


04.06.2024 1. Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Muhammad Jan learned District Attorney alongwith Hussain Ali, ADEO for the respondents present.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that appellant was suspended vide order dated 06.13.2016 upon involvement in the criminal case and is still on the strength of respondent department. He further argued that appellant was acquitted from the charges by the Worthy Peshawar High Court, Peshawar. Appellant is fit for service but respondents are reluctant to assign him duty and release his pay without any plausible reason which is against the rules. After earning acquittal in criminal, appellant file departmental appeal on 30.06.2023 which was not decided within statutory period of ninety days. Points raised needs consideration. Appellant is directed to deposited security fee within seven days. Written reply have already been submitted. Adjourned. To come up for rejoinder, if any, and arguments on 04.07.2024 before S.B at Camp Court, Swat. Parcha Peshi given to the parties.
