2. This application under Section 12(2) of the CPC, 1908 has been filed to get the order of the Tribunal dated 06.06.2023 set aside. The order of the Tribunal is as under:

"Learned counsel for the appellant present and submitted copy of letter No.35016-21/DEO/NWTD dated 19.12.2022 and stated that in view of the said letter, the desired relief has otherwise been granted to the appellant, therefore, this appeal has outlived its utility. The apprehension of the petitioners that execution petition was filed for implementation of the order dated 06.06.2023, is also misconceived because there is no question of implementation of the order dated 06.06.2023, for the above sole reason coupled with the fact
