PRELIMINARY OBJECTION:-

- 1. The appellant has got no cause of action or locus standi to submit the instant appeal.
- 2. The appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- 3. The appellant has not come with clean hands to this Honorable Court.
- 4. Due to mis-joinder/non-joinder of necessary party, the instant appeal is liable to be dismissed.
- 5. The appeal is barred by time and law.

Respectfully Sheweth:

Facts:-

- 1. It is correct. The appellant was appointed as Sepoy on 05-05-2007 in Malakand Levies and retired as Sepoy on 11-04-2023 as per amended levy rules dated 21-10-2021.
- 2. It is correct. Malakand Levies was initially regulated under FIC rules notified in 1962.
- It is correct. On promulgation of PATA Levies Force Regulation 2012. The Provincial Government framed PATA Federal Levies Force (Amended) Rules 2013 and anomaly were removed to larger extent.
- 4. It is correct. The 2013 rules, schedule-III were further amended and anomaly were removed to larger extent as below:-

5. It is correct to the extent that before 14-07-2020 the levy rules 2013 also amended on 25-08-2016 vide Notification No. SO(Levies)HD/FLW/1-1/2013/Vol-I and further amended vide Notification issued by the Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar on 16-07-2020:-

"That all Levies Personnel shall retire from service on attaining then age of superannuation i.e. sixty (60) years or they may opt for retirement after completion of twenty five (25) years regular service"

- 6. It is incorrect. The Levy Rules was further Amended through approval of Cabinet of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide Notification issued by the Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar on 22-03-2021.
- 7. It is partially correct. The Peshawar High Court, Mingora Bench, Dar-ul-Qaza, Swat referred the Writ Petition No.732-M/2021,No.1187-M/2021,No.1206-M/2021,No.1207-M/2021, No.34- M/2022 &No.1252- M/2021 to the larger bench of Peshawar High Court vide judgment dated: 18-01-2022. The Peshawar High Court Peshawar (Larger Bench at principal seat) through single judgment dated: 29-11-2022 dismissed all the connected No.406-M/2021, No.503-M/2021, No.514-No.337-M/2021, Petitions 33-Writ M/2021,No.518-M/2021,No.450-M/2021,No.601-M/2021,No.681-M/2021,No.632-M/2021,No.919-M/2021,No.968-M/2021,No.980-M/2021,No.1221-M/2021,No.3222-No.2913-P/2021,No.5092-M/2021,No.1252-M/2021,No.2210-M/2021,No.2210-P/2021, Petitions No.333likewise Writ P/2021,No.5423-P/2021 and No.5424-P/2021 M/2021,No.334-M/2021,No.335-M/2021,No.338-M/2021,No.345-M/2021, M/2021,No.1035-M/2021,No.1187-M/2021, No.1206- M/2021,No.1207- M/2021,No.34-M/2022 No.212 No.1206- M/2021,No.1207- M/2021,,No.34- M/2022 P/20222 including COCs No.38- M/2021, No.436-P/2022 and the petitioners were directed to seek legal remedy from the Honorable Service Tribunal. (Copy enclosed as annexure-A)
- 8. It is correct. The Levy Rules was further Amended on the recommendation of anomaly committee vide Notification issued by the Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar on 21-10-2021 and service from Sepoy to Havildar were enhanced and 3-years tenure was removed.

9. It is correct. The Honorable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar dismissed all the Writ Petitions including COCs and the petitioners were directed to seek legal remedy from the Honorable Service Tribunal (Copy enclosed as annexure-B). The operating part of the judgment is reproduced as follow:

"The status of petitioners has been declared as that of Civil Servant and the matter in question revolves around the terms and conditions of their service which does fall outside the jurisdiction of this court given the baring provision of Article 212 of the Constitution and as such Instant petitions are dismissed being not maintainable. However, the petitioner may approach the worthy Service Tribunal for the redressal of their grievances if so advised"

- 10. It is correct. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Peshawar through judgment dated: 24-08-2023 disposed off the Service Appeal No. 1916/2022 titled Muhammad Salim & Others vs. Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Chief Secretary Civil Secretariat Peshawar & Others, that they would approach the proper forum for giving effect to/implementation of provisions of section-II of the Act of 2021 and in case their grievances are not addressed in accordance with the terms of the Act, they would recourse to further legal remedies available to them.
- 11. It is correct. On the recommendations of anomaly committee amendment in levy rules was made on 21-10-2021. Sequel to this at Para No.07 the minutes of anomaly committee regarding retrospective effect for beneficiary (those levy personnel already retired from service upon 03-years service tenure pursuant to the Rules notified on 22-03-2021) of new amendment 21-10-2021.

It is pertinent to mention here that both the last amendment 21-10-2021 and PATA Levy Force (Amended) Act, 2021 approved by the cabinet of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through executive summary dated 31-08-2021 for cabinet under same instrument.

In pursuance of further amendment in Levy Rules 21-10-2021 and Act 2021, total 135 including Appellant at S.No: 41 and paid salary/arrears/back benefits vide pay slip & source attached as annexure-C out of 250 Levy Personnel were reinstated into service who have not been crossed the upper age/service limit prescribed in schedule-III of amended rules 21-10-2021 and the remaining 115 levy personnel were not reinstated into service as they have already crossed their age/service as per Levy Rules 21-10-2021. (Copy of reinstatement order enclosed as annexure-D).

- 12. It is partially correct to the extent that the appellant was retired from service on completion of 45-years age as per amended Levy Rules 21-10-2021 on dated: 27/08/2023 As regard to suspension of the levy rules 21-10-2021 was in appeal of one Naib Subedar Mohtamim Khan of Malakand Levies and was only for the extent of the appellant (Mohtamim Khan) and not for the rest of others (Copy enclosed as annexure-E)
- T3. It is incorrect. As per Amended Levy Rules para-No.11, proper forum/authority for filing application regarding service rules is Secretary, Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar (Copy of Levy Rules 2013 is enclosed as annexure-F) while the applicant had filed application before the DC/Commandant Malakand Levies which was sent to Secretary, Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar through Commissioner Malakand Davison at Saidu Sharif Swat vide this office letter No.6860/LC dated 01-09-2023. Hence, action taken by this office as per law/rules. (annexure-G).
- 14. It is incorrect. This office has sought guidance/legal advice regarding implementation of the judgment passed in service appeal No.1916/2023 dated: 24-08-2023 vide letter No.7018/LC dated: 08-09-2023 from Home Department Peshawar(Copy enclosed as annexure-H).

In response to this letter, a meeting was held in Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar on 26-09-2023 under the chairmanship of Special Secretary-I, Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar with the concerned Departments i-e Establishment Department Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Finance Department, Law Department and all Deputy Commissioners and minutes were recorded and circulated (enclosed as annexure-I), wherein the following decisions are made:-

a. To examine the cases of all those Levies Personnel retired under the PATA Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules 2013 as amended on 22-03-2021 in light of Schedule-III of the PATA Levies Force (Amended) Act 2021 effective from 30-11-2021 and reinstate them in the service in compliance with both orders of Honorable Courts after checking their eligibility under the Amended Act-2021. Similarly the cases of those already reinstated in compliance with court order may be examined under the PATA Federal Service Rules, 2013 as amended on 21-10-2021 and retire them under the said amended rules.

b. The Deputy Commissioners concerned to carefully prepare and send cases for creation of supernumerary posts for reinstatement and adjustment of the

Levies retired under the previous rules in compliance with Court orders, if they do not have vacant posts for their reinstatement"

Subsequently, a scrutiny committee was notified vide this office order No.8093/LC dated 13-10-2023 (Copy enclosed as annexure-J) to examine complete details pertaining to age and service length of each individual/Levy Personnel and the proposed date of retirement as per rules. In this regard, a meeting of the scrutiny committee was held under the chairmanship of AC/Deputy Commandant (Operation) Malakand Levies on 13-10-2023. The details regarding service and proposed retirement of conditionally 72-reinstated Levies personnel of different ranks in compliance with the directions mentioned at para (a) above of Home & TA's Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar were worked out as per record duly signed by all members of scrutiny committee (Copy enclosed as annexure-K).

Hence, the subsequent reinstatement order dated 06-12-2021 of the appellant in light of minutes of the meeting of Home Department and Levy Rules 21-10-2021 stand valid by the Peshawar High Court Swat vide Judgement dated: 18-01-2022 which is reproduced below and enclosed as annexure-L:

"Claim of the petitioner is basically based upon earlier amendment to the rules brought about by same Authority on 14-07-2020. His right of retirement of superannuation has not been guaranteed by any primary law enacted by compact legislation. With bringing of amendment on 14-07-2020 in the rules, same Authority cannot deemed divested from further amendment the rules, the age of superannuation or retirement may well be changed by an authority who has initially provided same".

- A. It is incorrect. As explained at para-14 above.
- B. It is incorrect. It is mandate of the Provincial Government to amend rules.
- C. It is partially correct to the extent that the Honorable Peshawar High Court declared the appellants as civil servants for the sack of disposal of cases by the Honorable Service Tribunal. Furthermore, Pakistan Army, Frontier Constabulary are civil servants having their own Rules. Thus civil servant is basically for the terms and conditions of the appellant.
 - D. It is incorrect. As per Para-B above.
 - E. It is incorrect. The Levies Force of Tribal Districts were absorbed into Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police. However the Force of Malakand Levies is not included in the said Act, 2019 (Copy enclosed as Annexure-M) and not absorbed into Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police. Only Seven (7) agencies of Tribal district the Erstwhile FATA, Levy Force have been merged in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police. This Act relates to Districts of Erstwhile FATA Levies Force. Furthermore, Deputy Commissioner Malakand is still the Commandant of Malakand Levies Force.
 - F. The respondents seek leave to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

In view of above, it is humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may kindly be dismissed being devoid of merit on ground realities.

In alternative, they have prayed that the respondents be directed to treat them at par with erstwhile Federal Levies of Federally Administrated Tribal Area (FATA) and; absorb them in police and; grant them full pensionary benefits.

2. Likewise in W.P.Nos.333-M/2021, 334-M/2021, 335-M/2021, 338-M/2021, 345-M/2021, 1026-M/2021, 1035-M/2021, 1187-M/2021, 1206-M/2021, 1207-M/2021, 34-M/2022, 212-M/202 and 993-P/2022 the petitioners have made the following preyer:

"On acceptance of this writ petition, the impugned Notification SO (Police-II) HD/ MKD/Levies/ Misc/2020 is against law and the fundamental rights guaranteed by the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Puldatan, 1973, may be declared lilegal void ab initio and of no legal effects on the rights of the petitioners."

Similarly, in COC Nos.38-M/2021 in W.P.No.367-M/2021 and COC No.436-P/2022 in W.P.No.1335-P/2022 petitioners seek initiation of contempt of court proceedings against the respondents for violating the order of this court dated 21.04.2021 passed in W.P.No.387-M/2021.

3. Brief facts of the case(s) are that the petitioners were appointed in the "Swat Levies Force" as Sepoys etc. and presently terms and conditions of their services are regulated by Provincially Administrated Tribal Areas Levies Force Regulation 2012" whereunder besides PATA Levies Force Rules, 2012, PATA Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules 2013 were also framed. Rule 17 of the Amended Rules 2013, deals with the retirement of personnel of the force, which was amended vide notification dated 12.12.2013 in the manner that "All the personnel shall retire as per Schedule-III and no extension in service beyond retirement shall be granted". On 14.07,2020, vide Natification No.SO

Thereafter once again through certain modifications rule, 17 was amended by giving life to the deleted schedule-III of the rules 2013 as under-

"Retirement; All levy personnel shall retire as per Schedule-III and no extension in service after retirement shall be granted."

- 4. Being aggreed from the ibid amendment, the petitioners have filed the instant petitions.
- 5. Pursuant to the directions of this court respondents have filed their parawise comments, wherein issuance of the desired write has been opposed.
- 6. Learned counsel representing the petitioners vehemently argued that the

impugned Notification is arbitrary, perverse, illegal, issued without lawful authority and mala fide intention just to deprive the petitioners of their vested rights accrued in their favour hence violative of their fundamental rights guaranteed under the Constitution and thus not sustainable in the eye of law. - 9. Before discussing metits of the case we deem it appropriate to discuss the background of the matter in hand to properly comprehend the Issue involved therein. It is worth mentioning that earlier the services of the Levies Force were dealt with under the Frontier Inegular Corps (FIC) rules, 1962 which was substituted by the "Provincial Administered Tribal Areas Levies Force Regulation, 2012" (regulation) and under the said regulation "PATA Levies

While separate service rules were also framed thereunder for PATA Federal Levies Force performing duties in "PATA" known as "PATA Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules 2013. Rule 17 of the ibid rules deals with the retirement of the Levies personnel which was amended from time to time. However, petitioners have become aggrieved from the impugned Notification vide which the petitioners' retirement age was altered which is challenged by them

petitioners is that after 25th amendment the regulation has lost its efficacy and sanctity and has become redundant, therefore, the impugned amendment under the said regulation is illegal being void ab initio. It is worth mentioning that after the 25th amendment in 2018, both FATA & PATA were merged in the province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Federal Levies Force

through instant petitions.

working in FATA was merged into the regular police of the province. Albeit, in Malakand Division, Levies Force is still regulated by "PATA Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules 2013 In view of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No 111 of 2019 through which the laws prevalent in eratwhile PATA at the time of 25th amendment were allowed to continue including regulation 2012 which still holds the field and as such the same is a valid instrument. Therefore; impugned Notification was issued by the respondents with lawful authority.

petitioners it is worth mentioning that earlier this court while deciding W.P No 528-M/2016 (ligramullah's case) determined the status of personnel of the Provincial Levies Force as that of civil servants in the following terms:

"19. The Provincial Levies Force ("Force") was granted statutory cover through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Regulation No.1 of

- (6) The officers and members of the Force shall receive such pay, pension, allowances and other remunerations and shall enjoy such leave and other privileges as may be prescribed by rules.
- (7) The officers and members of the Force shall wear such uniform as may be prescribed by rules or instructions.
- (8) The administration of the Force shall vest in the Commandant in his jurisdiction, who shall administer it in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation, rules and instructions.
- (9) The Commandant shall exercise his powers and perform his functions under the general supervision and directions of Government.

21. Having said this, we would now refer to the crucial issue as to whether the employees of the Force can be termed as a civil servants and as such they cannot maintain a constitutional petition before this Court for enforcement of the terms & conditions of their service.

22. The connotation 'civil servant' is defined and explained in respect to the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, in the Civil Servants Act, 1973 ("Act, 1973"). For ease reference, we would refer to Section 2 (b) of Act, 1973, which reads as under:

*2. Definitions.—(1) In this act, unless the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say—

The Phrase "performing in connection with the affairs of Federation or for present matter Province" was elaborately explained in the case of Salahuddin and 2 others vs. Frontier Sugar Mills & Distillery Ltd.: Tokht Biral and 10 others (PLD 1975 Supreme Court 244). In the sald judgment, the Apex Court has held:

Now, what is meant by the phrase performing functions in connection with the affairs of the Federation or a Province", It is clear that the reference is to governmental or State functions, involving, in one from or another, an element of exercise of public power. The functions may be: the traditional police functions of the State, involving the maintenance of law and order and other regulatory activities; or they may comprise functions pertaining to economic development, social welfare, education, public utility service and other State enterprises of an Industrial or commercial nature. Ordinarily, these functions would be performed by persons or agencies directly appointed, controlled and financed by the State, i.e., by the

25, Admittedly, as evident from the bare reading of paragraph-3 & 4 of the Regulation, the present petitioners are performing policing service in the erstwhile tribal area, however, their terms and conditions are being regulating through Regulation No.1 of 2014 and after the omission of Article 247 from the Constitution; through a provincial statute i.e. the Khyber Continuation of Laws in the Erstwhile Provincially Administered Tribal Areas Act, 2018 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. III of 2019), the operation of Regulation No.1 of 2014 was continued. 7...Perusal of these rules clearly shows that they are all embracing, and therefore, under the emendment of section 1 of the Pakistan Rangers Ordinance, these rules would prevail over the Rules of 1973. The Paldsten Rangers Ordinance was promulgated: to constitute a force called the Pakisten Rangers for the protection of and maintenance of order in the border areas. Since with regard to the status of the members of the force the Pakistan Rangers Ordinance is silent, therefore, it can be safely said that the employees of the Pakistan Rangers will be deemed to be civil servants as they are performing duties in connection with affairs of the Federation and hence under the Service Tribunals Act, 1973, an appeal by a member of the Pakistan Rangers regarding a matter relating to terms and conditions of his service is competent before the Federal Service Tribunal...".

Firstly, under Article 240(a) of the Constitution, appointments to and the terms and conditions of service of the persons in the "service of Pekisten" are bedetermined by or under Act of Parliament, Secondly, by virtue of Article 260 of the Constitution, 'service of Paldstan' means any service, post or office in connection with the affairs of the Federation. Thirdly, under Article 212(1) (a) of the Constitution, the exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate disputes relating to the terms and conditions of persons, who are in the service of Pakistan vests in an Administrative Tribunal, namely, the Federal Service Tribunal, These tests are mentioned in the Muhammad Mubeen-us-Salam case

ibid (at pp. 686-689 of the law report). The definition of the term 'civil servant" in the Act adopts the Constitutional criteria given in Article 260 noted above to referate that a person who, inter alia, holds a civil post "in connection with the attains of the Federation" including any such post cormected with defence, to be a civil servent. The larger Bench has in this respect taken the logical step to incorporate the requirements under-Article 240 (a) and 260 of the Constitution as the definitional criteria of the term "civil servent" (at p. 682 of the law report).

7. Having noticed the qualifying criteria of a civil servent under the law, it is appropriate now to examine the factual matrix of the present controversy. The FC was established by the NWFP Constabulary Act, (Act-XIII) of 1915 ("Constabulary Act"). Section 3 of the Constabulary Act empowers the Federal Government to maintain the FC as a force for the better protection and administration of the external frontiers of Pakistan within the limits of or adjoining North-West Frontier or any pert thereof. The test laid down in Article 240(a) of Constitution requires that appointment to and the terms and conditions of service of posts in connection with the affairs of the Federation and of a service of Pakistan shall be determined by or under an Act of Parliament The expression "by or under" in Article 240(a) of the Constitution authorizes the terms and conditions of service of a civil servant to be provided both by statute or by statutory rules. The provision made in the Constabulary Act and the Constabulary Rules, therefore, satisfy the Article 240(a) test. The judgment in the Muhammed case ibid Mubeen-us-Salam · endorses this point of view:--

*86... The terms and conditions of service of those employees, however, are required to be specified under Article 240 of the Constitution by or under Act of the Parliament. Thus, the conclusion would be that only those persons, who are in the service of Pakistan, as discussed hereinabove, and if their terms and conditions are governed either by a statute or statutory rules, in terms of Article 240 of the Constitution, can seek remedy before the Service Tribunals..."







SERVICE RULES FOR FEDERAL LEVIES FORCE IN PARA

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the PAIA Levies Force Regulation, 2012 the Pravincial Government of Kliybor Pakhtunkhwa is pleased to make the following rules, namely:

- 1. Short title and commencement- (1) These rules may be called Provincially Administered Tribal Areas (PATA) Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules; 2013.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions.-(1) In these Rules, upless the context otherwise require, the following expressions bhalf have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them, namely:-
 - (a) "Appointing Authority" means the appointing outhority specified in rule-4:
 - (b) "Commandant" means Commandant of the Force, who shall be the Deputy Commissioner in their respective jurisdiction;
 - (c) "Deputy Commandant (Operation)" means an Assistant Commissioner or any officer of the District designated as such by the provincial government who shall be Deputy Commandant (Operation) of the Force in PATA, to exercise in his respective jurisdiction such powers and perform such functions as may be prescribed; and who shall be responsible to the Commandant for operational matters of the Force in PATA.
 - "Deputy Commandant (Administration)" means Deputy Commandant (Administration) of the Force, who shall be an officer of the provincial government or any officer of the District designated as such by the provincial government to exercise in his respective jurisdiction such powers and perform such functions as may be prescribed and who shall be responsible to the Commandant for administration and establishment matters of the Force in PATA.
 - "Government" means the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
 - (f) "Home Department" means Provincial Home & Tribal Affairs Department;
 - "initial recruitment" means appointment made other than by promotion or by transfer;
 - "Schedule" means the Schedule appended to these rules;

- (i) "Selection or Promotion Committee" means a Committee for recruitment or as the case may be, promotion of Force personnel as notified by the Government;
- (i) "Service" means the levies service;
- (2) The expression used but not defined herein shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them under the PATA Levies Force Regulation 2012.
- 3. Composition and eligibility of the Force (1) The Force shall comprise of the posts specified in Schedule-I and such other posts as may be determined by the Government from time to time.
- (2) Recruitment to the Force shall be made in accordance with the requirement specified in Schedule-I. No person shall be appointed unless he fulfills the following conditions:-
 - (a) The candidate shall be a citizen of Pakistan and bonafide resident of the respective district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - (b) The candidate shall be, in good mental and bodily health and free from physical defect, which likely to interfere in the efficient discharge of his duties.
 - (c) Medical Superintendent of the respective district headquarter hospital shall issue a certificate of medical fitness to the candidate.
 - (d) Recruitment to all ranks of the Force shall be made from amongst those persons having a minimum height of 5'-7" and chest measurement of 34"-35 ½ " with an age of not less than eighteen years and not more than twenty-five years on the last date of submission of application;
 - (e) No person (except those who are already in Government Service) shall be appointed to the Force unless he produces a certificate of character from the Principal of Academic Institution last attended or a certificate of character from two gazetted officers from respective districts, not being his relative and who are well acquainted with his character; and
 - (f) No person who is married to foreign national shall be eligible for appointment in the Force, unless allowed by the Government, in writing.

Appointing Authority.- (1) Commandant shall be the appointing authority for initial recruitment and premotion up to the rank of Subedar. Whereas promotion to the rank of Subedar Major and above, the authority shall rests with the provincial government.

- (2) Appointment to the post shall be made in accordance with the provisions contained in Schedule-I read with Rule-3 of these rules.
- (3) Appointment either through initial recruitment or by promotion shall be made through duly constituted Selection/promotion Committees.

Provided that in case of raising of force in a new district, the Commandant shall have the authority to recruit ex-servicemen above the rank of sepoy on contract basis for a period of one year extendable for a further period of one year but not exceeding three years in total, with prior approval of the government.

It is further provided that the ex-serviceman so appointed on contract shall not be more than forty five years of age.

5. Probation.-Persons appointed to posts by initial recruitment, promotion or transfer shall remain on probation for a period of one year extendable by a further period of one year. If no order is issued on the expiry of the first year of probation period, the period of probation shall be deemed to have been extended for further one year. If no order is issued on the completion of extended period, the probation shall be deemed to have been terminated.

Training. -(1) All newly recruited personnel of the Force shall undergo six months pre-service hing before being assigned duties of the rank for which they selected. Initially, the Appointing Authority I arrange for appropriate training till a proper Levies Training Conter is established.

(2) The pre-service training mentioned in sub-rule (1) may contain training on basic laws, estigation techniques, mob control, basic intelligence, arrest and detention procedure, jail duties, drill, apons training, field craft, bomb disposal, counter assault, traffic control, raids, watch & ward etc. per training syllabus and modules shall be developed through mutual consultation with local law forcing agencies by the Home Department.

Resignation.-No member of the Force shall resign before the expiry of the first three months of his cruitment or he shall deposit an amount equal to his three months pay in lieu of his three months sential service.

Seniority and promotion.- (1) Promotion shall be strictly on seniority cum fitness basis as well on the required and senior as specified in Schedule-I.

(2) The service of a personnel by initial recruitment, promotion or transfer may be dispensed ith or reverted if, in the opinion of the competent authority his work and conduct is not satisfactory during robation period or due to abolishment of posts, as the case may be.

Provided that in case of dispensing with their service or reversion the concerned authority shall ecord cogent reasons for such action in writing.

- (3) The seniority list of the Force shall be maintained at district level. Commandant shall be esponsible for maintaining the seniority list of the force and shall notify annually.
- B. Transfer during service. Every member of the service shall be liable to serve anywhere within PATA with the prior approval of the Commissioner Malakand Division.
- 10. Punishment. -After satisfying himself regarding punishable acts (as referred in Schedule-II) through a charge duly framed in writing, necessary punishments specified in Schedule-IV may be awarded by the respective authority.

Provided that punishment so awarded shall be duly incorporated in service rolls / service dossier accordingly.

- 11. Appeal. If any personnel of the force is aggrieved by any order issued under these rules, within thirty days of communication to him of such order, may prefer an appeal to the competent authority.
- Provided that no appeal shall lie against the punishments specified at S.No. (1) and (2) of Schedule IV.
- 12. Awards and commendations. –(1) Force personnel may be given special award and commendation certificate for devotion to duty, demonstration of gallantry and such achievement in the performance of duty, in the manners as prescribed by the Commandant, and shall be made part of the service rolls / service dossier.
- (2). Force personnel, if embraces martyrdom in the discharge of his duty, will be given proper Guard of Honour at the time of burial.
- 13. Service Record. -Proper service rolls / service dosslers of all Force Personnel shall be maintained in Levy Office of each district. Annual reports of all Havaldars and Junior Commissioned Officers (JCOs) will also be maintained for the purpose of promotion.
- 14. Uniform. The levy personal shall attire black shalwar gamees with brown chappli, white socks, black barrette cap and black belt whereas the JCOs will wear brown belt during duty hours.
- 15. Leave.- (1) Leave may be granted depending on the exigencies and at the discretion of the Commandant. All leave of ten days or above, will be considered as long leave and shall be granted on the recommendations of Subedar Major by the Commandant.

- 23. Monitoring and evaluation. (1) Commandant or Deputy Commandant of the Force shall set up suitable number of levy posts in their respective jurisdiction and shall assign suitable number of Force personnel at each of such levy post. In case of establishment of Levies Station within their jurisdiction shall require prior approval of the government.
- There shall be levy line in each district, which shall have all necessary facilities including paradeleround, barracks, quarter guards, koth/armoury etc.
- (3) Duty Register showing the duties assigned to each individual on day-to-day basis shall be maintained in each levy post / Lavy Station/Levy Lines by a lavy Muhadr.
- (4) Naib Subedar shall be responsible for carrying out the work assigned to Force personnel whose duties shall be entered in advance in the duty register.
- (5) Registers including roznamohas as prescribed by the Commandant shall be maintained in every levy post/Station/Lines.
- (6) Commandant Deputy Commandant or any other officer of the District Administration shall continue course of their tours in their jurisdiction, may inspect duty register and roznamchos of composts/stations and satisfy themselves that Force Personnel are carrying out their assigned duties. - is engaged or is reasonably suspected of being engaged to excite, cause or conspire to cause or joins in any mutiny, or being present at any mutiny and does not use his utmost endeavor to suppress it;
- attempts collective bargaining, conspiring or attempting to call off duty or take procession to press for the demands; or
- is guilty of omission and commission under the law and rules.

- Being a sentry, sleeps upon his post or quits it without being regularly relieved or without leave; or
- Without authority, leaves his commanding officer, or his post or party, to go in search of 0. plunder, or
- Quits his guard, picquet, party or patrol without being regularly relieved or without leave; or
- Uses criminal force to, or commits an assault on, any person bringing provisions or other necessaries to camp or quarters, or without authority breaks into any house or any other place for plunder, or plunders, destroys, or damages any property of any kind; or

Internally causes or spreads a false alarm or rumour during action or in post, camp, lines, or quarters.





The meeting was started with the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran.

At the outset, the Chair welcomed the participants and apprised them that the meeting was held pursuant to the requests of the Deputy Commissioners to this department regarding the recent Order of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal in respect of the reinstalement of lavies personnel into the service.

List of participants utlached.

After opening remarks by the worthy Special Secretary-I Khyber Pokhlunkhwa Home and Tribal alfairs Department, he was briefed on the Levies Force functioning in different districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhyra regulating under PATA Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules, 2013 amended from time to time. The last two amendments were brought on 22-03-2021 and 21-10-2021 vide Notifications No. SO(POLICE-II)HDMKDN-3/LEVIES/Misc./2020 SO(POLICE-II)HD/1and SIFEDERAL LEVIES 2021 of Kyber Pakhlunkhwa Home and Tribal affairs Department respectively. Both Notifications No. SO(POLICE-II)HD/MKD/1-3/LEVIES/Misc./2020 and SO(POLICE-II)HD/1-3/FEDERAL LEVIES 2021 of Kyber Pakhtunkhwa Home and Tribal allairs Department have laid down the criteria for retirement of the Federal Levies Force.

Moreover, it was briefed that Section-11 of the PATA Levies Force (Amendment) Act-2021 was brought on 30-11-2021 to reinstate all levies Personnel retired from 22-03-2021 till the commencement of the Act. Section-11 is reproduced

Re-instatement of the levies personnel.— All levies personnel, who have been relired from the Force with elfoct from 22-03-2021, till the commencement of the Provincially Administrated Tribal Arona Lovina Force (Amendment) Act, 2021 shall be reinstated in the Force as regular employees, willt effect from their respective dates of retirement and they shall be deemed as never relired from the Force.

After briefing to the Chair, the forum was opened for discussion to deliberate on reinstatement of levies personnel under Section 11 of the Act in light of the Judgment of the Honourable Peshawar High Court, Mingora Bench in writ patitions no. 1281-M/2022 and 1283-M/2022 dated: 25-11-2022, legal opinion of the Advocate General, Khyber Falchluckhwa on Malakand Lautes dated: 17-08-2023 and Order of Honourable Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal in appeal No. 162/2023 dated:

The Judgment of the Renoutable Performer their Court, Mingore Bench in with petitions No. 1281 6672002 and 1283-Mi7022 was discussed. The following paras of

Accordingly, both those connected writ patitions bearing No. 1281-M of 2022 and 1283-M of 2022 are allowed and the patitioners are reinstated in service of the Levies Force with affect from the date of their retirement and it shall be deamed that they have never been retired and consequently the respondents are directed to issue formal orders of their reinstatement in service in light of Section 11 of the Act of 2021. Order accordingly.

The forum discussed legal opinion solicited on Malakand Layles from Advocate General, Khyber Pakhlunkhwa, regarding the reinstatement of relired Levies personnel, Some part of the opinion reproduced here;

It is worth mentioning that after the 25th Constitutional Amendment in 2018 both FATA and PATA were marged in the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and the Federal Levies Force working in FATA was merged into the regular Police Force of the Province, however, toyles force in Melekand Division is still regulated by PATA Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules, 2013 in view of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. 111 of 2019 through which the laws prevalent in erstwhile PATA at the time of 25th Constitutional Amendment were allowed to continue including PATA Levies Force Regulation, 2012. It is pertinent to mention here that PATA Federal Levies Service Rules, 2013 were amended from time to time and the last amendment was brought on 21-10-2021, therefore all those personnel who are conditionally reinstated in compliance of the Judgment of the Honourable Peshawar High Court, Mingorn Bench shall be governed under the PATA Federal Levies Force Service (Amended), 2013 as amended lastly en 21-10-2021."

The Order of the Khyber Pakhlunkhwa Service Tribunal was also discussed by the forum.

The para of the Order reproduced here;

"Whan confronted with the provisions of the newly added section 11 of the Act of 2021, whereby, all Levies personnel, who had relired from the Force w.e.f 22-03-2021 till the commencement of the Act, i.e. 30-11-2021, were reinstated as regula employees w.o.f. from respective dates of retirement and were deemed to have never retired from the Force. The learned counsel was very fair to say that there was nothing more to be resolved by this Tribunal in these appeals, so as the agreement of other learned counsels as well as appellants present before the

ness to the commend that even the provisions of the Act were not complied maxinplemented by the respondents. They say they would approach the proper form for giving effect to/implementation of the provisions of Section 11 of the Act of 2021 and in case their grievances are not addressed in accordance with the terms of the Act, they would recourse to further legal remedies evallable to them. Disposed of in the above terms."

Following the detailed deliberations on the above points, the forum arrived to the conclusion that:

The Judgment of the Honorable Peshawar High Court, Mingora Bench had reinstated the levies personnel and had directed the respondents to Issue their formal orders of reinstatement into the Service.

Both the Judgment of Honorable Peshawar High Court Mingora Bench as well in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal were examined in detail. Whereas the Judgment of the Honorable Peshawar High Gourt Mingora Bench carries clear order with regard to reinstatement of the appellants, the Judgment of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal is advisory in nature and does not direct the Government for reinstatement of the appellants. Rather it asks for compliance of our own amendment Act passed on 30-11-2021,

Moreover, Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in his legal opinion had categorically stated that all those Personnel who are conditionally reinstated into the service in compliance with the Judgment of the Honorable Peshawar High Court Mingora Bench shall be governed under the PATA Federal Levies Service Rules, 2013 as amended on 21-10-2021.

After detailed deliberations and threadbare discussion, the following decisions were taken by the forum:

1. To examine the cases of all those Levies Personnel retired under the PATA Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules 2013 as amended on 22-3-2021 in light of Schedule-Illof the PATA Levies Force (Amended) Act 2021 effective from 30-11-2021 and reinstate them in the service in compliance with both orders of Honorable Courts after checking their eligibility under the amended Act-2021. Similarly the cases of those already reinstated in compliance with court order may be examined under the FATA Federal Service Rules, 2013 as amended on 21-10-2021 and retire them under the sold amended rules.

2. The Deputy Commissioners concerned to carefully prepare and send case for creation of supernumerary posts for reinstalement and adjustment of the lavies retired under the provious rules in compliance with court orders.

If they do not have vacant posts for their roinstatement.

In W.P Nos. 1187-M/2021, 1206-M/2021, 1207-M/2021 and 34-M/2022, petitioners are partly aggrieved of interim orders of this Court passed in W.P. No. 2210-P/2021 and W.P. No. 732-M/2021, whereby further appointments in all the levies force had been ordered to be stopped. To said extent, their writ petitions are not at all maintainable but they have also been seeking a restraining order against their retirement and have raised grievances against the impugned Rules as well, which are holding the field at the moment. An ad-interim injunction in one case cannot be challenged by filing a separate writ petition. So far as grievances of the petitioners's arising from the prevalent Rules are concerned, such grievances may be heard by the larger Bench finally but at the moment, they were not found having a prima facie case for suspending operation of the Rules and extending their age of retirement. In case, where vires of the law or Rules are challenged, then interim relief cannot be granted. Reliance in this respect may be placed on judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan given in the case of Federation of Pakistan vs. Aitzaz Ahsan and

- 13. Indemnity.—Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Act, no suit, prosecution or other legal proceedings shall lie against any member of the Levies Force. Government or any other authority for anything which is done in good faith or intended to be done under this Act or the rules.
- Explanation: The phrase "good faith" shall have the same meaning as given to it in section 52 of the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 (Act No.XLV of 1860).
- 14. Removal of difficulties.—If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of this Act, the Departmentmay notify a committee to take a decision not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, as may appear to it to be necessary for the purpose of removing the difficulty.
- 15. Repeal and savings.—(1) The Federal Levies Force Regulation, 2012and the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Levies Force Ordinance, 2019 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Ordinance No.III of 2019) are hereby repealed.
