
PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE RESPONDENTS

Respectfully Sheweth,

Preliminary objections:

- i. That the petitioner has got no cause of action to file the instant execution petition.
- ii. That the execution petition in hand is not maintainable in its present form.
- iii. That the execution petition is bad for Mis-joinder/non-joinder of unnecessary and necessary parties.
- iv. That under section 4(6) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Services Tribunal Act 1974, no appeal shall lie in the tribunal against an order or decision of a departmental authority regarding the fitness or otherwise of a person to be appointed to or to hold a particular post or to be promoted a higher post or cadre on this score alone the appeal is not maintainable.
 - v. That the execution petition is based on misrepresentation of facts, hence the petitioner is estopped by his conduct to file the appeal.
- vi. That the petitioner has got all his back benefits along with increments and salaries etc.
- vii. That the appellant has been declared surplus and is now governed under the surplus pool policy.
- viii. That the petitioner has not come to the court with clean hands:
- ix. That the execution petition is barred by law.





- 2. Pertains to the record.
- 3. Correct to the extent of judgement of the Honorable Tribunal, however, the Finance Department abolished the posts of the **Services** in the Directorate of Tourists Services and created new positions in surplus pool in the Establishment Department which was approved by provincial cabinet in its meeting held on 24.06.2023 and the **Services** were parked in surplus pool on 24th October 2023 under under section 8(iv)(a) of the Tourism Act(Annex-A).
- 4. Pertains to the record.
- 5. Incorrect. As explained in para 03. It is further submitted that the same petitioner had filed WP No. 2772-P/2022 and WP No. 2773-P/2022 in the Peshawar High Court, the operative part of the judgement dated 26.01.2023 is reproduced as under: -

" Now the brief question as to whether an attached department which is no more in existence and merged into an authority while its employees who would be in surplus pool, and their fate either absorption, retention or utilization has not so far decided, how come the respondents would convene a meeting of the departmental Selection or promotion committee for their promotion for the simple reason that on which post and in which department they will be given promotion "

- The Directorate of Tourist Service is no more in existence and the petitioner has been declared surplus and is governed under the surplus pool policy. Therefore, keeping in view the legal hurdles involved in the implementation of the ibid judgement the Culture, Tourism, Archaeology and Museums department has filed CPLA number 290-P/2024against the ibid Judgement of the tribunal in the August Supreme Court of Pakistan on the advice of Law Department.
- 6. As explained vide para 05 CPLA No. 290-P/2024 has been filed in the August Supreme Court of Pakistan against the Judgment of the Honourable Tribunal dated 15.03.2024 (Annex-B). keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are no more employees of their parent Department and the promotion posts were abolished by the Finance Department as narrated above (Annex-C), it is humbly prayed that the execution

petition may be dismissed/kept pending till the final outcome of the CPLA to avoid legal complications in the implementation of the judgement of the honourable tribunal please.

7. The respondents seek leave to raise additional grounds at the time of the arguments.

Substantial questions of law of general public importance and grounds, inter alia, which falls for determination of this august Court are as under:-

- Whether the impugned judgment and order dated 15/03/2024 passed in Service Appeal No.597/2023 by the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar does not suffer from material illegality, factually incorrect and required interference by this august Court?
- 2. Whether the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar has properly and legally exercised its jurisdiction in the matter in hand?
- 3. Whether the respondent is employee of the Tourism Department?
- 4. Whether the promotion of respondent was deferred as he was recently promoted to the post of Office Superintendent on acting charge basis in the light of Service Rules of the Directorate of Tourist Services on 31/10/2017 and there was no provision for promotion of the said official to the post of Assistant Director/Assistant Controller/Assistant Director-cum-Assistant Controller in the amended Service Rules of Directorate of Tourists Services notified on 25/04/2022?
- 5. Whether the employees who are kept in surplus pool and their fate of absorption, retention or utilization are under the surplus pool policy can be granted promotion and call DPC for them?
- 6. Whether under Section 08 of newly promulgated Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Tourism Act, 2019, the said Directorate was not ceased and merged in-to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Culture and Tourism Authority "CTA" established under Section 6 of the Act?
- 7. Whether the employees of DTS parked in surplus pool can be promoted but on which post and in which department?
- 8. Whether the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar has advanced any legal and plausible reason by accepting the Service Appeal of respondent without adverting to legal and factual aspect of the matter?
- 9. Whether the Hon'ble Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar has properly construed the record and material in its true perspective?
- 10. Whether the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar has properly followed, applied and interpreted the law in the subject case?

11. Whether the Hon'ble Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar has properly construed the record and material in its true perspective while passing its impugned judgment and order dated 15/03/2024?

FACTS

II- Facts relevant to the above points of law, inter alia, are as under:-

- 1. That the Directorate of Tourist Services was established by Federal Government in 1976 while its regional offices in 1988. On 31st March 2012, the Directorate of Tourist services was devolved to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in the 18th Constitutional Amendment.
 - 2. That the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa promulgated Tourism Act, 2019, under which the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Culture and Tourism Authority was established for the development of Culture and Tourism. Under Section (8)(i) of the Tourism Act, the authority shall take over the administrative, financial and regulatory control of all the activities, offices, projects, centers of the corporation, Directorates and Institutes in a prescribed manner as a result thereof shall cease to be the attached departments of the department and shall merge into the authority as given in the Sub-section (b) of the Sub-Section (i) of the ibid Section.
- 3. That Sub-section (iv) of Section 8 of the Act, the Government shall create surplus pool in the Establishment Department for the employees of the Directorates till the retirement of the last incumbent. These employees shall continue to enjoy all the benefits currently admissible to them and shall be entitled to receive their salaries and other benefits as if they had continued to work against existing cadres or posts. The section ibid further adds that the service of the employees shall be utilized in a manner prescribed by the Government or absorb in the other departments.
- 4. That Secretary Tourism issued a certificate to the extent that the authority has developed the requisite capacity to take over the functions of the Directorate of Tourists Services on 25th July 2022 as required under the Act. The functions of the Directorate were transferred to the Tourists Services Wing of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Culture and Tourism Authority on 17th November 2022. Subsequently the Finance department abolished the posts of the respondent in the Directorate of Tourists Services and directed BO-IV to create similar posts on the strength of the

Establishment Department for the creation of a surplus pool which was approved by Provincial Cabinet in its meeting held on 24/06/2023 and the respondent along-with other employees of the erstwhile Directorate of Tourists Services were parked in surplus pool 24th October, 2023 under section 8(iv)(a) of the Tourism Act. Now all of the employees of the erstwhile Directorate of Tourists Services are now placed are parked in surplus pool and their absorption, retention, etc. is governed under the surplus pool policy. Therefore, for all intents and purposes, the employees of the erstwhile Directorate of Tourist Services is no longer the attached department of the Culture, Tourism, Archaeology and Museum Department and its employees are governed under the surplus pool policy of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Establishment Department.

- That during the pendency of the creation of surplus pool, the Departmental 5. Promotion Committee meeting was held on 07/11/2022 on the request of the Directorate of Tourists Services and directions of the superior Court. The request of the respondent for promotion to the post of Assistant Directorate/Assistant Controller/Assistant Director-cum-Assistant Controller was also placed before the Departmental Promotion Committee but the case was differed. The decision of the Departmental Promotion Committee is reproduced as, 'the said official has already been promoted to the post of Superintendent BS-17 on ACB in the light of Service Rules of DTS duly notified on 31/10/2017 and there is no provision for promotion official to the post of of the said Assistant Directorate/Assistant Controller/Assistant director-cum-Assistant Controller in the amended service rules of DTS notified on 25/04/2022, hence the Committee deferred the promotion of said incumbent".
- 6. That the respondent filed Departmental Appeal but without waiting for the result being aggrieved from Departmental Promotion Committee, filed W.P No.2772/2023 before the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar which was dismissed and directed that their right of promotion shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations and terms and condition of the cadres into which they are absorbed.
- 7. That the respondent filed Service Appeal No.597/2023 before the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar for holding of the Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) wherein Para-wise reply was asked from the

petitioners which was filed and the stance of respondent was denied on legal and factual grounds.

- 8. That the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar allowed the Service Appeal and directed to the petitioners to promote the respondent from the date when the meeting of DPC was held i.e. 07/11/2022.
- 9. That the petitioners being aggrieved from the impugned judgment and order of the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar dated 15/03/2024 passed in Service Appeal No.597/2023, prefer this CPLA before this august Court.
- 10. That the petitioners seek leave to appeal against the impugned judgment and order of the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar dated 15/03/2024 passed in Service Appeal No.597/2023.

It is, therefore, prayed that on acceptance of this petition, leave to appeal against the impugned judgment and order of the Learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar dated 15/03/2024 passed in Service Appeal No.597/2023 may graciously be granted.
