- O1. Petitioner alongwith counsel present. Mr. Asif Masood Ali Shah, DDA alongwith Yousaf Jamal, Assistant for the respondents present.
- O2. Vide judgment dated 07.12.2023 of this Tribunal, it was held that the concerned authorities should ensure posting of proper person in grade- 20 against the post of Medical Superintendent. However, for the petitioner, it was stated by this Tribunal that being at the verge of retirement, he might be posted in the district of his domicile. The respondent department regularized the period from 01.01.2024 to 17.05.2024 vide Notification dated 25.07.2024 after which the petitioner stood retired on 18.05.2024.
 - O3. Counsel for the petitioner stated that the respondents were not processing the pension case of the petitioner, upon which the departmental representative stated that before the petitioner was directed to report to the Director General office, he was posted at Charsadda and the required LPC from Charsadda had not been provided by him to the D.G office. Counsel for the petitioner requested for time to provide the required documents to the D.G office for processing the pension case of the petitioner. The petitioner had already retired from service and nothing was left to be implemented as far as the judgment of the Tribunal is concerned, therefore salary of respondent No. 3 attached on 14.06.2024 is released.

Accountant General office be informed accordingly. Learned counsel for the petitioner insisted to keep the case open till such time that the petitioner was given pensionary benefits. To come up for further proceedings on 09.09.2024 before the S.B. PP given to the parties.
