That the respondents submit as under:-

#### **PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:**

- 1. That the appellant, namely, Mr.Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) has got no cause of action and locus standi to file the instant service appeal.
- 2. That the appellant has not come to the Hon'ble Tribunal with clean hands and has been filed with malafide intentions.
- 3. That the appeal is barred by law and limitation.
- 4. That the appeal is bad for mis joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.

#### **PARA-WISE REPLY ON FACTS: -**

1. The contents of para No.01 of the service appeal is partially correct to the extent that the appellant, namely, Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) was initially appointed as Junior Clerk (BPS-11) on 13-11-2006 and rest of the para is sternly denied as he remained habitually absent from duty without any permission or intimation and so many occasions, warning was issued to him to be careful in future, but he did not mend his ways. It would not be out of place to state here that in multiple inquiries regarding his willfully absence; from official duties and his negligent behavior during performance of his official duties, minor and major penalties were imposed upon the appellant (copies of the orders are annexed as annexure "A" and "B" respectively). It is further, pertinent to note that, he has also submitted unconditional apology in written form in some of the inquiries and requested to give him a final chance, and promised to mend his ways/habits of negligence and habitual absence from duty (Copy of unconditional apology, copy of order sheet No.06 dated 16-12-2020 pertaining to the Final Show Cause Notice issued vide letter bearing No.2394/DSJ dated 19-10-2020, copy of order sheet No.02 dated 16-12-2020 pertaining to the explanation regarding non-issuance of warrant of arrest against the delinquent official besides the directions of the court, copy of order sheet No.02 dated 16-12-2020 pertaining to the inquiry dated 20-06-2020 are annexed as annexure "C, C-1 & C-2", "D & D-1" and "E & E-1" respectively).

2. The contents of Para No. "02 to 08" of the service appeal pertaining to facts relating to initiating of disciplinary proceedings till its conclusion are against the facts, hence forcefully denied. The allegations against the delinquent official, namely, Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) were established after complying the proper procedure as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised) which was adopted by the Inquiry Officer as well as Competent Authority. It is relevant to state here that, the Superintendent, District Courts, Lakki Marwat submitted his report on 27/01/2022 regarding willful absence of the appellant/Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) who was posted as Muharrir in the court of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-II, Lakki Marwat w.e.f 06-01-2022 to 27-01-2022 without any prior permission/leave or intimation. The superintendent, further stated that, although appellant/Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) had submitted his application along with medical prescription regarding grant of 15 days earned leaves on medical grounds (w.e.f 06-01-2022 to 20-01-2022) on 06-01-2022 duly forwarded by learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-II, Lakki Marwat, but on the said application, this office sent a letter bearing No.79/DSJ dated 06-01-2022 to M.S City Hospital, Lakki Marwat for verification of the medical prescription chit of the appellant "Muhammad Suelman Yousaf". In response to the said letter of this office, the M.S City Hospital, Lakki Marwat submitted through letter bearing No.07/M-I dated 07-01-2022 that; "The medical prescription bearing No.696 dated 05-01-2022 and bearing long leave of 15 days in respect of Muhammad Suleman Yousaf Junior Clerk is not countersigned and hence leave is not verifiable from this office....." . After receiving this letter, this office approached M.S DHQ Hospital, Lakki Marwat, vide letter bearing No.85/DSJ/L.K dated 08-01-2022 for medically re-examination of the appellant named Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk and for submission of second medical opinion as per revised leave Rules-1981. In response to the said letter, the M.S, DHQ Hospital, Lakki Marwat constituted a medical board vide order letter bearing Endst: No.123-26/M.B dated 12-01-2021 and directions were issued to the delinquent official by the MS DHQ Hospital, Lakki Marwat, as well as by this office through official telephone for appearance before the Medical Board on 17-01-2022 at 10:00 AM for the said purpose, but the appellant did not appear before the constituted board. The Superintendent of this office further submitted that, no information had been received from appellant / Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk and also that he had not applied for any other kind of leave.

As per report of Superintendent, his request, which was also not allowed, was only for 15 days, but he remained absent from duty, till the date of report i.e. 27-01-2022 and later on also remained continuously absent without any prior permission/application till the conclusion of inquiry.

In pursuance to the sub-rule-06 pertaining to **Suspension** under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules-2011 (Revised), the services of Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) were placed under Suspension for 90 days or till further order vide this office order bearing endorsement No. 303-307/DSJ/L.M dated 27-01-2022 and later on it was extended for further period of ninety days vide this office order No.74/DSJ/L.M dated 20-04-2022 and formal proceedings were initiated.

First Show Cause Notice was issued vide letter bearing No. 308/D&SJ/Admn dated 27-01-2022, but no reply was submitted within the given time by the appellant/delinquent official, therefore another chance for submission of his reply was given through final show cause notice which was issued in continuation with the first show cause notice, vide this office letter bearing No.387/D&S.J/Admn dated 08-02-2022 to the said accused official and also dispatched through registry of the post office and its service upon him also ensured through his brother Mr. Adnan Yousaf, Bailiff working in the establishment of the Senior Civil Judge (Admn), Lakki Marwat.

Despite of the above, the appellant/delinquent official did not submit his reply deliberately within the stipulated time despite being informed of the proceedings.

On 23-02-2022, he attended the office of Superintendent for the purpose of submission his reply when written reply was checked on the spot, the enclosures mentioned in reply were not found annexed, so his reply was returned on the spot for submission of the same after completion in all respect. He was also directed to regularly attend his official duties, but he left the office deliberately and left without any prior permission/application or intimation.

Similarly, on 24-02-2022, he once again attended the office and submitted his reply and left the office deliberately and left without any prior permission/application.

The written reply of the delinquent official was found not satisfactory and formal disciplinary proceedings were initiated against him and his salary was stopped forthwith; so as to ensure the principle of "No work, No pay".

In this backdrop, he was charge sheeted, as well as statement of allegations was issued to him and proper formal Inquiry was conducted and after adopting proper procedures as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government

Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised), the inquiry officer recommended major penalty against the delinquent official.

Final Show Cause Notice was issued vide this office letter bearing No.3718-19/DSJ/L.M dated 15-07-2022 along with affording the opportunity of personal hearing, but he did not avail the same, he only submitted his reply through his cousin on 18-07-2022.

In light of the above mentioned facts, the allegations against the delinquent official were proved and he was found guilty of "Inefficiency", "Misconduct" and "Habitually & willfully absenting himself from official duties without prior permission" as specified in Rule: 03 (a)(b)(c) and thus, while agreeing with the findings of the learned Inquiry Officer, major penalty as enumerated in Rule: 4(1)(b)(ii) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 was imposed upon the delinquent official Mr.Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) and he was awarded major penalty of compulsory retirement w.e.f. 05-01-2022 as he remained absent without permission/leave or intimation from 06-01-2022 onwards (copy of compulsory retirement is annexed as annexure "F & F-1").

It is also submitted here that proper procedure as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised) was adopted by the Inquiry Officer, as well as Competent Authority. Despite so many chances given to him, he did not resume his official duty deliberately as he was busy in his private business and activities. For the purpose of examining of his willful absence, even during the course of inquiry, Order sheet No. 04 dated 25-02-2022 and order sheet No. 22 dated 19-07-2022 clearly indicate his willful absence and delinquent attitude towards his office decorum and discipline (Copies of order sheets and report of Superintendent are annexed as annexure "G", "G-1" & "G-2").

The punishment in the shape of compulsory retirement from his service, was awarded by the competent Authority on proof of charge, against delinquent ex-official, appellant namely, Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) in accordance with law under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011(Revised). As it is already stated that the appellant was habitually absenting himself from duty without permission or intimation and innumerable chances were afforded to him to mend his ways and to ensure his regular attendance during performance of his duties but, he was always making lame excuses to justify his willful absence and always submitted unauthorized medical certificates for bed rest (Copies of the letters/replies of M.S City Hospital are annexed as annexure "H & H-1" respectively).



3. The contents of para No. 09 are also strongly denied. It is pertinent to mention here that after laps of almost more than 10 months, the appellant filed departmental appeal on 13-07-2023 against the order dated 22-08-2022 regarding his compulsory retirement from service

#### **PARA-WISE REPLY ON GROUNDS: -**

- A. The contents of Para No. "A", of the grounds are sternly denied. As the case of appellant / Muhammad Suleman Yousaf was purely treated in accordance with Law, Rules and Policy by the respondent/competent authority and proper procedure as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised) was adopted by the Inquiry Officer as well as Competent Authority.
- B. The contents of Para No. "B" of the grounds are also strongly denied. Final Show Cause Notice was issued vide this office letter bearing No.3718-19/DSJ/L.M dated 15-07-2022 along with affording him the opportunity of personal hearing, but he did not avail the same, he only submitted his reply through his cousin on 18-07-2022. As the appellant remained willfully absent from duty w.e.f. 06-01-2023, therefore, his case was treated under the principle, of "No work No pay" for the said period. The appellant was compulsorily retired w.e.f. 05-01-2023 after complying with the proper procedure as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised).
- C. The contents of Para No. "C" of the grounds are also strongly denied. The allegations against the delinquent official, namely, Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk (BPS-11) were established after complying the proper procedure as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised) which was adopted by the Inquiry Officer as well as Competent Authority and he was awarded major penalty of compulsory retirement w.e.f. 05-01-2022 instead of dismissal from service as he remained absent without permission/leave or intimation from 06-01-2022 till the conclusion of entire proceedings.
- D. The contents of Para No. "D" of the grounds are also firmly denied. As so many chances for defense were given to appellant, but he did not come to put his defense, because he remained, indolent, and willfully deliberately absented himself from his duties. It is also worth mentioning here that, from the date of his absence i.e. w.e.f. 06-01-2022 to 19-08-2022 (for almost more than 07 months), he did not bother to attend his duties, even for a single day. He was awarded major penalty of compulsory retirement after complying the proper procedure as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants

f

(Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised) which was adopted by the Inquiry Officer as well as Competent Authority.

- E. The contents of Para No. "E", of the grounds are totally denied. As the final show cause notice was issued in continuation of First show cause, in fact a chance for submission of reply was given to the appellant/delinquent official. but he did not submit his reply within the stipulated period, after that, he was charge sheeted as well as statement of allegations was also issued to him; Similarly, proper formal inquiry was conducted and after receipt of inquiry report in the matter, Final Show Cause notice regarding communication of penalties, with respect to his charges as proved and affording of opportunity of personal hearing for his defense, was issued against the appellant/delinquent official, namely, Muhammad Suleman Yousaf, Ex-Junior Clerk, but he did not avail the opportunity of personal hearing, as he being guilty had nothing to say in his defense. In short, it is crystal clear, that the case of the appellant/Muhammad Suleman Yousaf was purely treated in accordance with Law, Rules and Policy by the respondent/competent authority and proper procedure as given under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 (Revised) was adopted by the Inquiry Officer as well as Competent Authority.
- F. The contents of Paras No. "F to H" of the grounds are absolutely denied, they are related to matters of fact, and in that respect detailed reply has already been given in the preceding paras No. "A, B, C, D & E".

In light of the above para wise comments, the Service Appeal filed by appellant/Ex-official, may kindly be dismissed with cost.
