- 31st July. 2024 <u>Kalim Arshad Khan, Chairman:</u> Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Muhammad Jan, District Attorney for the respondents present.
 - 2. Brief facts of the case, as reflected from the record are that appellant was initially appointed as Medical Officer (BPS-17) on 01.06.1990; that after working for sufficient time, he was appointed on the recommendation of Departmental Selection Committee, as District Specialist (BPS-18) on contract basis vide Notification dated 27.01.2004; that vide Notification dated 05.05.2009, he was appointed as District Specialist by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission; that he had served on contract basis w.e.f 27.01.2004 to 05.05.2009; that for the purpose of pensionary and other benefits, he filed departmental appeal, but the same was not responded, hence, the instant service appeal.
 - 3. Arguments heard. Record perused.
 - 4. The issue in the instant service appeal is that the appellant has served for five years, on contract basis. The appellant's claim is regarding counting of that service with all back benefits. However, in the absence of any record enabling the Tribunal to reach a proper conclusion and despite directions for production of record, no record was produced.

- 5. Therefore, we send this matter back to the department to resolve it at their own end. Costs shall follow the event. Consign.
