

Kalim Arshad Khan, Chairman: Learned counsel for the appellant and Mr. Muhammad Jan, District Attorney for the respondents present.

2. Brief facts of the case, as per averments of the appeal, are that appellant was appointed as Sub Inspector on 09.09.1982; that he was promoted to the post of Inspector on 22.11.2017; that he, on attaining the age of superannuation, retired from service on 28.02.2023; that in the year 2023, the post of Assistant Registrar became vacant and the said post was to be filled by promotion from amongst the senior most Inspector; that the appellant's case was sent for promotion with all working papers but he was not considered, therefore, he filed departmental appeal followed by a reminder, but the same was not responded, hence, the instant service appeal.

3. Arguments heard. Record perused.

4. Before he could be promoted against the post of Assistant Registrar, laid vacant in the year 2023, he had already retired from service. In order to get pro-forma promotion to the post of Assistant Registrar, the appellant filed departmental appeal, but the same was not responded. Although, working paper for promotion of the appellant was sent but mere preparation of working paper will not create any right in favor of appellant.




5. Therefore, the appeal in hand has no merits in it and is dismissed with costs. Consign.
