ORDER

Munib Akhtar, J: We have had the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioners and have considered the questions of law that have been proposed for our consideration. On our asking, the learned counsel has chosen the first question as the best question of law that can be put forward by the Provincial Government in the facts and circumstances of the case. We have considered the impugned judgment of the learned Service Tribunal, which ultimately sent the matter back to the concerned department for a de-novo inquiry. Although, learned counsel has sought to persuade us to the contrary, we with respect, are not satisfied that any substantial question of law of public importance within the meaning of Article 212(3) of the Constitution is raised as would require interference by this Court. Accordingly, this petition is dismissed and leave to appeal is refused. 📢
