 - (e) "Case" means a particular matter under consideration and includes all papers relating to it and required to enable the matter to be disposed of, viz: correspondence and notes and also any previous papers on the subject or subjects covered by it or connected with it;
 - (f) "Chief Secretary" means the officer notified as such in the Gazette, who shall in addition to other Departments and functions that may be allotted to him







6.3.1.6 Mode of Payment

The government share of 80% of the total cost will be made by the department to the fanner through cross-cheque, after due endorsement of TPV Consultants, issued from the project account in the name of the beneficiary/SWCA according to the sanctioned estimate after the successful completion of the construction work according to specification and design. An assignment account will be opened out of which payment will be made in two installments. It is proposed that, those farmers who doesn't have sub-surface source of irrigation water in barani areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and interested to install new Tube well, shall be benefited by sharing the cost of tube well installation @ 80:20% (Project: Farmer) basis, i.e., 80% share will be borne by the Project and 20% share will be borne by the Farmer.

The estimated cost of installation of Tube Well (320 feet depth) is Rs.927,240/- as such per foot cost of the tube well drilling comes out to be around Rs.2,900. Project Director/ Director Agricultural Engineering will scrutinize the documents and final approval to the deserving beneficiaries keeping in view the very objectives of the project.

On the receipt of approval, farmer shall then arrange for deployment of earth moving machinery, If the departmental machinery could not be spared for leveling/development of land, it shall be carried out through private earthmoving. machinery under close supervision of concerned Agricultural ' Engineer/Assistant. Agricultural Engineer and on the approval of Project Director/ Director Agricultural Engineering. After completion of work, the Departmental Technical Committee will confirm satisfactory completion of land leveling work. Government Share @ 80% (i.e. Rs. 50,000/acre up to maximum of Rs. 57,600/- per 12.5 acres) cost of land development work will be paid to the individual beneficiary in shape of cross cheque through Accountant General Khyber Pakhtunkhwa/District Account Officer only after provision of verification/completion report including before & after map of the land developed along with the pictures & videos by technical committee regarding successful completion of land leveling work.

Payment to the concerned beneficiary/farmer will be subject to actual area reclaimed/physically

measured.

Tube wells: 🖟

The project will be executed as per procedure proposed here-under:

- 1. The Scheme will be advertised in leading newspapers.
- 2. The concerned 'Agricultural Engineer/Assistant Agricultural Engineer will collect applications from land owners interested in the installation of Agricultural

Tube-wells on their land.

- Each application must be provided with following revenue documents (duly attested by the Revenue authorities):
 - Land Holding Certificate of the Agriculture land measuring minimum 20 Kanals (2.5 Acres) in a compact block that confirms ownership of the applicant (individual or group with alterney in: favour of anyone of them). A certificate to that effect clearly indicating the ownership and land holding of the applicant / group of farmers will also be provided.
- 4. Surety bond duly signed by the farmers/beneficiaries (attested by oath commissioner) mentioning that he/she/they have not availed similar facility (Tube Well installation) under government funded scheme in the last five years and that the Tubé well shall be utilized for agriculture purpose only and thereby ensuring operation, maintenance and security of Tube well.
- 5. Departmental technical committee comprising of Agricultural/Assistant Agricultural Engineer and Unit Supervisor of the concerned sub-office will scrutinize the applications and land ownership documents duly verified by district revenue department on the basis of criteria and physical inspection of site for availing the facility.
- 6. The site feasibility report will then be prepared by the technical committee including resistivity report (provided by farmer). GPS Coordinates and three pictures of the site.
- 7. Agricultural Engineer/ Assistant Agricultural Engineer of the concerned sub-office will furnish all the verified applications along with the relevant documents received at his end of the individual sites to the Project Director/ Director Agricultural Engineering. Project Director/ Director/ Director Agricultural will scrutinize the documents and accord final approval to the deserving beneficiaries keeping in view the very objectives of the

project,

- 8. On the receipt of approval, work order will be issued by the concerned Agricultural Engineer / Assistant Agricultural Engineer to the applicant for installation of Tube Weil according to the approved specifications. (Already Existing Tube well will not be considered for grant of incentive under the scheme), if the departmental drilling machinery cannot be spared from installation of tube wells, drilling work through private drilling agencies shall be carried out under close supervision of concerned Agricultural Engineer/Assistant Agricultural Engineer and on the approval of Project Director/ Director Agricultural Engineering Department.
- 9. After completion of tube well to the desired depth, the departmental technical committee Will confirm satisfactory completion of the tube well. Government Share @ 80% cost of installation of Tube Well of the relevant category will be paid to the individual beneficiary in shape of cross cheque through Accountant General Khyber Pakhtunkhwa/District Account Officer only after installation of pumping set on the Tube Well and upon provision verification/completion report by concerned Agricultural Engineer / Assistant Agricultural Engineer regarding successful installation and operation of Tube Well.

Solar pumping system:

The project will be executed as per procedure proposed hereunder:

o The Scheme will be advertised in leading newspapers and more publicity at local level will be done by printing banners & pamphlets.

 The Agricultural Engineer/ Assistant Agricultural Engineer of the concerned district will invite/collect applications from land owners interested in the installation of solar pumping machinery.

o The interested farmer/farmers should have a ground water source of minimum 8 inches' diameter with enough sub surface water availability for irrigation purpose.

 Each application must be provided with following revenue documents (duly attested by the Revenue authorities):

a. A Certificate from Revenue Department attested by Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar showing therein the size of land in possession of applicant (individual or group with attorney in favour of anyone of them) having an area of minimum 20 Kanals (2.5 Acres) in a compact block that confirms ownership of the applicant (individual or group with attorney in favour of anyone of them). A certificate to that effect clearly indicating the ownership and land holding of the applicant / group of farmers will also be provided.

- b. Surety bond duly signed by the farmers/beneficiaries to ensure that the system shall be utilized for agriculture purpose only and thereby ensuring operation, maintenance and security of the system.
- o Departmental technical committee comprising of Agricultural Engineer / Assistant Agricultural Engineer of the concerned district and Unit Supervisor concerned of the sub-office will scrutinize the applications and land ownership documents duly verified by district revenue department on the basis of criteria and physical inspection of site for availing the facility.

o On the basis of the feasibility report to be provided by the Unit supervisor concerned of the District and signed by the members of the above committee recommends the solar pumping system of appropriate size.

o The Agricultural Engineer / Assistant Agricultural Engineer of the concerned district will furnish all the verified applications received at his end with papers attached thereto of the individual sites to the Project Director/ Director/ Agricultural Engineering. The Project Director/ Director Agricultural Engineering will scrutinize the papers and accord final approval to the deserving beneficiaries keeping in view the very objectives of the project.

 On receipt of approval, the concerned farmer/group of farmers will be requested to deposit his or their share (i.e. 20% of the total

cost of solar pumping system) in a designated PLS account opened for the purpose.

o On confirmation of deposited amount from the bank, a solar pumping system of appropriate capacity and size will be Issued to the respective farmer from the Directorate Agricultural Engineering main store at Tamab, Peshawar, by adopting proper store procedure and the supplying company will install the system on the water source of the beneficiary / beneficiaries.

UP-GRADATION OF SOLAR PUMPING SYSTEM:

If a farmer Intends to upgrade the approved Solar pumping system, he (the beneficiary) will submit a written request with the Agricultural Engineer / Assistant Agricultural Engineer (DDO) of the concerned district, for up gradation of its approved Solar pumping system in order to increase the discharge. The authority after receipt of request will examine the documents on file and site feasibility and if appropriate, allow the farmer to Up-Grade its approved solar pumping system on the following grounds:

- a) The Up gradation should be at the "RISK AND COST" of the beneficiary and the quality and brands of the approved solar systems must not be changed at any cost.
- b) The components needed for up gradation should be of the same make and brands.
- c) The farmer will be bound to upgrade the solar system through the approved firm / supplier of the Directorate of Agricultural Engineering.

The additional cost of the material (PV panels, Inverter, pipes, Trackers etc.) required for Up gradation of solar pumping system shall be borne and settled / negotiated with the firm by the beneficiary himself and the Department should not be made responsible or party to any sort of dispute if cropped-up between the beneficiary and the supplier.

Provide details of civil works, equipment, machinery and other physical facilities required for the project.

Development of Culturable waste land:
The land will be reclaimed through private sector machinery under close supervision of concerned Agricultural Engineer/Assistant Agricultural Engineer.
