

Service Appeal U/S 4 Of The KPK Service Tribunal Act 1974

Prayer in Appeal: -

On Acceptance of the Instant Service Appeal the impugned action of changing the position of appellant from Serial No-9 to Serial No.32 in the Newly Prepared Seniority list of Drawing Master BPS (15) Male District Dir (Upper), may very graciously be set aside and the Respondents Concerned Be Directed to Place the appellant at Serial No.9 instead of Serial No. 32 in the newly Prepared Seniority List of Drawing Master BPS (15) Male District Dir (Upper).

Respectfully sheweth,

1. That the appellant was appointed as Drawing Master in PBS-9 along with others vide order dated 16-12-2013 in the light of the judgment declared on 22/10/2013 by the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar. Review Petition No. 7-M/2012 in W.P No. 3362-P/2010 and Review Petition No. 8/M/2012 in W.P No. 4378/2010. The allowances will be effective from 03/02/2009 (without any financial benefits) up to 28/6/2012 according to the court decision dated 28/6/2012. In the best interest of justice, and their seniority will be considered w.e.f. 03/02/2009. (Copy of the appointment order is attached as Annex-A)
2. That thereafter, his name was placed at Serial No. 15 in the Previous seniority list wherein appellant was awarded seniority from 03/02/2009, while respondent No.3 was placed at Serial No.16 in the Previous Seniority list of Drawing Master BPS (15) Male District Dir (Upper). (Copy of the previous Seniority list is attached as Annexure "B")
3. That all of sudden, respondents who were appointed on the same date with the appellant but were at lower positions in the seniority list filed complaint against the appellant, wherein the appellant's seniority was challenged.
4. That the authority neither provided a copy of the complaint to the appellant nor gave him a chance of hearing and allowed the complaint and placed the appellant at S. No. 32 in the newly prepared seniority list, while respondent No.3 placed at Serial No.16 in the Previous Seniority list was placed at Serial No.9 in the Newly Prepared Seniority list of Drawing Master BPS (15) Male District Dir (Upper). (Copy of the new Seniority list is attached as Annexure "C")

5. That being aggrieved of the same, the appellant preferred a representation before the authority concerned on 20/08/2024, which was dismissed vide impugned order dated 21/08/2024. (Copies of the representation & impugned order dated 21/08/2024 are attached as Annexure "D" & "E" respectively).
6. That the appellant submits, proposes the instant service appeal inter alia on the following amongst others, -

GROUND:

- A. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law nor equal protection of law has been given to him.
- B. That the appellant and two private respondents concerned have the same academic qualifications for the post who were appointed on the directions of the Honorable Peshawar High Court, and the appellant was placed in the seniority list in a better position because he was senior in age. (Copies of the Judgments are attached as Annexure "F", "G" & "H")
- C. That if any benefit is/was given to the respondents concerned, the appellant is/was also entitled for the same in the light of the judgment of the apex court reported as 2009 SCMR page 1, i.e.

"If a Tribunal or Supreme Court of Pakistan Decides a Point of law relating to the terms and conditions of a civil Servant who litigated, and there were other civil servants, who may not have taken any legal proceedings, in such a case, the dictates of justice and rule of good governance demand that the benefit of the said decision be extended to other civil servants also, who may, not be parties to the litigation, instead of compelling them to approach the tribunal or any other legal forum- all citizens are equal before law and entitled to equal protection of law as per Art. 25 of the Constitution". (Copy of the Judgment is attached as Annexure "I")

- D. That mandatory provisions of law have been ignored in changing position of the appellant in seniority list. Thus, the action of the official respondents is not sustainable in the eyes of law thus liable to be set aside.
- E. That while doing changing the position of the appellant in seniority list of Drawing Master BPS (15) Male District Dir (Upper), no show cause, neither any notice was issued in the name of the appellant nor served upon him. No chance of defending his position was given to him. Even on the request of the appellant, a copy of the complaint was not provided to him.



F. That any other ground can also be taken during the argument with permission of this Hon`ble Tribunal.

Any other relief which has not been specifically asked for and deem fit in the circumstances of the case may also be granted to the appellant.

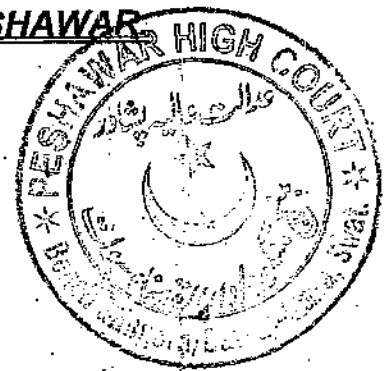

KHALID MAHMOOD, J.- This judgment shall dispose of writ petitions No.2093, 1896 of 2007, 294 of 2008, 3402 of 2009, 3620 & 4378 of 2010, 2288 & 159 of 2011, as same question of law is involved in all these petitions.

2. The brief facts of the case are that in response to advertisement for different posts of teachers in the Education Department, petitioners applied for the same. After conducting the test and interview for the said posts, the petitioners were ignored in the matter of appointment and the appointment orders dated 22.8.2007 etc, issued by the respondents department are illegal, without lawful authority and of no legal effect. According to petitioners, they were not invited for interview, rather vide impugned order dated 22.8.2007, appointment of respondents No.5 to 13 was made.

Petitioners have prayed for directing the respondents concerned to appoint the petitioners being trained and qualified for the said posts.

3. On 23.02.2012, during course of hearing, this Court come to the conclusion that all the certificates produced by the petitioners with regard to their professional qualification should be examined by Secretary Education, the Province of Sindh as to whether the same are genuine and have been issued by the concerned Institution and also to verify that the certificates produced by the petitioners are equivalent to Drawing Master. The petitioners were also directed to submit their original certificates with the Additional Registrar of this Court within a week time for sending for the above-said purpose. Prior to that comments and rejoinder were filed by the parties concerned.

4. Counsel for petitioners argued that impugned order issued by respondent No.1/ department is against law, without jurisdiction and of no legal effect; that the petitioners were trained drawing masters; that respondent concerned had totally ignored the petitioners while making the impugned order of appointment in spite of the fact that they were placed at high pedestal of merit and qualified for the appointment.

On the other hand, it was argued on behalf of respondents that all the appointments were made in accordance with law and policy of the Government governing the subject.

5. With the valuable assistance of the counsel for the parties, the record perused.

6. The main grievances of all the petitioners in the present case that all the petitioners had submitted their requisite qualification along with certificate of Drawing Master before the respondent for their appointment. After test and interview, the merit list was prepared by the respondent concerned wherein the petitioners were declared higher in merit but later on instead of appointment of petitioners, the other candidates were appointed on the ground that the Drawing Master certificate obtained by the petitioners from Institutions situated in Jamshoru and Karachi are not equivalent to the certificate which was prerequisite for the post of Drawing Master. Counsel for the petitioners referred to the recruitment policy. He also referred to the advertisement published on 11.02.2007 in which the required qualification was F.A/F.Sc. with certificate of Drawing Master from any recognized institution. According to the recruitment policy as well as said publication petitioners on the patch-

wise criteria had passed their examined on 31.5.1997. In the first merit list displayed by the respondents, the petitioners had qualified and stood first in the merit list. The respondents on the pretext that the certificate of Drawing Master is not obtained from the recognized institution, who were ignored in the said appointment and the case of the petitioners remained pending after verification of the Drawing Master certificate. Thereafter, the concerned institution wherefrom the petitioners had obtained the D.M. certificate were asked for the verification of the said certificate. This Court too, had directed the concerned institution for the verification of the certificate.

7. In the similar nature case wherein the D.M. certificate was obtained from Jamshoru verified in a case by Abbottabad Bench of this Court, in WP No. 66 of 2009 titled "Muhammad Banaris vs. Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa" wherein it is held that the D.M. certificate by Jamshoru is competent and the recognized one.

8. In the present case, the D.M. certificate qualify from all corners as a genuine certificate issued by the recognized institution, which was the requirement of the recruitment policy as mentioned above. We have gone through the merit list which clearly indicates that the

petitioners have been deprived on lame excuse on the ground of delaying tactics regarding the verification of D.M. certificate obtained by the petitioners. It was also pointed out that respondent in subsequent appointment had also appointed other candidates who had obtained DM certificates from the same Institutions whereas, petitioners has been deprived though they have also qualified from the same Institutions, hence act of respondents is discriminatory and is utter violation of Article 25 of the Constitution. Instead of petitioners who were at better pedestal in the merit list, the other candidates who were below at the merit list as compared to the petitioners have been appointed which apparently shows the mala fide on the part of respondents. After thrashing the entire record, we have come to the conclusion that petitioners have wrongly been deprived for appointment against the post of D.M. which requires interference by this Court.

In the light above discussions, facts and circumstances of the case, all the writ petitions are allowed and respondents are directed to appoint the petitioners against the said post positively.

ABDUL HAMEED DOGAR, C.J.---Through this order we intend to dispose of above captioned petitions filed against common judgment, dated 29-1-2008 passed by learned Judge in Chambers

of Lahore High Court, Lahore whereby Cr.O.P. No.370/W and 561/W of 2007, Writ Petitions Nos.11525, 11263, 11516, 11662, 11663, 11766, 11881, 11835, 12136 and 12185 of 2007, 86, 123, 274, 345, 599, 643 and 11619 of 2008 filed by respondents were allowed and the impugned orders passed by petitioner/authority were set aside.

2. Briefly, stated facts giving rise to the filing of instant petitions are that respondents were appointed as PTC Teachers during the year 1995/1996 after completion of all legal requirements and they joined their respective place of posting. After sometime, their appointments were cancelled being bogus vide order No.277/E-1, dated 3-4-1998. This order was assailed before learned Lahore High Court, Lahore and same was declared to be without lawful authority in the case reported as Mst. Muqqadas Akhtar and another v. Province of Punjab through Secretary Education Department, Government of Punjab and another 2000 PLC (C.S.) 867. The relevant paragraph is reproduced as under:--

"Consequently the petitioners are declared to be in service and the action of the Headmasters/Incharge of the Schools stopping the petitioners from performance of their duties as PTC Teachers on the basis of the above said impugned order, is declared to be without lawful authority. It is, however, clarified that the department is at liberty to proceed against petitioners, if so desired, on individual basis under the relevant law and under the Punjab Civil Servant (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 1975."

In view of above judgment, the respondents were absolved of the charges of bogus appointments. But later on once again the services of respondents were terminated vide order, dated 3-8-2005, which order was challenged before learned Lahore High Court, Lahore through Writ Petition No.16864 of 2005. The said writ petition was allowed vide judgment, dated 11-12-2006 and the impugned order, was declared as illegal and without lawful authority. Similarly, one of the teachers namely Mst. Naseem Akhtar assailed the order, dated 3-8-2005 before Punjab Service Tribunal, Lahore through Appeal No.903 of 2006 which was also allowed vide judgment, dated 4-9-2006. The said judgment was maintained by this Court in Civil Petition No.1960-L of 2006 vide judgment, dated 2-11-2006. On 26-9-2007 once again the services of respondents were terminated. Feeling aggrieved they filed above mentioned petitions before the learned Lahore High Court, Lahore which were allowed vide impugned judgment as stated above.

3. It is mainly contended by learned A.A.-G. Punjab appearing on behalf of petitioners that the jurisdiction of the learned High Court is barred under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 in matters involving determination of terms and conditions of civil servants. She further contended that the appointments of the respondents were bogus and fake as they were never selected by the competent authority, therefore the orders of dismissal passed by departmental authority were in accordance with law, which did not call for any interference by this Court.

4. On the other hand, Mr. S. M. Tayyub, learned Senior Advocate Supreme Court appearing on behalf of some of the respondents supported the impugned judgment and contended that appointments of respondents had taken place in accordance with rules and prescribed procedure. They submitted their applications in pursuance of advertisement of the posts of PTC Teachers. They passed the required test and were appointed by the competent authority. According to him, the respondents were in service for about 9-10 years and during this period no objection was raised, and subsequently on vague allegations they were dismissed from service. He further contended that cases of respondents were at par with Mst. Naseem Akhtar which was decided by this Court in Civil Petition No. 1960-L of 2006 vide judgment, dated 2-11-2006.

5. We have considered the arguments of both the parties and have gone through the record and

ceedings of the case in minute particulars. The matter has already been decided by this Court in the case of Mst. Naseem Akhtar (supra), and it has been held that the appointment orders of the respondents as PTC Teachers were genuine. It was held by this Court in the case of Hameed Akhtar Niazi v. The Secretary, Establishment Division, Government of Pakistan and others 1996 SCMR 1185 that if a Tribunal or this Court decides a point of law relating to the terms and conditions of a civil servant who litigated, and there were other civil servants, who may not have taken any legal proceedings, in such a case, the dictates of justice and rule of good governance demand that the benefit of the said decision be extended to other civil servants also, who may not be parties to that litigation instead of compelling them to approach the Tribunal or any other legal forum. This view was reiterated by this Court in the case of Tara Chand and others v. Karachi Water and Sewerage Board, Karachi and others 2005 SCMR 499 and it was held that according to Article 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 all citizens are equal before law and entitled to equal protection of law.

6. In this view of the matter, we are of the view that no ground for interference in the impugned judgment is made out. Accordingly, the petitions being devoid of force are dismissed and leave to appeal refused.
