At the very outset, learned counsel for the appellant requested for sine adjournment of the instant service appeal and stated that appeal against appellant's acquittal was still pending before the Supreme Court of Pakistan. He also informed that a compromise has arrived at between the parties in the matter and the appeal before the Supreme Court would be soon decided on the basis of compromise. Therefore, it is appropriate that this matter be adjourned sine die i.e. till the decision of the matter before the Supreme Court of Pakistan, filed against acquittal of the appellant. The parties or any of them may get this appeal restored and decided after the decision of the matter pending before the Supreme Court of Pakistan. Consign.
