

1. Petitioner alongwith his counsel present. Mr. Umair Azam, Additional Advocate General alongwith Mr. Muhammad Kamran, PST for the respondents present.

2. Representative of the respondents submitted that they only requirement for further process of the case of the petitioner is the LPC from DHQ Teaching Hospital D.I.Khan where he was last serving. The respondent department has made correspondence with the Hospital Director DHQ Teaching Hospital D.I.Khan from time to time. He also produced a latest letter dated 24.11.2024 asking Hospital Director DHQ Teaching Hospital D.I. Khan to provide Last Pay Certificate (LPC). Copy of this letter handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner who is directed to inform the petitioner to visit the DHQ Teaching Hospital D.I. Khan for procurement of the LPC. It appears from the order sheets that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing his case as he had never appeared in the Tribunal last four dates of hearing. Since the judgment of the Tribunal has been complied by converting of major penalty of removal from service into compulsory retirement vide Notification dated 11th March, 2016, therefore, the instant execution petition is filed. However the petitioner would be at liberty to come to the Tribunal within 60 days if he find any hurdle for procurement of the LPC. Consign.
