2. The Service Appeal bearing No. 573/2023 was dismissed in default vide order dated 05.09.2023. The petitioner submitted application for attested copy on 14.09.2022 which was delivered to the petitioner on 25.09.2023 hence preferred the instant restoration application on 27.09.2023. The application is within time and learned AAG has got no objection on restoration of appeal. The application for restoration of service appeal is supported by duly sworn affidavit. Law also favours adjudication on merit by avoiding technicalities.

3. The application in hand is, therefore, accepted and the appeal is restored to its original number. To come up for preliminary hearing on 05.07.2023 before S.B at camp court Swat. P.P given to the parties.
