That the Various schools in the district were having single teacher and that the subject was often noted in the District Steering Committee meetings on report of the EMA, therefore, the said transfers were made in those schools in need of a second teacher. The respondents cannot afford to have a school at the mercy of a single teacher to avoid closure of the school in case that one teacher go on a leave or vacation.-B

- I. The respondents ordered the transfer in accordance with the proposal of the sub-divisional officer concerned purely in public interest.

● In light of the above stated facts, it is submitted that the case of the appellant may be dismissed with cost.





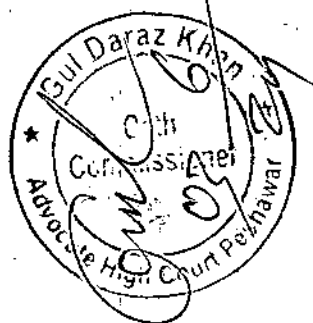

Posting and Transfer Policy

Statutory Provision.

Section 10 of the KP Civil Servants Act, 1973.

Posting and Transfer. Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the Province, in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or Local authority, or a Corporation or body set up or established by any such Government:-

Provided that nothing contained in this section shall apply to a civil servant recruited specifically to serve in a particular area or region;

Provided further that, where a civil servant is required to serve in a post outside a service or cadre, his terms and conditions of service as to his pay shall not be less favourable than those to which he would have been entitled if he had not been so required to serve.


Posting/transfer policy of the Provincial Government.

- i) All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants
- ii) All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posing/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
- iii) All contract Government employees appointed against specific posts, cannot be posted against any other post.
- iv) Tenure of posting/transfer for settled areas shall be two years for unattractive areas, 1½ years and for hard areas one year.
- v) Deleted vide No. SOR-VI/1-4/2008/VOL-VI DATED 3-6-2008
- vi) *While making posting/transfers of officers/officials up to BS-17 from settled areas to FATA and vice versa approval of the Chief Secretary, KP needs to be obtained. Save Tehsildars/Naib Tehsildars within a division in respect of whom the concerned Commissioner will exercise the same power. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice versa, specific approval of the Governor, KP shall be obtained.

Provided that the power to transfer Political Tehsildars and Political Naib Tehsildars within FATA between different divisions shall rest in Additional Chief Secretary FATA.

- vi (a) deleted vide No. SOR-VI/E&AD/1-4/2010/VOL-IX dated 24-11-2017
- vii) Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except Deputy Commissioner and Superintendent of Police. Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thaana) of his area/residence is situated.
- viii) No posting/transfers of officers/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- viii-A) *Guide lines to facilitate posting of husband and wife at the same station:-
 - a. Where a request is made for posting at a different station in the same department/service/cadre in which an employee is already serving, the request may be accepted subject to availability of a post in the same BPS.
