

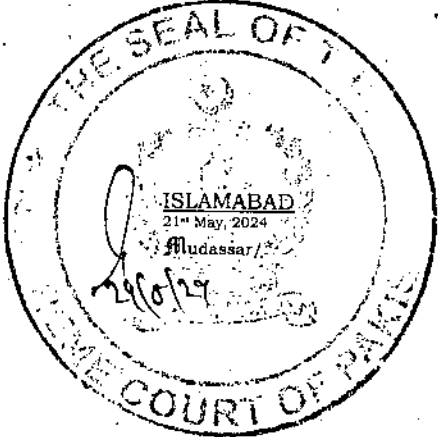

ORDER

Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J. — In this case, the appellate order dated 21.03.2022, passed by three Honourable Judges of the Peshawar High Court, was challenged, before learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Peshawar (**'Tribunal'**), which was not entertained by the Tribunal and in paragraph No.4 of the impugned order, the original memo and ground of appeal along with copies of the accompaniments were ordered to be returned to the petitioner.

2. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and also gone through the impugned order and do not find any justification to interfere. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner will avail appropriate remedy, if any, available to him under the law.
