03/2021 from Addl. Registrar, Peshawar High Court Mingora Bench Dar-ul-Qaza, Swat. Consequent upon the same you were transferred vide this officer order bearing No. 3868-72/AG dated 22/03/2021 to main office Peshawar. The Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide Order No. 6555-58/A.G./PF dated 11.03.2023 was pleased to withdraw the said order with a warning note and you were directed to report for duty in the office of Additional Advocate General, Swat with condition "to remain careful and in case, you were involved in any misconduct again, strict departmental action shall be taken against him".

But once again a written complaint dated 11.07.2023 was received from Additional Advocate General Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Dar-ul-Qaza, Swat regarding your inefficiency/misconduct, thus the under signed was constrained to withdraw office order bearing No. No. 6555-58/A.G. dated 11.03.2023 with immediate effect in the public interest on 24.07.2023.

You are, therefore, required to submit your written defence within ten days of the receipt of this charge sheet to the Inquiry Committee. Your written defence, if any, should reach to the Enquiry Committee within the specified period, failing which it shall be presumed that you have no defence to put in and in that case ex-parte action shall follow against you.

Intimate whether you desire to be heard in person.

A statement of allegation is enclosed."

The aforesaid charge sheet was communicated to the accused, through which he was asked to submit his written defense within 10 days and statement of allegations leveled against the accused on 05-08-2023 was also communicated to the accused on the allegations already mentioned in the charge sheet. The accused submitted his written reply on dated 15-08-2023 through which he denied all the allegations leveled against the accused and in his written reply he also appealed for mercy and requested to withdraw all the charges leveled against him. The para-wise reply of the accused is already annexed with the inquiry report.

The accused was also heard in person and an opportunity to record his statement was also given to the accused. The accused was also present during the recording of the statements of the other witnesses and he was provided full opportunity to cross-examine the witnesses.

STATEMENTS

Statement of accused

I have performed my duties as accountant in Dar-ul-Qaza Swat and usually visited District Account Office, Swat, situated at Migora City with permission and main reason of delay is due to heavy rush and account office work. As concerned with abusive language to Additional AG at Swat. I have not use any abusive language about said officer although my tone of speaking is loud and seems to be aggressor instead of normal speaking. Secondly my illness is out of control of human and I have already declared ill/sick by standing Medical Board and recommended one month bed rest.

That Mr. Asim Khan (Accused) stated that "....I have seen all the original documents along with my replies...." (Reply attached with the record). In his said reply dated 15-08-2023 he denied all the allegations leveled against him but in para 2 he stated "I do not think to use abusive language, not only with my boss but all members of society. Furthermore, my tone of speaking is loud and seems to be aggressor...." In Para 4 of his reply he stated that "My illness is out of control and I was already declared sick by the standing medical board.....I have sufficient leave in my account....there is no misconduct on my part" and lastly he prayed for charges to be withdrawn against him.

Statement of Additional Advocate General, Darul Qaza Swat

In his statement he deposed that accused performed his duty since 11/03/2023 in Mingora Bench Peshawar High Court further stated that accused was transferred from Main Office at Peshawar and I was directed to keep a watch on his daily attendance and submit report on weekly basis about his arrival and departure. I warned the accused so many times but I was compelled to file a complaint against him to Worthy Advocate General KP vide letter dated 11/03/2023 and 11/07/2023.

ATTESTED

At this stage the Additional Advocate General provided mobile to the inquiry committee in which the inquiry officer heard the voice message of the accused Mr. Asim Khan which was sent from his mobile number 344-8833235 around at 11:05 pm. The voice massage received from Mr. Asim personal mobile number. The abstract of the communication is available on the record. Through the said voice message the accused offered to patch up the matter with AAG Swat otherwise he threatened to put up the said past bills to Sectary Law, KP for onward proceedings, the T.A/D.A and law charges bills without prior approval from the competent authority. The AAG also deposed that the accused has illegally kept the official laptop with himself since 2018 without any permission. He was directed to return the said laptop but he had failed to do so.

Statement of Additional Advocate General, Mohammad Nisar Khan

In his statement Mohammad Nisar Khan deposed about the behavior and abusive language used by the accused with his officer and dis-obedience shown by him during his duty in the office. Nisar khan AAG stated "I was present the worthy AG KPK on 26-07-223 wherein, the inquiry file of Mr. Asim khan was produced by one Mohammad Ayaz, Administrative officer, handed over the said inquiry file to me for perusal and the worthy AG KPK, asked me regarding the allegations to be explained. So, in compliance with the order of worthy AG KPK started the allegations in the inquiry file but Mr. Asim Khan (accused) shouted at me that I hate you more than a dog and interpreted to me that you do not explain the allegations to me. He further asserted that my father is an advocate these days at Dar-ul-Qaza, Swat. If this office will terminate me from my services, I will impugn the same order before the Service Tribunal and get reinstated".

Statement of Mr. Zaheerudin and Mr. Haroon Rashid and Mr. Khashif Hameed

All the witnesses stated that it is a routine during official duty that he comes late to office and likewise used to leave office prior 2:00 PM time and again on several dates and he was marked absent in the Attendance Register with the initial "A" but falsely he marked himself present by putting his signature that also starts with the alphabet "A".

Statement of Mr. Avaz Khan, Administrative Officer, Office of Advocate General

Stated in his statement that on 12/07/2023 in the presence of Advocate General hurled abuse at the senior Law officer Mr. Nisar Muhammad, Addl. AG. Further stated that his father is practicing lawyer and would file cases against the Advocate General.

Statements of Zubair Gul and Muneeb-ur-Rehman

Both stated about the aggressive attitude of the accused against Mohammad Nisar Khan, Additional Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

At the end of the recording of the statements of all the witnesses the accused was asked by the inquiry committee whether he had any objection on the inquiry proceedings and whether he

wants to provide any further proof in his defence. The accused showed his complete satisfaction on the inquiry proceedings and stated that he relies on the his statement already recorded before the inquiry committee.

Conclusion

The inquiry committee have gone through the available record and arrived at a conclusion. The record shows that prior to this inquiry many complaints against the accused were received/processed, the details are as follows.

- 1. Explanation called vide office Order bearing NO 8_AAG dated 12-01-2016
- 2. Complaint lodged/filed by the Additional Registrar Mingora Bench/Darul-Qaza, Swat Vide letter bearing no 1031/admin dated 16-03-2021
- 3. Explanation called vide letter no. 9095_9096 dated 20-08-2022.
- 4. Warning issued vide office note dated 10-03-2023
- 5. Complaint made by Addl. Advocate General Vide letter No 431 dated 11-07-2023 against
- the delinquent officer for coming late without proper approval of the competent authority
- 6. Explanation was called via letter bearing No 36234_35 dated 07-08-2023
 7. Letter issued vide office letter No 37620_22/AG dated 22-08-2023 for return of the office
- laptop

(All the aforesaid documents have been collected from the personal file of the accused which has been provided by Mr. Zubair, Senior Administration Officer, AG Office, KPK)

The officials of the Mingora bench, Swat namely, Mr. Khwaja AAG, Swat, Mr. Zaheerudin, Mr. Haroon Rashid and Mr. Kashif Hameed stated that the accused comes late to the office and leaves the office prior to 2 PM time and again on several dates. Furthermore, the accused tampered with the attendance register and changed the absent mark "A" by putting his signature and contented that his name also starts with the alphabet "A" thus he is not absent. The Addl. AG Swat stated that "I warned the accused so many times but he continued his routine without giving any heed to the oral warning notices". Therefore, he was constrained to intimate to the worthy AG KPK in writing about the conduct of the accused and disclosed the factual position of the accused.

The statements all the officials/officers against the accused are consistent. The accused never alleged any malfide against Mr. Zubair, Mr. Haroon and Mr. Kashif, who categorically stated that he used to arrive late and would leave early from the office and would also mark himself as present by putting his signature on the attendance register illegally and change the alphabet "A" (For absent) to "Asim" (Accused name). The original register was presented during the proceeding during the inquiry committee. The allegation No 1 of the charge sheet is proved.

As per Para 2 of the charge sheet dated 05-08-2023. The accused used abusive language with Mr. Mohammad Nisar Khan, Additional Advocate General, KPK. Mr. Mohammad Nisar Khan in his statement has narrated the entire episode. Statement of Mr. Mohammad Nisar Khan shows

AT

that the accused is not only aggressive with lower staff but also misbehaves with seniors and officials. The language used by the accused would not be considered acceptable in a bazaar, let < alone in a government office. The unacceptable language used by the accused against the respectable Mr. Nisar AAG – A man who is an elder to the accused – shows that the conduct of the accused is completely out of bounds and intolerable.

In his written reply to the statement of allegations in Para no 2, He admitted, "That my tone of speaking is loud and seems to be aggressor" but during statement of Mr. Nisar Khan before inquiry committee he never rebutted the statement of Mr. Nisar Khan. The allegation of the charge sheet leveled in Para No 2 stands proved.

As per allegations in Para No 3, Mr. Ayaz Khan stated before the inquiry committee that "...He also, in the presence of Mohammad Nisar AAG told the worthy AG KP that his father is practicing lawyer at Mingora, Swat and would file cases against the Advocate General Office. The accused never cross-examined the said Mr. Ayaz Khan statement. The allegation of the charge sheet leveled in Para No 3 stands proved.

Regarding the allegation leveled in Para No 4, it is evident from the record that he remained absent from the duty and his past conduct also shows that he was not a willful and dutiful official. He remained absent as per record. In his reply he never presented any explanation to the Para No 4 of the charge sheet. That he remained absent from 26-07-2022 to 20-08-2022. In Para No 4 of his reply. He stated "...I had sufficient leave in my account. Hence, I had the leave and inform officer through written application...". The application of the accused was declined as no medical certificate as no medical certificate was annexed with the application and sanctioning authority declined to accede to leave application which was also communicated but no solid reason was given by the accused. Hence allegation of the charge sheet leveled in para no.4 against the accused is also proved.

As per allegation No 5 of the charge sheet. The reply given by the accused in the written stance is very evasive and cannot be considered acceptable to a prudent mind and during the inquiry the accused also did not utter a single word about this allegation. As per record this allegation is also proved against the accused.

RECOMMENDATION:

The track record of the accused shows that the accused isn't a dutiful person and is not willing to work nor shows any interest in it. The attitude of the accused remains distant with the office. In this inquiry different officials and officers of the AG office of KPK have come forward and stated that the attitude of the accused is aggressive with staff and disobedient with officials, evenduring the inquiry. The statement of the AG Swat paints a bad picture for the accused, as the learned AAG presents a recording where the accused threatens his office. The witnesses involved in this situation render the misconduct of the accused apparent. The ampering with the attendance register and giving no heed to the instructions from seniors and officers is also evident from record. This is a grave misconduct on part of the accused and cannot be ignored. The accused's conduct with Mr. Nisar AAG shows his disobedience and amount to administrative disturbance in office. Moreover, a person such as the accused is not suitable to an office where the cases are related to the government and the state. Such a person cannot perform the duties of an assistant let alone the duties of a clerk in any law office or firm. As the accused tampered with the official record i.e. attendance register.

The record also shows the threatening attitude of the accused during the inquiry proceeding with Addl. AGG Swat (Witness of the inquiry) which is also an example of grave misconduct and insubordination. All the allegation against the accused are proved.

Prior to this inquiry numerous chances were given to the accused to mend his ways but his willful absence from office, tampering of official record and abusive behavior make him liable to be proceeded against departmentally. Keeping in view the past service of the accused it is, therefore, recommended that the accused may be compulsory retired from service.

Departmental Appeal against the office order dated 13.11.2023 passed by the worthy Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhaw whereby major penalty of Compulsory retirement was imposed upon the appellant.

Respected Sir,

- 1. That the appellant joined the service of Advocate General office way back or 19.11.2012 as Office Assistant (BPS-16). From the date of appointment till cate, the appellant served dedicatedly and has thus put in more than 11 years valuable service wherein not even a minor penalty has ever been imposed or him
 - That on 05.08.2023, the appellant was served with a Charge Sheet with Statement of Allegations containing the charges of habitual late-coming and leaving the office before the official timing and referring to the complaint of Additional Advocate General Mingora Bench, Swat alleging therein not responding towards the duty
- 3. That since the charges were ill-founded, therefore, appellant denied the charges and explained his position through his detailed reply submitted. The reply to the Charge Sheet and Statement of Allegations may be treated as integral part of this appeal.
- 4. That an Inquiry Committee was constituted consisting of Mr. Muhammad Niser, Addl: A.G and Mr. Ayaz Khan, Admin Officer. The Inquiry Committee conducted a summary inquiry and submitted their Report recommending the major punishment of cor pulsory retirement upon the appellant.
- 5. That the Competent Authority thereafter served a final Show Cause Notice apon the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant thereby explaining his position to the Competent Authority. Reply to the Show Cause Notice may also be considered as an integral part of the instant appeal.
- 6. That finally vide impugned office order dated 13.11.2023, the Competent Authority was pleased to impose major penalty of compulsory retirement upon the appellan.
- 7. That the appellant being aggrieved of the impugned office order ibid, prefers this departmental appeal to your good-self inter-alia on the following grounds:-

Grounds:

- A. That the impugned office order dated 13.11.2023 is not according to law as we has rules and policy on the subject matter and therefore, is not legally maintainable.
- B. That the charge(s) are not based upon sound footing. The appellant never emained absent from duty without permission. Whenever the appellant needed any Lave, the same was properly applied for and in case of medical leave proper Medical Certificates of the authorized Medical Officer have been obtained. In this respect office order dated 21.05.2022 and 27.06.2022 allowing medical leave to the appellant under the Revised Leave Rules, 1981 are referred (Copies enclosed) $-\frac{100}{200}$ $-\frac{100}{20$

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That inspite of the allegation of absence of so many times, not a single explanation has ever been called from the appellant regarding the absence from duty as well as late coming and early leaving of the office.

That the inquiry was not conducted according to law as may be pointed out as under:-

- (i) The appellant was not reposing confidence in the Inquiry Officers as they were biased towards the appellant and he was not expecting justice from them. Application for transfer of inquiry was duly submitted to the Competent Authority on 28.08.2023 (copy enclosed).
- (ii) The statements of the Witnesses were subsequently altered which fact was duly brought into the notice of the Officers as well as Competent Authority vide letter dated 28.10.2023 (Copy enclosed). Page 08-09
- (iii) During the course of inquiry proceedings, the appellant submitted application to the Competent Authority for requisition of original attendance record vide application dated 28.08.2023 but it was not provided till the conclusion of the inquiry proceedings (copy enclosed).
- E. That the penalty imposed upon the appellant was against the principle of justice and fairplay. The findings of the Inquiry Officers with regard to the father of the appellant is misstated. In fact the appellant had pleaded before the Inquiry Officers that the father of the appellant was also a practicing lawyer of the High Court and that he is also part of the Lawyers' respectable Community.
- F. That the appellant has been suffering from lower back neuro spinal issue since January, 2022 and is still under medical treatment from the Neuro Surgeon. The Medical Board has examined the appellant and advised him bedrest. The appellant applied for medical leave which application was processed while the appellant was bedridden. The application was later on, rejected whereas under the law medical leave cannot be refused, however, a second opinion of the Medical Board may be obtained which was not done. (relevant record enclosed)
- G. That on account of long service of more than 11 years, the appellant has in leave account more than 370 days earned leave and therefore, his leave could also be adjusted against the available leave in his account.
- H. That without prejudice to the grounds mentioned above but in addition thereto, the penalty imposed on the appellant, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case is highly excessive and does not commensurate with the so called guilt through not sustainable.


