

In pursuance of the order of Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan in Civil Appeals Numbers 51-p and 52-p of 2009 whereas the appeal was disposed of with the term & condition that appellants shall be appointed as PST (Primary School Teacher) in their respective Union Councils immediately and in case if the appellants fail to acquire the training and the said qualification within three years, their appointments shall stands terminated automatically".







Respectfully Sheweth:

Preliminary Objections

- 1. That the appellant has no cause of action/locus standi to file the present appeal.
- 2. That the appellant has concealed the material facts from this Honorable Court.
- That the appellant has not come to this Honorable Court with clean hands.
- That the appellant has filed the instant appeal on malafide grounds just to put pressure on respondent department.
- 5. That the appellant's Appeal is against the prevailing rules and law and terms and conditions of his appointment.
- 6. That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
- 7. That the instant appeal is not maintainable in its present form and also in the present circumstances of the issue and also badly barred by time.
- 8. That the appellant was appointed along with others vide order dated 15-02-2013 with the condition that they would have to acquire requisite qualification within three years (i.e up to 15-02-2016) failing which their services would stood terminated automatically. As the appellant has failed to fulfill the same condition, resultantly his services stood terminated automatically w.e.f 15-02-2016. Hence the appellant was considered to be terminated w.e.f 15-02-2016 and orders dated 04-01-2017 and 31-01-2018 are well in accordance with rules and law in the light of appointment order of the appellant and Judgments of Peshawar High Court

dated 25-05-2016 as well Supreme Court of Pakistan. The appellant has no cause of action and his appeal is liable to be dismissed without any further proceeding.

ON FACTS

Para No. 1 of the appeal pertains to the appointment and termination of the appellant hence needs no comments.

- II. Para No. 2 of the appeal is correct to the extent that the appellant was appointed vide order dated 15-02-2013, however he failed to fulfill terms and conditions of his appointment order and could not continue their services. (Copy of appointment order is annexed as *Annexure: "A"*).
- III. Para No.3 of the appeal is incorrect. Para No. hence denied. Notification dated 04-01-2017 was well in accordance with rules and law in the light of Judgments of August Supreme Court of Pakistan, the Hon'ble High Court, and terms and conditions of appointment orders of the appellant. Moreover Hon'able Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench has already dismissed similar cases in WP No. 844-A/2017 titled as; Noor Samad VS Govt of KP and others and WP No. 366-A/2018 titled as; Zebal Khan and others VS Govt. of KP and others (Copies of Judgments of Hon'ble SC court, Notification of E&SE Department and PHC Abbottabad bench judgments are attached as *Annex*; "B, C, & E").
- IV. Para No.4 of the appeal is incorrect and denied. Responded acted upon the Judgment of August Supreme court of Pakistan. Detailed reply is given in the above para. (Copy of Judgment of august Supreme Court of Pakistan is annexed as Annexure: "B")
- V. Appellant has no cause of action.

ON GROUNDS:

- A. Ground "a" of the appeal is incorrect. Order dated 31-01-2018 was passed well in accordance with rules and law in the light of Judgments of August Supreme Court of Pakistan, Hon'ble High Court, and terms and conditions of appointment order of appellant.
- b. Ground "b", of the appeal is incorrect and denied.
 Department followed the directions and judgments of the august Supreme Court in the instant matter.
- c. Ground "c" of the appeal is incorrect and misleading hence denied. Appellant has not completed the requisite qualifications within the stipulated time.
- d. Ground "d" of the appeal is incorrect. Order dated 31-01- 2018 is very clear and was passed in the light of Judgments of August Supreme Court of Pakistan, Hon ble

High Court, Notification of Department and terms and conditions of appointment order of the appellant.

- Ground "e" of the appeal is incorrect. As stated in preceding Paras.
- f. Appellant has no cause of action. Respondents seek gracious permission of this honorable court to raise other legal and factual points during the course of arguments.



It has been conceded before us that in the instant cases, though the respondents possessed the requisite academic qualification, they lacked the training which was sine qua non for the purposes of their

curument to the posts of CT/PTC, therefore they are not entitled to be reinstated because according to the definition of 'sacked employee' provided in Section 2(g) of the Act, only such employees, who were eligible for appointment and had been sucked, could be reinstated as per the law.

We have been apprised by the learned counsel for the respondents that according to the advertisement and appointment letters issued to the respondents, two kinds of candidates could be appointed: (i) specific period. This is exactly what the learned High Court has allowed in the relief granung portion of the impugned judgment. Undoubtedly, this is in consonance with the Department's own advertisement and the terms and conditions of service, therefore, the learned High Court did not fall into any error by requiring the Department to allow the respondents to complete the training within a specific period of time and to take action against them in case of failure to do so. 


