Incorrect. Date of birth of the appellant is 02.05.1962 and he was appointed as Driver (BPS-4) in the office of the Commissioner Hazara Division, Abbottabad on 15.7.1996 (F/5) and was terminated from Government Service on 19.5.1997 due to irregular appointment, (F/6). Length of service from 15.7.1996 to 19.5.1997 is 10 months. Due to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sacked Employees Act 2012 and in pursuance of Peshawar High Court, Abbottabad Bench's judgement, dated: 24.05.2016, appellant was appointed as Driver (BPS-6) on 2.2.2018,(F/7). Second period of service (fresh appointment) from 22.02.2018 to 01.05.2022 (date of superannuation) is 4 years, 2 months and 10 days. Total length of service of the petitioner (10 months of first timeappointment and 4 years, 2 months and 10 days of second time fresh appointment) is 05 years 10 days. Petitioner has less than 10 years service in his credit. According to Section-5 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sacked Employees Act, 2012, sacked employees shall not be entitled to claim seniority and other back benefits and appointment of sacked employee will be considered as fresh appointment. Consequently, appellant has 4 years, 2 months and 10 days service in his credit. Therefore, petitioner is not fulfilling required minimum length of Government service for financial pensionary benefits. In this regard, copies of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sacked Employees (Appointment) Act, 2012 and letter of Office of the District Comptroller of Accounts, Abbottabad have been annexed as "8-10" and "11-12" respectively. Furthermore, according to Section-3 (1) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Pension Rules, 2021, The service of a civil servant does not qualify for. pension unless it conforms to the following conditions: (a) the service shall not be less than ten years. Copy of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Pension. Rules, 2021 has been annexed as "13".

6. Incorrect. In compliance with judgement of Honourable Peshawar High Court, Abbottabad Bench,dated:12.01.2021 in Review Petition No.31-A/2018 in accordance with judgement of Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad dated:27.3.2020 in Civil Petition No.468-P,469-P,471-P and 472-P, the services of appellant Mr.Arif Khan, Driver were allowed for the protected period for consideration regarding pensionary benefits, copy of Order bearing No.CHD/Estb/1/8/3836-44, dated: 09.03.2021 issued from the Office of the Commissioner Hazara Division, Abbottabad (respondent No.2) has been annexed as "14". Copy of the said letter also issued to the office of the District Comptroller of Accounts, Abbottabad.

Later on, in compliance with Writ Petition No.506-A of 2022 filed in Honourable Peshawar High Court, Abbottabad Bench, the office of the Commissioner

Hazara Division, Abbottabad (respondent No.2) again complied with directions of the Honourable Court vide letter No. Lit./1/1/(A) 11109-12,dated:28.09.2022, copy of said letter has been annexed as "15". Copy of the said letter also issued to the office of the District Accounts Officer, Abbottabad (respondent No.3). Therefore, CM No.611-A/2022 had been disposed of, copy of Order Sheet, dated: 29.09.2022 of Honourable Divisional Bench of Peshawar High Court, Abbottabad Bench has been annexed as "16". Hence, respondent No.2 complied with the judgements/orders of the Honourable Courts.

## THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SACKED EMPLOYEES (APPOINTMENT) ACT, 2012.

### (KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA ACT NO. XVII OF 2012)

[first published after having received the assent of the Governor of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in the Gazette of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Extraordinary), dated the 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2012].

### AN ACT

o provide relief to those sacked employees in the Government service, who were dismissed, removed or terminated from service, by appointing them into the Government service.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide relief to those sacked employees who were appointed on regular basis to a civil post in the Province of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and who possessed the prescribed qualification and experience required for the said post, during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1993 to the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1996 (both days inclusive) and were dismissed, removed, or terminated from service during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1996 to 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1998 on various grounds;

WHEREAS the Federal Government has also given relief to the sacked employees by enactment;

AND WHEREAS the Government of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has also decided to appoint these sacked employees on regular basis in the public interest;

It is hereby enacted as follows:

- 1. <u>Short title, extent and commencement.</u>—(1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sacked Employees (Appointment) Act, 2012.
- (2) It shall apply to all those sacked employees, who were holding various civil posts during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> day of November, 1993 to 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1996 (both days inclusive).
  - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. <u>Definitions.</u>— In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them that is to say,-
  - (a) "civil post" means a post created by the Finance Department of Government for the members of civil service of the Province;

- (b) "Department" means the Department and the Attached Department as defined in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985, including the Divisional and District Offices working thereunder;
- (c) "Government" means the Government of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
- (d) "Prescribed" means prescribed by rules;
- (e) "Province" means the Province of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
- (f) "rules" means the rules made under this Act; and
- (g) "Sacked employee" means a person who was appointed on regular basis to a civil post in the Province of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and who possessed the prescribed qualification and experience for the said post at that time, during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1993 to the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1996 (both days inclusive) and was dismissed, removed, or terminated from service during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1996 to 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1998 on the ground of irregular appointments;
- 3. <u>Appointment of sacked employees.</u>—Notwithstanding anything contained in any law or rule for the time being in force, on the commencement of this Act, all sacked employees subject to section 7, may be appointed in their respective cadre of their concerned Department, in which they occupied civil posts before their dismissal, removal and termination from service:

Provided that the sacked employees shall be appointed against thirty percent of the available vacancies in the said Department:

Provided further that the appointment of sacked employees shall be subject to the medical fitness and verification of their character antecedents to the satisfaction of the concerned competent authority.

4. Age relaxation.— The period during which a sacked employee remained dismissed, removed or terminated from service, till the date of their appointment shall be deemed to have been automatically relaxed and there shall be no further relaxation under any rules for the time being in force.

Sacked employees shall not be entitled to claim seniority and other back benefits.--- A sacked employee appointed under section 3, shall not be entitled to any claim of seniority, promotion or other back benefits and his appointment shall be considered as fresh appointment.

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- 6. <u>Preference on the basis of age.</u>— On the occurrence of a vacancy in the respective cadre of the concerned Department of the sacked employee against the thirty percent available share, preference shall be given to the sacked employee who is older in age.
- 7. <u>Procedure for appointment.</u>—(1) A sacked employee, may file an application, to the concerned Department within a period of six months from the date of commencement of this Act, for his appointment in the said Department:

Provided that no application for appointment received after the due date shall be entertained.

- (2) The concerned Department shall maintain a list of all such sacked employees whose applications are received under sub-section (1) in the respective cadres in chronological order.
- (3) If any vacancy occurs against the thirty percent available share of the sacked employee in any Department, the senior in age from such sacked employee shall be considered by the concerned Departmental Selection Committee or the District Selection Committee, as the case may be, to be constituted in the prescribed manner, for appointment:

Provided that no willingness or response is received within a period of thirty days, the next senior sacked employee shall be considered for appointment.

- (4) The Concerned Departmental Selection Committee or District Selection Committee, as the case may be, will determine the suitability or eligibility of the sacked employee.
- (5) If no sacked employee is available against thirty percent vacancy reserved in respective cadre in a Department, then the post shall be filled through initial recruitment.
- 8. Removal of difficulties.— If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of this Act, the Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa may issue such order not inconsistent with the provision of this Act as may appear to him to be necessary for the purpose of removing the difficulty:

Provided that no such power shall be exercised after the expiry of one year from coming into force of this Act.

- 9. Act to override other laws.—Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law or rules for the time being in force, the provisions of this Act shall have overriding effect and the provisions of any other law or rules to the extent of inconsistency to this Act, shall cease to have effect.
- 10. <u>Power to make rules.</u>—Government may make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.

Therefore, this office is of the view that on attaining the age of superamuation i-e 02.05.2022 the net qualifying service of the official will be 05 years & 11days. Accordingly gratuity for each completed year of service would be paid as per rule and in light of the verdict of Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench dated 12/01/2021 "counting of services for the protected period for payment of pensionary benefits" (Copy Attached)

While, the counting of termination period as qualifying period (Protected period for payment of pensionary benefits) is contradictory with the below detailed standing rules as well as verdict of the august court under reference.

Section 5 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sacked Employees (Appointment) Aci, 2012 provides "A sacked employee appointed under section 3" shall not be entitled to any claim of seniority, promotion or other back benefits and his appointment shall be considered as fresh appointment."

Under the provisions of the Rule (3) of the Klyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Pension Rules, 2021. The past services of a civil servant, for the purpose of pension, shall not be counted in the following cases (b) removal or dismissal from service.

While under the provision of Rule 7 of the Klyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Pay Revision Rules and Allowances "the increment in the Basic Pay Scales shall fall due on 1st of December, following completion of at least six months service at stage in the relevant Basic Pay Scales".

Under the provision of Rule (1) of the Kin her Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Pension Rules, 121 The Services of Civil Servant does not qualify for pension unless it conforms to the following conditions (a) the service shall not be less than 10 years

In light of the above narrated facts it is therefore requested that necessary directions regarding the stance of this office in the matter or otherwise may be issued to save loss to the public exchequer please.

### <u>Chapter-II</u> Service Qualifying for Pension

- 3. Conditions of qualification.---(1) The service of a civil servant does not qualify for pension unless it conforms to the following conditions:
  - (a) the service shall not be less than ten years;
    - (b) the service must be paid by Government from the Provincial Consolidated Fund;
    - (c) the service of a probationer who is subsequently confirmed in a permanent post without interruption qualifies for pension;
    - (d) the time spent by a civil servant in approved training shall count as service qualifying for pension; however, the period of training before actual appointment to a civil post shall not count for pension;
    - (e) all leave, other than extra ordinary leave counts as qualifying service for the purpose of pension;

Explanation: The period of extraordinary leave shall not be treated as qualifying service for pension but only as a bridge between the two periods of qualifying service.

- (f) the period of suspension, followed by reinstatement, shall be deemed to have been the period as qualifying for pension, regardless of the fact whether the civil servant was or was not allowed full pay and allowances for the period of suspension;
- (g) time spent by a civil servant on deputation in another Government or autonomous body working under Government;
- (h) military pensionable service which ceases before a pension has been earned in respect of it, when followed by civil pensionable service, counts as part of such service;

(i)

- if a permanent post, on which a civil servant holds a lien, is abolished, under circumstances entitling him to get a compensation pension or gratuity, his service thereafter in a temporary post, under Government, qualifies for pension; and
- (j) for the purpose of grant of pension for the service in an autonomous or semi-autonomous body, the pay drawn and the effective service, rendered by a civil servant in an autonomous or semi-autonomous body, the authorized capital of which is wholly subscribed by the l'ederal or Government in a post, appointment to which is by law, required to be made and salary of which is required to be fixed by the Federal Government or Government shall be treated as pay

### ORDER:

Whereas Mr. Arif Khan Driver (BPS-6) of this office filed a Review Petition No. 31-A/2018 before Honorable Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench for review of the judgment & order of the Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench dated 06-9-2018 wherein the COC No. 44-A/2016 was dismissed to the extent of other petitioners and petitioner Mr. Arif was directed to approach the competent forum for the grievances.

And whereas the above official was initially appointed as a Driver (BPS-06) in the office of the Commissioner, Hazara Division vide order No. E/2 (10)77/51-58 dated: 15/07/1996. Later on he was terminated from services vide Order No. E/2(45)/77/6056-62 dated: 19/05/1997. Mr. Arif Khan filed a writ petition No.546-A/2013 before Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench which was decided on 24/05/2016. In pursuance of ibid judgment of Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench and in the light of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sacked Employees (Appointment) Act – 2012, Mr. Arif Khan was appointed as Driver (BPS-06) vide order No. CHD/Estb/1/2/1764-67 dated: 03/02/2018.

And whereas Mr. Arif Khan, Driver filed a review petition before Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench bearing No. 31-A/2018. The Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench disposed of the ibid petition on 12/01/2021 in accordance with Judgment of august Supreme Court of Pakistan dated: 27/03/2020 passed in civil petition No. 468-P, 469-P, 471-P and 472-P with the following observations:

"It is however observed that the petitioners will be allowed counting of their service for the protected period for payment of pensionary benefits".

Now therefore, in the light of judgment of Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench dated: 12/01/2021, the services of Mr. Arif Khan, Driver (BPS-06) are allowed for the protected period for consideration regarding pensionary benefits.
