## Execution Petition No.965/2023 titled "Qabil Jan Vs. Prisons Department"

2. The Tribunal vide its judgment dated 04.10.2023 held as under:

"Viewing the case in the above situation, we deem it appropriate that the matter be remitted to the respondents for conducting inquiry into the matter to verify the signature and genuineness of the alleged resignation and then proceed in accordance with law and rules. The appellant is reinstated in service for the purpose of inquiry. The issue of back benefits shall be subject to the outcome of the inquiry. Consign."
