01. Petitioner alongwith counsel present. Mr. Arshad Azam, Assistant Advocate General alongwith Muhammad Bilal, ADEO for the respondents present.

02. In pursuance of order sheet dated 09.07.2024, representative of the respondents produced a copy of letter dated 03.07.2024 of the office of Commissioner Afghan Refugees Peshawar, according to which the petitioner was appointed as Teacher on 22nd April, 1982 on contract basis, out of UNHCR budget. He remained under the Commissionerate of Afghan Refugees and was later on handed over to BEFARF NGO. Copy of the letter is placed on file. According to that document, the petitioner is not entitled to pensionary benefits of that period as he was not a government servant paid out of government exchequer. The petitioner stated that he joined the Government service in 2010 and retired on 11.10.2017 which shows that he remained in government service for a period which was less than ten years. In view of the reply of respondents submitted on 23.05.2023, read with the letter dated 03.07.2024 of the office of Commissionerate Afghan Refugees, Peshawar, a question arises whether the judgment of this Tribunal dated 11.11.2021 is executable or not.


03. Let the petitioner, as well as the respondents, be put on notice to assist this Tribunal on the above question. To come up for further proceedings on 21.08.2024 before the S.B. PP given to the parties.
