Learned counsel for the appellant requested for sine die adjournment of the appeal on the ground that similar nature matter was decided by this Tribunal in Service appeal No. 1266/2018 filed by Afzal Shah and others, against which CPLA was filed by the respondent department and accepted. Against which review petition was filed which is pending adjudication and subjudice before the august Supreme Court of Pakistan, therefore, he requested that to avoid conflicting orders, appeal in hand be adjourned sine die till the final decision of review petition. Request of the learned counsel seems genuine, therefore, the appeal in hand is hereby adjourned sine die. Either party may apply for revival of the appeal after decision of the review petition.
