PARA WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH: -

That the respondents from 1 to 3 submit as under:

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:

- 1. That the present appellant was appointed as AT BPS-15 through NTS and as per 2017 Act and regularization Notification 2018 the seniority was framed accordingly. Hence the appellant has no cause of action and the instant appeal is liable to be dismissed.
- 2. That the present Appeal of the Appellant is not maintainable in its present form.
- 3. That the Appellant has logged the instant Appeal to waste the precious time of this Honorable Services Tribunal.
- 4. That the case of the Appellant is devoid of merit and having no legal force.
- 5. That the appeal of the appellant is barred by law and limitation.
- 6. That the appeal is bad for misjoinder and non-joinder of the necessary parties.

ON FACTS:

- 1. That Para No 1 is incorrect and denied, as the tentative seniority list was widely circulated through social media, and notice board as well as WhatsApp groups and then appeals were entertained but the present appellant has submitted his appeal in a belated stage which was not entertainable after the stipulated time period which was given for appeal. Hence the appeal of the appellant was treated as time barred as per section-4 of the Services Tribunal Act. (Annexure A)
- 2. That Para No 2 is correct to the extent of appointment of the appellant and his employment in the police department. Moreover, he has served as constable BPS-05 in police department and pay protection was accorded as per law, rules and policy. The appellant applied for the post of AT (BPS-15) under the advertisement dated: 11-01-2014 purely on adhoc basis. His seniority will be determined under 2017 Regularization Act wherein all the adhoc employees

were regularized and there inter se seniority will be calculated as per service in cadre and age factor. (Annexure B & C)

- 3. That Para No 3 is related to official record of this office.
- 4. That Para No 4 on facts is related to the service record and regularization of the appellant along with others under regularization Notification 2018.
- of the appellant about his pay protection as per law, rules and policy. Moreover the office order Dated:09-09-2014, which is annexed with the appeal of the appellant is fake and bogus as no dispatch record is available in this office regarding the same letter. (Annexure D)
- 6. That Para No 6 is incorrect and denied as only pay protection was provided to the appellant under the relevant rules while he is not entitled for other benefits as he was appointed as AT BPS-15 through NTS on adhoc and contract basis and he was to be dealt along with other NTS employees under 2017 Act and regularization Notification 2018 as all such employees are sailing in the same boat.
- 7. That Para No 7 is incorrect and denied, the seniority of all Arabic Teachers have been framed under 2017 Act and the appellant has been placed at his lown serial No as per law, rules and policy. (Annexure E).
- 8. That Para No 8 is incorrect and denied, as the seniority of all such employees ware finalized after redressal of grievances, removal of objections and necessary corrections and the appellant was informed time and again that his appeal is time barred and is without any legal justification as he has been placed at his own scrial No in the seniority list under the same law along with others NTS employees.
- 9. That Para No 9 is related to the appellant and his counsel, personal legal approach and justifications.

GROUNDS:

- A. That Para A is incorrect and denied as stated in the preceding paras the appellant has served in the police department in BPS-05 and then applied for the post of AT BPS-15 through NTS in the year 2014, only pay protection was provided while the seniority is to be determined under 2017 Act as this Honorable Services Tribunal decided all such cases in various judgments that the inter se seniority is to be determined on the basis of service in cadre and age factor as per section-4 & 5 of 2017 Act and regularization Notification 2018.
- B. That Para B on ground is incorrect and denied, and Para 8 on facts and Para A on grounds are referred as ready reference.
- C. That Para C on ground is incorrect and denied, as this department always follow law, rules and policy.
- D. That Para D on ground is incorrect and denied, as stated in the preceding paras the seniority has been framed under the existing rules and the appellant has properly placed in the seniority list to which he was entitled and no other remedy/benefit can be provided as no such provision exists in the act 2017.



E. That Para E on ground is related to the appellant and his counsel, but the respondence may be allowed for additional arguments at the time of hearing.

PRAYER:

In view of the above made submissions it is requested that this Honorable Services Tribunal may very graciously be please to dismiss the instant appeal with heavy cost.

THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA EMPLOYEES OF THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION DEPARTMENT (APPOINTMENT AND REGULARIZATION OF SERVICES) ACT, 2017.

(KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA ACT NO. I OF 2018)

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in the Gazette of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, (Extraordinary),dated the 8th January, 2018).

AN ACT

to provide for the appointment and regularization of the services of certain employees appointed on adhoc or contract basis or appointed in certain projects in the Elementary and Secondary Education Department in the Province of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the appointment and regularization of the services of certain employees appointed on adhoc or contract basis or appointed in certain projects in the Elementary and Secondary Education Department in the Province of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, in the public interest:

It is hereby enacted as follows:

- 1. Short title, application and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees of the Elementary and Secondary Education Department (Appointment and Regularization of Services) Act, 2017.
- (2) It shall apply to all the employees in the Elementary and Secondary Education Department, as defined in clause (c) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of this Act.
- (3) It shall come into force at once and it shall be deemed to have taken effect from the date of the initial appointment of the employees as referred to in clause (c) of subclause (1) of section 2 of this Act.
- Definitions.--(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "Commission" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "contract appointment" means appointment of a duly qualified person for a specific period made otherwise than in accordance with the prescribed method of recruitment;
 - (c) "employees" mean duly qualified persons,-

- (i) who are appointed as teachers on adhoc or contract basis by the Government after 2013 through National Testing Service but does not include the teachers engaged on work charge basis or who are paid out of contingencies;
- (ii) who are appointed in the projects on contract basis in accordance with the project policy; and
- (iii) who are appointed as Junior Clerk in the Elementary and Secondary Education Department by Government after 2013 through National Testing Service;
- (d) "Government" means the Government of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
- (c) "law or rule" means the law or rule for the time being in force governing the selection and appointment of civil servants;
- (f) "project" means,-
 - (i) IT/Computer Teachers in Computer Labs Projects in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Phase-II);
 - (ii) establishment of five hundreds (500) IT Labs in Government High and Secondary Schools in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa; and
 - (iii) establishment of five hundreds (500) IT Labs in Government High Schools in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Phase-III); and
- (g) "teacher" means a teacher of primary, middle, secondary or higher secondary school
- (2) The expressions "adhoc appointment" shall have the same meaning as respectively assigned to them in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XVIII of 1973).
- 3. Regularization of services of employees.—(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law or rules, the employees, who hold posts till the commencement of this Act. [or till 30th June 2017, in respect of the project as mentioned in sub-clause (i) of clause (f) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of this Act, as the case may be], shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis from the day of the initial appointment; provided that-
 - they possess the same qualification and experience required for a regular post;

they have not resigned from their services or terminated from services on account of misconduct, inefficiency or any other ground, before the commencement of this Act [:]

²[Provided that expiry of the project as mentioned in sub-clause (i) of clause (f) of sub-section (l) of section 2 of this Act, shall not be deemed a ground for non-appointment of an employee on regular basis under this Act; and]

- (iii) the service promotion quota of all service cadres shall not be affected.
- (2) The services of the employees shall be deemed to have been regularized only on the publication of their names in the official Gazette.
- 4. Determination of seniority.--(1) The employees whose service are regularized under this Act or in the process of attaining service at the commencement of this Act, shall rank junior to all other employees belonging to the same Cadre, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission made before the commencement of this Act, are to be appointed to the Cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment.
- (2) The seniority inter-se of those employees, whose services are regularized under this Act within the Cadre, shall be determined on the basis of their continuous service in Cadre:

Provided that if the date of continuous service in the case of two or more employees is the same, the employee older in age shall rank senior to the younger one.

5. Overriding effect.— Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law or rules for the time being in force, the provisions of this Act shall have an overriding effect and the provisions of any such law or rules to the extent of inconsistency to this Act shall cease to have effect.

THE ¹KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA CIVIL SERVANTS (APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION &TRANSFER) RULES, 1989

PART-I

GENERAL

1. Short title and commencement: - (1) These rules may be called the ²[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.

- (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. **Definitions:-**(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) "Appointing Authority" in relation to a post, means the persons authorized under rule 4 to make appointment to that post;
 - (b) "Basic Pay Scale" means the Basic Pay Scale for the time being sanctioned by Government, in which a post or a group of posts is placed;
 - (c) "Commission" means the ³[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Public Service Commission;
 - ⁴(d) "Departmental Promotion Committee" means a committee constituted for making selection for promotion or transfer to such posts under a Department, or offices of Government, which do not fall within the purview of the Provincial Selection Board;
- ⁵(dd)"Departmental Selection Board" means a Board constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial recruitment /appointment to posts under a Department or office of Government in Basic Pay Scale 17 not falling within the purview of the Commission:

Provided that more than one such committees may be constituted for civil servants holding different scales of pay".

(e) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a committee constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial appointment to posts under a department, or office of Government [in Basic Pay Scale 17 and below not falling within the purview of the Commission];

(f) "Post" means a post sanctioned in connection with the affairs of the Province, but not allocated to all Pakistan Unified Grades; and

- (g) "Provincial Selection Board" means the Board constituted by Government for the purpose of selection of civil servants for promotion or transfer to posts in respect whereof the appointing authority under rule 4 is the Chief Minister and shall consist of such persons as may be appointed to it by Government from time to time.
 - (2) Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them in the ⁷[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Civil Servants Act, 1973 (⁸[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Act XVIII of 1973) or any other statutory order or rules of Government for the time being in force.
- 3. **Method of Appointment:**-(1) Appointment to posts shall be made by any of the following methods, namely:-
 - (a) by promotion or transfer in accordance with the provisions contained in Part-II of these rules; and
 - (b) by initial recruitment in accordance with the provisions contained in Part-III of these rules.
 - (2) The method of appointment, qualifications and other conditions applicable to a post shall be such as laid down by the Department concerned in consultation with the ⁹Establishment and Administration Department and the Finance Department.
- 4. **Appointing Authority:-** The authorities competent to make appointment to posts in various basic pay scales shall be as follows:-

- (b) In case of High Court, the Chief Justice; and
- (c) In the case of Attached Department:
 - (i) the Head of Attached Department concerned; and
 - (ii) In any other case the Secretary of the Department concerned.
 - (a) In the case of civil Servants borne on ministerial establishment of Civil Courts subordinate to High Court, the officer authorized as such by the Chief Justice; and
 - (b) In other cases
 - (i) an officer declared under the relevant Delegation of Powers Rules, which shall to this extent be deemed as operative; or
 - (ii) Where no such appointing authority has been declared, the Secretary to Government or the Head of an Attached Department/ Office, as the case may be.
- 4. posts in Basic pay Scale 1 and 2. Deputy Secretary incharge of Administration or office, , as the care may be
- 5. ¹⁴Departmental Promotion & Selection Committee/Board- (1) In each Department or office of Government there shall be one or more Departmental Promotion Committee and Departmental Selection Committee ¹⁵(or, as the case may be, Departmental Selection Board), the composition of which shall be determined by the Establishment and Administration Department or the Department in consultation with the Establishment and Administration Department.
- (2) Each such Committee (or the Board, as the case may be), shall consist of at least three members, one of whom shall be appointed as Chairman.

Procedure when recommendation is not accepted:- When an appointing authority for Basic Pay Scale 17 or below does not accept the recommendation of a Departmental Promotion or Selection Committee, or the Departmental Selection Board, as the case may be, it shall record its reasons and obtain order of the next higher authority.

PART-II.

APPOINTMENT BY PROMOTION OR TRANSFER

- 7. **Appointment by Promotion or Transfer.** ¹⁷(1) Except as otherwise provided in any service rules for the time being in force, appointment by promotion or transfer to posts in respect whereof the appointing authority under rule 4 is the Chief Minister shall ordinarily be made on the recommendation of the Provincial Selection Board and promotion and transfer to posts other than those falling within the purview of the Provincial Selection Board shall ordinarily be made on the recommendation of appropriate Departmental Promotion Committee".
- (2) Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment on regular basis in the same basic pay scale, in which the posts to be filled, exist.
- (3) Persons possessing such qualifications and fulfilling such conditions as laid down for the purpose of promotion or transfer to a post shall be considered by the Departmental Promotion Committee or the Provincial Selection Board for promotion or transfer, as the case may be.
- (4) No promotion on regular basis shall be made to posts in Basic Pay Scale 18 to 21 unless the officer concerned has completed such minimum length of service as may be specified from time to time.
- ¹⁸(5) If on an order of promotion or before promotion any civil servant declines in writing, to accept promotion, such civil servant shall not be considered for such promotion for the next four years following order.

Provided that if he declines to avail the benefit of promotion for the second time, then he shall stand superseded permanently for such promotion.

8. Inter-Provincial Transfer:-(1) Persons holding appointment in BPS 1 to 15 under Federal Government and other Provincial Government may, in deserving cases, be transferred to equivalent posts under these rules:-

Provided that:-

- (i) the Federal Government or the Government of the Province concerned, as the case may be, has no objection to such a transfer;
- (ii) the person seeking transfer possesses the requisite qualification and experience and the post to which his transfer is intended can, under the rules, be filled by transfer;
- (iii) the person concerned holds appointment to the post in his parent Department on regular basis;

- (iv) the person concerned is a bona fide resident of the ¹⁰[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa].
- (v) a vacancy exists to accommodate the request for such a transfer; and:
- (vi) Provided further that in most deserving cases, the merit of which shall be determined on case to case basis and the decision of the Competent Authority in that behalf shall be final, Government may allow transfer of a civil servant in BPS-16 and above, subject to the aforesaid conditions.
- (2) A person so transferred shall be placed at the bottom of the cadre strength which he joins for the purpose of determining his seniority vis-à-vis other members borne on the cadre.
- (3) It will be the sole discretion of the appointing authority to accept or refuse a request for transfer under this rule and any decision made in this behalf shall be final and shall not be quoted as precedence in any other case.
- 9. Appointment on Acting Charge or current Charge Basis. (1) Where the appointing authority considered it to be in the public interest to fill a post reserved under the rules for departmental promotion and the most senior civil servant belonging to the cadre or service concerned, who is otherwise eligible for promotion, does not possess the specified length of service the authority may appoint him to that post on acting charge basis;

²⁰Provided that no such appointment shall be made, if the prescribed length of service is short by more than ²¹[three years].

- (3) In the case of a post in Basic Pay Scale 17 and above, reserved under the rules to be filled in by initial recruitment, where the appointing authority is satisfied that no suitable officer drawing pay in the basic scale in which the post exists is available in that category to fill the post and it is expedient to fill the post, it may appoint to that post on acting charge basis the most senior officer otherwise eligible for promotion in the organization, cadre or service, as the case may be, in excess of the promotion quota.
- (4) Acting charge appointment shall be made against posts which are likely to fall vacant for period of six months or more. Against vacancies occurring for less than six months, current charge appointment may be made according to the orders issued from time to time.
- (5) Appointment on acting charge basis shall be made on the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee or the Provincial Selection Board, as the case may be.
- (6) Acting charge appointment shall not confer any vested right for regular promotion to the post held on acting charge basis.

PART-III

INITIAL APPOINTMENT

- 10. **Appointment by Initial Recruitment :-**(1) Initial appointment to posts ²³[in various basic pay scales] shall be made-
 - (a) if the post falls within the purview of the Commission, on the basis of Examination or test to be conducted by the Commission; or
 - (b) if the post does not fall within the purview of the Commission, in the manner as may be determined by Government.
- ²⁴(2) Initial recruitment to posts which do not fall within the purview of the Commission shall be made on the recommendation of the Departmental Selection Committee, after vacancies have been advertised in newspapers.

- (i) the percentage of vacancies reserved for recruitment on merit;
- (ii) short term vacancies likely to last for less than one year; and
- (iii) isolated posts in which vacancies occur only occasionally.
- 11. Eligibility. (1) A candidate for appointment shall be a citizen of Pakistan and bona fide resident of the ³⁹[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa].

Provided that for reasons to be recorded in writing, Government may, in a particular case, relax this restriction.

- (3) No person, not already in Government service, shall be appointed to a post unless he produces a certificate of character from the principal, academic officer of the academic institution last attended and also certificates of character from two responsible persons, not being his relatives, who are well acquainted with his character and antecedents.
- (4) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (3), an appointment by initial recruitment shall be subject to the verification of character and intercedents of the candidate or the person appointed, to the satisfaction of appointing authority.

- 12. Zonal and Divisional representation: (1) Except as orbetwise specifically provided in any rule for the time being in force, initial recruitment to posts in Basic Pay Scales 16 and 17 and other posts in Basic Pay Scales 3 to 15 borne on Provincial cadre shall be made in accordance with the Zonal quota specified by Government from time to time:

Ad hoc Appointment:-(1) When the appointing authority considers it to be in the public interest to fill in a post falling within the purview of the formassion urgently, it may, pending nomination of a candidate by the Commission, proceed to fill in such post on ad hoc basis for a period not exceeding ⁴²[one year] by advertising the same in accordance with the procedure laid down for initial appointment in Part-III of these rules:

PROBATION AND CONFIDMINITION

PART-VI

SENIORITY

- 17. **Seniority**:-(1) the seniority inter se of civil servants ⁴⁷(appointed to a service, cadre or post) shall be determined:-
 - (a) in the case of persons appointed by initial recruitment, in accordance with the order of merit assigned by the Commission ⁴⁸[or as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee:] provided that persons selected for appointment to post in an earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection; and
 - (b) in the case of civil servants appointed otherwise, with reference to the date of their continuous regular appointment in the post; provided that civil servants selected for promotion to a higher post in one batch shall, or their provision to the higher post, retain their inter se seniority as in the lower post.

Explanation-1:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post temporarily in the public interest, even though continuing later permanently in the higher post, it would not adversely effect the interest of his seniors in fixation of his seniority in the higher post.

Explanation-II:- If a junior person in a lower post is protein to a higher post by superseding a senior person and subsequently that senior person is also promoted the person promoted first shall rank senior to the person promoted subsequently; provided that junior person shall not be deemed to have superseded a senior person if the case of the ranior person is deferred for the time being for want of certain information or for into anthroproceed or for any other reason not attributing to his fault or demerit.

Explanation-III:- A junior person shall be deemed to have supposed a senior person only if both the junior and the senior persons were considered for the higher so if and the junior person was appointed in preference to the senior person.

- (2) Seniority in various cadres of civil servants are interest to the recruitment vis-à-vis those appointed otherwise shall be determined with rate to to the interest of their regular appointment to a post in that cadre; provided that if two data are the reson appointed otherwise shall rank senior to the person appointed by initial to a street.

- 18. General Rules: In all matters not expressly provided for in these roles, civil servants shall be governed by such rules as have been or may hereafter be prescribed by Government and made applicable to them.
- 19. Repeal:- The ⁵¹[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1975, are hereby repealed.

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
