KALIM ARSHAD KHAN CHAIRMAN: Appellant's case in brief, as per the averments of the Appeal, is that she was appointed Lady Health Visitor (BPS-09) vide order dated 10.05.2000 and was promoted to the

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post of P.H.C Technician (BPS-12). While serving in the said capacity,vide impugned order dated 18.05.2021, she was terminated from service.2. Feeling aggrieved of the impugned order dated 18.05.2021, the

appellant filed departmental appeal on 08.06.2021, which was not responded, therefore, she filed the instant service appeal.

3. On receipt of the appeal and its admission to full hearing, the respondents were summoned. Respondents put appearance and contested the appeal by filing written reply raising therein numerous legal and factual objections. The defense setup was a total denial of the claim of the appellant.

 We have heard learned counsel for the appellant and learned District Attorney for respondents.

5. The learned counsel for the appellant reiterated the facts and grounds detailed in the memo and grounds of the appeal while the learned District Attorney controverted the same by supporting the impugned order(s).

6. Perusal of impugned order dated 18.05.2021 shows that the appellant was <u>"terminated"</u> from service on the basis of different allegations i.e. absence from duty, denial of performance of duty as well as non-submission of replies to the official correspondence. Allegations have been mentioned in the impugned order, but there is nothing annexed with the reply of respondents, to show the mentioned correspondence nor is the word <u>"terminated"</u> mentioned anywhere in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011, rather it is mentioned in Section-11 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

CALCELLE TO ST Civil Servants Act, 1973, but that would be relevant if the appellant was on probation, but in this case, the appellant was not on probation.

7. Besides, neither charge sheet/statement of allegations have been issued nor the appellant has been cross-examined which shows that the appellant has not been given proper opportunity of defense which is the requirement of law.

8. Keeping in view the situation, instant service appeal is accepted. The impugned order is set aside with the direction to the respondents to conduct proper inquiry into the matter strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011 and then pass appropriate but speaking order. Appellant is reinstated for the purpose of inquiry. The issue of back benefits shall be subject to the outcome of inquiry, which to be conducted within <u>60</u> days of the receipt of this judgment. Costs shall follow the event. Consign.



On acceptance of the instant appeal, the Impugned office order No. 2054-60/DHO/LK/CK/ADMIN/TER dated 18/05/2021 passed by District Health Officer (DHO) District Kurram, may kindly be set aside being illegal, void ab-initio and unlawful, and the appellant may kindly be re-instated into service with all back benefits. And any other relief and remedy deems justified by this Hon'ble Tribunal may also be passed in favour of the appellant for the interest of justice and fair play.

The appellant humbly submits as under: -

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That the appellant belongs to an educated, social and well to do family having a modest status in the society.

- 2. That the appellant was appointed as MCH (LHV).
- 3. That the appellant has put more than 20 years unblemished service on her credit and the appellant since her appointment performed her duties with great, zeal, zest, Enthusiasm and to the entire satisfaction of her superiors.



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That the appellant never resorted to make herself absent from duty and performed duty whole heartedly even during racial crisis as well as Moharam UI Haram, also performed duty during Eidain, even in the era of Taliban when law and order situation in the area were quite fragile and service record of the appellant to this effect is self explanatory.

5. - K. That the appellant has been condemned unheard as no opportunity of personal hearing or defense has been provided to the appellant by the inquiry Officer or the competent authority which is fundamental right of the appellant.
- L. That neither statement of any witness has been recorded nor did the appellant was confronted with anything.
- M. That the appellant has not been confronted with any documentary or oral evidence and the appellant was treated inhumanly or intra to do to
- N. That no any show cause notice has been issued /Served as mentioned in the impugned 'order and the allegation leveled against the appellant are self made and having no sound footings.



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With due regard the subject appeal is submitted on the following grounds:

That the appellant belongs to an educated, social and well to do family having a term of the society.

That the appellant has put more than 20 years unblemished service on her credit and the appellant since her appointment performed her duties with great, zeal, zest, Enthusiasm and to the entire satisfaction of her superiors.¹

That the appellant never resorted to make herself absent from duty and performed duty whole heartedly, during racial crisis as well as Moharam UI Haram, also performed duty during Eidain, even in the era of Taliban when law and order situation in the area were quite fragile and service record of the appellant to this effect is self explanatory.

That while posted as PHC Technician MNCH (LHW) BS-12 DHQ SADA[®] District Lower and Central Kurram whereby the appellant was surprised to receive the impugned termination order dated 18/05/2021 which was issued by an incompetent authority, without adopting proper procedure under Khyber Pakhatunkhwa Efficiency & Disciplinary Rules 2011, hence the impugned order dated 18/05/2021 is void abi initio, Coram non judice, not sustainable in the eyes of law. It is worth mentioning that the same has not communicated to me by the department however the appellant on her own got copy of the same (copy of the mgugned order dated 18/05/2021 is annexure A):

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That feeling aggrieved from the impugned order dated 18/05/2021 the appellant having no other remedy hence filling the instant appeal on the following grounds;

GROUNDS:

That the punishment of termination awarded to the appellant is no where mentioned in Khyber Pakhatunkhwa Efficiency & Disciplinary Rules 2011 which is sufficient to prove that the appellant has been treated under the law of jungle mala fidely.

That the penalty is imposed without due process of laws and rule in vogue. That the removal order is technically not correct.

That no charge sheet has been issued which is mandatory under the Khyber Pakhatunkhwa Efficiency & Disciplinary Rules 2014 which is sufficient to termed the whole proceedings null and void.

That no regular inquiry has been conducted as mentioned in the impugned order nor did the appellant was provided any opportunity to defend herself.

That no charge sheet statement of allegation issued/served on the appellant which is mandatory under E & D Rules 2011.

That the appellant was condemned unheard as no opportunity of personal hearing or defense has been provided to the appellant by the inquiry Officer or the competent authority which is fundamental right of the appellant.

That neither statement of any witness has been recorded nor did the appellant was confronted with anything.

That the appellant has not been confronted with any documentary or oral evidence and the appellant was treated under the law of jungle. That no show cause has been issued /Served as mentioned in the impugned, order and all of a That the allegation leveled against the appellant are self made and having no sound footings. The appellant has requested for provision of the records/ charges leveled against the appellant, however the office of DHO has denied providing the same and due to this reason the appellant has been constrained to approach Right to Information Commission for redressal of her grievance/ procurement of record to reply her stance in this regard.

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That no inquiry has been conducted against the appellant and no charge sheet, statement of allegations, notice on given address or through press / publication has been issued and served upon the appellant in service. That the appellant has not been provided opportunity of defending herself while

taking this harsh unilateral action.

That the appellant has been subjected to discrimination as the appellant has been guaranteed equal protection of law and entitled for due course of law however the same has been refused to the appellant thus Article 25 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 has been violated

That since the illegal impugned order the appellant fundamental rights of the enshrined in the constitution of Pakistan 1973 have been put at stake, hence the instant appeal.

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


