05.06.2024 1. Mr. Qazi Ishaq, Advocate submitted Wakalatnama on behalf of appellant which is placed on file.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that vide impugned order dated 22.03.2021 major punishment of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant on the basis of involvement and conviction in criminal case bearing No. 38 U/S 324/148/149/337D/337F (iii) and 337F(v) and FIR No. 39 U/S 15AA at PS Talash dated 25.05.2020. Appellant was released by the Worthy Peshawar High Court vide order dated 03.05.2021 in case FIR No. 39 while Additional Sessions Judge, Timergara acquitted the appellant in case FIR No. 38 by accepting his application vide order dated 22.11.2022. After release, he filed departmental appeal on 05.12.2022 which was decided vide order dated 13.01.2023 by reinstating and converting the major penalty of dismissal from service into censure with immediate effect. Feeling aggrieved, he filed revision petition which alongwith connected documents was send by the Regional Police Officer, Swat to the Inspector General of Police, Khyber

Pakhtunkhwa vide letter dated 08.02.2023 and revision petition of the appellant was rejected vide order dated 22.01.2024, hence the present service appeal. Points raised need consideration. The appeal is admitted for regular hearing subject to all just and legal objections. Appellant is directed to submit security fee within seven days, thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents for submission of written reply. Respondents be summoned through TCS the expenses of which be deposited by the appellant within seven days. To come up for written reply/comments on 03.07.2024 before S.B at Camp Court, Swat. P.P given to learned counsel for the appellant.
