1. Learned counsel for the petitioner present. Mr. Umair Azam, Additional Advocate General alongwith Mr. Roqia Bahar, ADEO for official respondents present. Learned counsel for private respondent No. 4 present.

2. Learned counsel for private respondent submitted that the private respondent No. 4 had already filed 12 (2) CPC Petition No. 730/2024 in service appeal No. 896/2022. In this respect he produced a copy of order dated 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 wherein the judgment passed in service appeal No. 896/2022 was suspended by the Divisional Bench of this Tribunal.
