Respectfully Sheweth;

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS

1. The appeal is not maintainable in the present form.
2. The Appellant has no locus standi and cause of action to bring the present appeal.
3. The appeal is time barred and hit by limitations.
4. The appeal is non-maintainable for mis-joinder and non-joinder of proper parties.

ON FACTS:

1. No comments.
2. Correct to the extent that the appellant was appointed as Range Officer Wildlife (BPS-16) on 20/11/2008 upon recommendation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission. *Tamir Daktori*
3. Correct to the extent that the appellant applied afresh for the post of Sub-Divisional Wildlife Officer (BPS-17) and after going through fresh competition, she was recommended by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission as Sub-Divisional Wildlife Officer (BPS-17) and appointed on 03/10/2014 against the post of Sub Divisional Wildlife Officer falling to the initial recruitment quota.
4. In Correct. The appellant has concealed the facts from the Tribunal because the Method of Recruitment to the post of Divisional Wildlife Officer (BS-18) is "by promotion from amongst the holder of the post of Sub Divisional Wildlife Officer (BPS-17) on seniority-cum fitness having five years' Service as such & passing of departmental Examination". According to online Collin's Dictionary definition the phrase "AS SUCH" means i) "with respect

to its inherent nature, or when used after a noun it means considering a thing on its own, separately from other things / factor. Therefore, 05-Years Regular Service in BS-17 is must for promotion to BS-18 in *accord with existing Service Rules of Wildlife Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa*. The Appellant mentioned the relevant portion of Promotion Policy 2008. However, Service Rules for a post framed on the recommendation of Standing Service Rules Committee (SSRC) are superior to the policy. Policy guidelines are issued by the Govt as a general procedure for all kind of promotions and length of service prescribed in the policy is applied when no specific length is mentioned in the Rules, as promotion is always made on existing Service Rules of the concerned Deptt: to specific post / vacancy subject to many other fitness parameters. (Copy of notification dated 08/10/2007 of Service Rules relating the post of Divisional Wildlife Officer is attached for ready reference **Annex-I**). Moreover, the appellant has already availed the Benefits of BS-18 w.e.f. 17/01/2018 on appointment on Acting Charge Basis according to Rule 9(1) of the APT Rules, 1989 (**Annex-II**) and when she completed 05 Years' Service in BS-17, then promoted on regular basis on 13/07/2020 vide notification No. SO(Estt)/FE&WD/II-8/2020 (**Annex-III**). ***It is noteworthy that service in lower grade (BS-16 & below) is countable towards length of service for promotion to BS-18 only if the holder of BS-16 post moves to BS-17 and BS-18 through promotion, whereas the appellant was selected to BS-17 as a fresh candidate by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission through competitive process.***

5. In-correct. As already explained in Para 4 above, the applicant has concealed the facts from the Tribunal.
 6. Incorrect. The appellant is misleading the Tribunal. The fact is that the appellant filed departmental appeal for alteration of Seniority List of the post of Deputy Conservator Wildlife/Divisional Wildlife Officer (BPS-18), however the appeal of the appellant was rejected by the competent authority **partially** as per prevailing rules with the condition that all financial benefits of previous service in BS-16 may be given to the applicant as per rules and policy. As confirmed from the Budget & Accounts Cell of this Department all previous financial benefits of BS-16 as well as financial benefit of appointment on Acting Charge Basis (A.C.B) in BS-18 have already been given to the appellant properly (**Annex-IV**). It is pointed out that as evident from Column 4 Sr. No.13 of the Seniority List **20.11.2008** is reflected as date of 1st entry into Government Service and 13.07.2020 reflected as the date of appointment to the present post i.e. BS-18 (**Annex-V**). It is pointed out that length of service alone is not determining factor in determination of seniority in a cadre or service. In terms of Section-8(3) read with Rule-17(1) (a) and 17 (2), seniority, in case of initial appointment, is determined on the


basics of merit assigned by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission and date of regular appointment. As pointed out at para-1 above, the appellant was appointed to BS-17 through initial recruitment by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission.


7. As already explained in paras 5 & 6, the appellant is not an aggrieved person and merely wasted the precious time of the Court/Tribunal as well as the Govt/Deptt. Therefore, the Instant Service Appeal may be dismissed straightaway with cost.




- A). Pertains to record, hence needs no comments.

In view of the above exposition, it is most humbly prayed that the instant service appeal may kindly be dismissed with cost being devoid of merit as the appellant has been treated according to existing Service Rules & Policy of the Provincial Govt, please.




