- 2. Appellant's case in brief is that he had earlier filed Service Appeal No.1203/2019 and the same was dismissed by the Tribunal vide order dated 0411.2019. That after adding some documents, he has again approached this Tribunal through filing the instant service appeal.
- 3. Arguments heard. Record perused.
- 4. The appellant has filed the instant service appeal without filing of departmental appeal, rather his earlier appeal on the same issue has been dismissed. In such situation, Rule-23 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Rules, 1974 bars this appeal. Rule-23 is reproduced as under:
 - "23. No entertainment of appeal in certain cases:-The Tribunal shall not entertain any appeal in which the matter directly and substantially in issue has already been finally decided by a Court or a Tribunal of competent jurisdiction."
- 5. In view of the above, instant service appeal is dismissed with costs. Consign.
