The appellant was serving as Head Constable in District Torghar; that according to Rule 13(8) of Police Rules, 1934 appellant was entitled to seniority w.e.f the date of passing departmental examination; that vide impugned order dated 16.08.2016, appellant was deprived of the said seniority and the private respondents, who had not passed the departmental examination prior to the date of passing of the same, were granted seniority; that feeling aggrieved, he filed departmental appeal on 01.09.2016, which was rejected on 16.11.2016, hence, the instant service appeal.

## ii. SA No.37/2017 Muhammad Naveed:

The appellant was serving as Head Constable in District Torghar; that according to Rule 13(8) of Police Rules, 1934 appellant was entitled to seniority w.e.f the date of passing departmental examination; that vide impugned order dated 16.08.2016, appellant was deprived of the said seniority and the private respondents, who had not passed the departmental examination prior to the date of passing of the same, were granted seniority; that feeling aggrieved, he filed departmental appeal on 01.09.2016, which was rejected on 16.11.2016, hence, the instant service appeal.

The appellant, while serving in the Police Department, submitted an application for correction of his seniority, which was turned down on 05.10.2017, against he filed departmental appeal on 30.05.2017 which was rejected on 05.10.2017. Therefore, he filed the instant service appeal. iv. SA No.11638/2020 Wazir Muhammad:

The appellant, while serving in the Police Department, submitted representation against the seniority list dated 24.01.2020; that the said representation was dismissed vide order dated 04.06.2020. Therefore, he filed the instant service appeal.

- 3. On receipt of the appeals and their admission to full hearing, the respondents were summoned, who put appearance and contested the appeals by filing written replies raising therein numerous legal and factual objections. The defense setup was a total denial of the claim of the appellants.
- 4. We have heard learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel for private respondents and learned Deputy District Attorney for official respondents.
- 5. The learned counsel for the appellants reiterated the facts and grounds detailed in the memo and grounds of the appeals while the learned District Attorney assisted by the learned counsel for private respondents, controverted the same by supporting the impugned order(s).

- 6. The issue involved in all the four cases is, the seniority lists of officiating ASIs and Head Constables, issued on different dates. The dispute is fixation of seniority amongst the private parties. It is the contention of the learned counsel for appellants that seniority list was not prepared in accordance with the merit order notified by the Department. The list is stated to be not in accordance with the law and rules. When asked about the fact from where the seniority was fixed on different criteria, we could not find any plausible reply from either side, nor could anyone refer to any law or rule on the basis of which, the seniority was prepared in the manner it was prepared. The record is silent as well as the arguments were also not assisting the Tribunal to reach a proper conclusion.
- Therefore, we are constrained to remit the matter back to the departmental authorities to first decide, by a detailed order, with reasons, as to how different seniority lists should be prepared, by taking it into consideration all the laws, rules instructions, standing orders (but only those, having backing of law) and to decide in what manner seniority list should be prepared, also answering the questions as to how, why and which order of seniority should prevail, if need be, the authority may invite objections from all the concerned officials/officers and on passage of the detailed order in writing, seniority lists be issued accordingly. This exercise should be completed within three months from the passage of
