2. Earlier, an application for restoration of appeal was filed by
the petitioner bearing No.189/2023, which was decided on
22.06.2023 in the following manner:

"This application has been moved to get Service Appeal No.1324/2011 restored which, according to the applicant, was dismissed in default on 16.04.2018. Copy of the order dated 16.04.2018 is annexed with the application. The same shows that certified copy was issued on 12.11.2021. The order dated 16.04.2018 shows that counsel for the appellant had withdrawn the appeal by stating at the bar that grievance of the appellant had been redressed. On the request, the appeal was dismissed as withdrawn. As the appeal was not dismissed in default, rather it was dismissed as withdrawn and that too, on the request of the learned counsel for the appellant that grievance of the appellant had been redressed, therefore, application for restoration of appeal is misconceived and dismissed accordingly. is Consign"

3. Now, this application under Section-12(2) CPC, 1908 has been moved, which is not only bereft of the elements of fraud and misrepresentation etc. but also on the same grounds on which application for restoration was filed. Besides, the application under Section-12(2) of CPC is barred by time as well. Although, the petitioner has stated that she got knowledge of the order dated 16.04.2018 on 28.03.2023, but no source of getting knowledge

has been mentioned.

4. For the above reasons, we see no merits in this petition, therefore, the same is dismissed with costs. Consign.
