1. Appellant in person present. Mr. Umair Azam, Additional Advocate General present.

2. Earlier Appeal No.30/2017 of the appellant was decided by this Tribunal on 19.03.2018, wherein, the issue of back benefits was held to be subject to the rules on the subject. The appellant was reinstated on 06.06.2018 for the purpose of de-novo inquiry. The period from 25.08.2014 to 05.06.2018 during which the appellant had served the department, was treated as leave without pay, while decision on the period after 05.06.2018 was deferred in the report of inquiry. There is an order on the file dated 27.06.2022, which shows that the appellant was exonerated from the charges leveled against him but no order was passed regarding the issue of back benefits. The appeal is, therefore, admitted to regular hearing subject to all just and legal objections. Appellant is directed to deposit security fee within 10 days. Respondents have already been placed ex-parte. To come up for ex-parte arguments on 25.07.2024 before D.B at Camp Court, Abbottabad. P.P given to the appellant.
