

ORDER

Qazi Faez Isa, CJ. The learned Additional Advocate-General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa ('AAG') states that pursuant to the order of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar ('the Tribunal') the respondent was promoted. However, the order of the Tribunal had concluded by stating that, '*the instant appeal is accepted as prayed for*', therefore, we read the prayer in the appeal preferred by the respondent before the Tribunal which simply stated that he wanted to be considered for promotion. The learned AAG has placed on record a notification showing that the respondent was promoted on 24 August 2022 on the recommendation of the Provincial Selection Board in its meeting held on 6 July 2022. The Tribunal did not direct that the respondent be promoted. There is no reason for us to review our order dated 13 March 2024, review whereof is sought through the instant review petition, therefore, it is dismissed.
