



- 1. That on 18-07-2014, the department placed 263 posts before the Commission for appointment of Probationer Assistant Sub-Inspectors after advertisement the same. (Copy as annex "A")
- 2. That after going through the prescribed procedure of selection, the Commission recommended numerous incumbents, the name of appellant was figured at S. No. 45 vide order dated 01-02-2017. (Copy as annex "B")

3. That in pursuance of the aforesaid recommendation of the Commission, R. No. 01 issued appointment order on 23-02-2017 by figuring name of appellant at S. No. 09 along with colleagues. (Copy as annex "C")
4. That on satisfactory performances of the official duties, appellant was confirmed on 13-02-2020 after completion of 03 years' probation period and his name was then brought on promotion list "E", and then figured his name at S. No. 03. (Copy as annex "D")
5. That on 11-07-2023, R. No. 01 wrote letter to DPO Bannu / Lakki Marwat to remit the names of eligible ASI's for promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspector. The name of appellant was figured at S. No. 26 along with his colleagues. (Copy as annex "E")
6. That on 14-07-2023, R. No. 01 promoted colleagues to the rank of Officiating Sub Inspectors but the name of appellant was not figured in the list, however, his colleagues names were figured from S. No. 10 to 15, thus made discrimination. (Copy as annex "F")
7. That on 24-04-2024, appellant submitted representation before R. No. 02 for promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspector with his colleagues but in vain. (Copy as annex "G")


Hence this appeal, Inter Alia, on the following grounds:-

### **GROUND S**

1. That strange enough, colleagues of appellant were promoted to the rank of Officiating Sub Inspectors B-14 but the name of appellant was dropped from the same.
2. That process of further promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspector was initiated by the department but appellant was deferred for no legal reason but due to malice.
3. That similarly and equally placed persons be treated alike under the law as well as per the judgments of the apex court but no such treatment was extended to appellant.


4. That no reason of dropping, of the name of appellant was given in the promotion order, thus discriminated.
5. That promotion order dated 14-07-2023 ignoring appellant from promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspectors is not per the mandate of law, rather based on malafide.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the appeal, order dated 14-07-2023 by promoting colleagues to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspectors and by ignoring appellant be reviewed / modified and he be promoted to the said rank with all service benefits from the aforesaid date, with such other relief as may be deemed proper.



### **MODE OF EXAMINATION**

#### **Physical Endurance Test:-**

All the eligible candidates applying for initial recruitment for the post of Assistant Sub-Inspector, shall qualify the following physical endurance tests to be conducted by a team of three members, two from the Public Service Commission and one from Police Department to be nominated by the Provincial Police Officer.

#### **CATEGORIES**

#### **RACE**

Male Candidates: 1600 meters in 8:00 minutes.

Female candidates: 1000 meters in 8:00 minutes.

All categories of candidates shall qualify physical endurance test. Candidates who fail to qualify the physical endurance test shall not be eligible to appear in other tests.

Candidates, both general and in service, who qualify the physical endurance test, shall be eligible to appear in the written examination to be conducted by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission.

### **Psychological Test:-**

Candidates, both general and in Service, who qualify written examination, shall be called by the Public Service Commission for psychological test to be conducted by certified psychologist of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission. The result of this test shall be a guide for the interview panel whether or not candidate is suitable for the police job.

### **Viva Voce Examination:-**

Psychological test shall be followed by viva voce exam to be conducted by the Public Service Commission. The candidate shall appear before the interview panel at the time of viva voce examination. Failure in or absence from viva voce shall mean that the candidate has failed to qualify the examination for the post of Assistant Sub-Inspector.

Candidates who qualify physical endurance test, written examination and viva voce shall undergo medical examination to be conducted by Director Health Services Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Final merit list shall be prepared by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission. If the total marks of any of the two candidates are equal, the candidate with higher marks in viva voce test shall be placed higher on merit and, in case, where the marks obtained in viva voce are also equal, the candidate older in age shall be placed higher on merit list.

Issuance of appointment order shall be subject to background clearance reports from intelligence agencies.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

- i) Age shall be reckoned on 01/01/2015. The candidates are required to be academically qualified in all respects by 22/08/2014. Candidates not in possession of the required qualification by the last date for receipt of application for inland candidates shall not be considered. Maximum age limit as prescribed in the recruitment rules shall be relaxed upto Ten years for Disable persons and Govt. servants who have completed two years continuous service and upto 03 years for candidates belonging to backward areas specified in the appendix attached to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Initial Appointment to Civil Posts (Relaxation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 2008. However, a candidate shall be allowed relaxation in age in one of the above categories provided that the candidates from backward areas, in addition to automatic relaxation of three years shall be entitled to one of the relaxations available to govt. servants, general or disable candidates, whichever is relevant and applicable to them. Employees or Ex-employees of development projects of the govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and employees or Ex-employees of development projects of the federal govt. under the administrative control of the govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa shall also be entitled to age relaxation equal to the period served in the projects, subject to a maximum limit of ten years provided that this age relaxation shall not be available in conjunction with any other provisions of the age relaxation rules.
- ii) Degrees / Experience Certificates / Testimonials of unrecognized institution are not accepted. Only original Degrees / Certificates are accepted, however, the candidates can apply on provisional certificate signed by the Controller of Examination of the respective institution. The candidates shall have to produce original degrees / certificates till last date of interviews. Detail Marks Certificates shall necessarily be required and these should be attached with the application forms.
- iii) The candidates are required to apply on the prescribed application form obtainable from the listed below branches of the **NATIONAL BANK**. Only one application will be sufficient for the above posts, the candidates intending for different categories mentioned above should however indicate the categories/quotas in the application form. The application Fee is Rs.285/- for all candidates. In addition to application fee, the candidates will have to pay Rs.15/- on account of Bank charges. Application form obtained other than the specified branches of the National Bank will be considered invalid and such applications will not be entertained. **The application on plain paper or photostat shall not be accepted. Incomplete applications if not supported by requisite documents or late applications shall also be rejected.**
- iv) Candidates can also apply online through the Commission's website ([www.kppsc.gov.pk](http://www.kppsc.gov.pk)). However the application fee needs to be deposited in State Banks of Pakistan or a National Bank of Pakistan Branch under head of account No. **C02101- Organs of State-Examination Fee of KP PSC** through Challan on or before the closing date. The same alongwith attested copies of all the documents need to be submitted to the Commission within 10 days.
- v) Applications must be submitted within stipulated time as no extra time is allowed for postal transit. Applications if posted on the last date must reach the Commission's office by the closing hours.







**Respectfully sir,**

1. That on 18-07-2014, the department placed 263 posts for appointment of Probationer Assistant Sub-Inspectors in the Commission and the same were then advertised on the aforesaid date.
2. That after going through the prescribed procedure, the Commission recommended numerous incumbents, wherein name of appellant was figured at S. No. 45 vide order dated 01-02-2017.
3. That in pursuance of the aforesaid recommendation of the Commission, RPO Bannu Region Bannu issued appointment order dated 23-02-2017 figuring name of appellant at S. No. 09 along with colleagues.
4. That on satisfactory performances of the official duties, appellant was confirmed on 13-02-2020 after completion of 03 years' probation period by bring his name on promotion list "E" from the date of his confirmation i.e. 13-02-2020 and his name was figured at S. No. 03.
5. That on 11-07-2023, RPO Bannu Region Bannu wrote letter to DPO Bannu as well as Lakki Marwat to remit the names of eligible ASI's for promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspector. The name of appellant was figured at S. No. 26 along with his colleagues.
6. That on 14-07-2023, RPO Bannu Region Bannu promoted candidates to the rank of Officiating Sub Inspectors but the name of appellant was not figured in the list, however, his colleagues names were figured from S. No. 10 to 15, thus made discrimination.



That strange enough, colleagues of appellant were promoted to the rank of Officiating Sub Inspectors B-14 but the name of appellant was dropped from the order of promotion.

8. That process of further promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspector was initiated by the department but appellant was deferred time and again for no legal reason but due to malice.
9. That similarly and equally placed persons be treated alike under the law as well as the judgment of the apex court but no such treatment was extended to appellant.
10. That no reason, of dropping whatsoever, was given in the promotion order of appellant thus discriminated.
11. That the promotion order dated 14-07-2023 ignoring appellant from promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspectors is not per the mandate of law, rather based on malafide.

It is, therefore, most humbly requested that order dated 14-07-2023 by promoting colleagues to the rank of Officiating Sub Inspector be reviewed / modified and appellant be promoted to the said rank with all service benefits from the said date with all service benefits.


