Home & Tribal Affairs Department vide letter dated 13.12.2022 (**Annex-II**) sought opinion of Establishment Department upon the decision of DPC meeting dated 28.12.2018 regarding deletion of Rule 9(2) of APT Rules. The Establishment Department vide its letter dated 13.03.2023 (**Annex-III**) conveyed that DPC had miss-interpreted Rule 9(2) of APT Rules and advised that the promotion case may be re-submitted to DPC for resolving the issue. The matter was again placed before DPC, which, in its meeting dated 25.09.2023 (**Annex-IV**) reconsidered the matter and in light of the opinion of Establishment Department, recommended that 14 senior clerks, including the Appellant, be promoted on Acting Charge Basis, with effect from 11.02.2019 and thereby the impugned order dated 08.08.2023 was issued. It is pertinent to mention here that vide a recent Promotion order dated 18.10.2023 (**Annex-V**), the Appellant along with some other Senior Clerks, have been promoted on Regular Basis, due to availability of vacant posts of Office Assistant BS-16.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF DEPARTMENTAL PROMOTION COMMITTEE

5

A meeting on the subject was held on 28th December, 2018 at 1100 hours under the chairmanship of Special Secretary, Home & Tribal Affairs Department in his office.


02. The meeting commenced with the recitation from the Holy Quran, after which, the Chair welcomed the participants and invited DG Prosecution to present the case.


03. The Director General Prosecution apprised the Departmental Promotion Committee that Seventeen (17) posts of Office Assistants (BS-16) fall under the promotion quota in the Directorate of Prosecution as well as District Public Prosecutors offices in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. According to Serial No.8 (b) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Prosecution Service Rules 2005, amended in 2010 and 2013, the method of promotion of Senior Clerks to the next higher rank of Office Assistant is 75% by promotion on the basis of Seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Senior Clerks (BPS-14), with at least five (05) years service as Junior Clerk and Senior Clerk. It was further elaborated that 15 Assistants have recently been appointed as Superintendent (BS-17) on acting charge basis.

04. Keeping in view the above, 17 Senior Clerks are required to be appointed as Office Assistant on Acting Charge Basis, including those three senior clerks who were not promoted in previous DPC due to inquiry pending against them. It was pointed out that Sub rule (2) of Rule-9 of the Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989 had been deleted vide Notification No. SOR-VI(E&AD)1-3/2009/Vol-VIII, dated 22-10-2011. Hence, the committee recommended the following 17 Senior Clerks (BS-14) for promotion as Assistant (BS-16) on regular basis.



1. I am directed to refer to your letter SOR-III(E&AD)4-2/2022 dated 23.11.2022 on the subject noted above and state that this Department vide letter of even number dated 05.09.2022 (copy enclosed for ready reference) has intimated that promotion case of (14) Senior Clerks (BPS-14) to the post of Assistant (BPS-16) in the Directorate General Prosecution was placed before the Departmental Promotion Committee to consider promotion against (01) post on regular basis and (13) posts on acting charge. It is pertinent to mention here that earlier (15) Assistants were appointed as Superintendents (BPS-17) on acting charge basis, resultantly the posts of Assistant were available for promotion on acting charge basis.

2. The Departmental Promotion Committee recommended all (14) Senior Clerks for promotion as Assistant on regular basis instead of acting charge on the grounds that sub-Rule-2 of Rule-9 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (APT) Rules, 1989 has been deleted vide notification No.SOR-VI(E&AD)1-3/2009/Vol-VIII dated 22.10.2011.

3. This Department vide letter of even number dated 05.09.2022 has therefore, requested for your advice as to whether the Senior Clerks promoted on regular basis on the grounds of deletion of rule 9(2) of APT Rules, 1989 against the posts which were not actually available for regular promotion is correct or otherwise.

4. I am, therefore, directed to request you that the matter may be re-considered and guide this department to resolve the issue of seniority as intimated vide this Department letter of even number dated 05.09.2022, please.

Subject: MINUTES OF THE DEPARTMENTAL PROMOTION COMMITTEE'S (DPC) MEETING HELD ON 25.09.2023 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SPECIAL SECRETARY-I, HOME & TA'S DEPARTMENT

A meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) was held on 25-09-2023 at 11:00 AM under the Chairmanship of Special Secretary-I, Home and Tribal Affairs Department in his office. The following attended the meeting:

1. Mr. Akbar Ali Khan, Special Secretary-I, Home & Tribal Affairs Department Chairman.
2. Mr. Sadaqat Ullah Deputy Secretary (R-II), Establishment Department
3. Mr. Fazal Qayyum Khattak, Deputy Secretary (Judicial), Home & Tribal Affairs Department
4. Mr. Sikandar Khan, Dy. Director (Admn) Directorate of Prosecution, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

2. The meeting started with the recitation from the Holy Quran. The Chair welcomed the participants and asked the Deputy Secretary Judicial, Home & Tribal Affairs Department to brief the forum in the instant case. The Deputy Secretary (Judicial) briefed the forum on the following two point's agenda:

- i) Promotion of (28) Acting charge Assistants (BPS-16) on regular basis.
- ii) Promotion of (01) acting charge Senior Scale Stenographer-BPS-16) on regular basis

AGENDA ITEM NO.1: (Promotion of (28) Acting charge Assistants (BPS-16) on regular basis)

3. The Deputy Secretary (Judicial) apprised the forum that total sanctioned strength of Assistant (BPS-16) in the Directorate of Prosecution is (50) posts, out of which 25% quota has been reserved for initial recruitment i.e (12.5 posts). 37.5 posts @ 75% come to the share of promotion quota. Presently 10 posts of Assistant (BPS-16) have been filled on regular basis, while 28 Senior Clerks (BS-14) are working as Assistants on acting charge basis. As per Prosecution Service Rules, for promotion to the post of Assistant (BPS-16), five years' service is required as Senior Clerk and Junior Clerk.

RECOMMENDATIONS

5. The Departmental Promotion Committee recommended the above mentioned (28) acting charge Assistant (BPS-16) for promotion as Assistants on regular basis with immediate effect i.e. date of notification.

AGENDA ITEM NO.2: (Promotion of (01) acting charge Senior Scale Stenographer-BPS-16) on regular basis)

6. The forum was informed that there are two sanctioned posts of Senior Scale Stenographer (BPS-16) in the Directorate of Prosecution. However, only one post has been filled through appointment of Mr. Muhammad Zahid, Junior Scale Stenographer (BPS-14) on acting charge basis due to less length of service. As per Service Rule, the post of Senior Scale Stenographer (BPS-16) is required to be filled by promotion from amongst the holder of the post of Junior Scale Stenographer (BPS-14) with at-least five years' service as such.

7. Mr. Muhammad Zahid, Junior Scale Stenographer (BPS-14) was initially appointed on 07.08.2018 in the Public Safety Commission of Home and Tribal Affairs Department. He was appointed as Junior Scale Stenographer (BPS-14) in the Directorate of Prosecution on 17.12.2018 through proper channel. The required length of service for regular promotion to the post of Senior Scale Stenographer is five years as Junior Scale Stenographer.

8. The representative of Establishment Department was of the view that the incumbent has not completed the required length of service as he has joined the present post on 18.12.2018. His previous service rendered in Public Safety Commission could not be counted for the purpose of seniority. Therefore, his case for regular promotion to the post of Senior Scale Stenographer is required to be dropped due to less length of service.

RECOMMENDATIONS

9. After threadbare discussion, the Departmental Promotion Committee decided to defer the case.
