1. Learned counsel for the applicant present. Mr. Umair Azam, Additional Advocate General for the respondents present. Arguments on restoration application heard and record perused.

2. The Service Appeal bearing No. 56/2024 was dismissed in default vide order dated 02.09.2024. The appellant submitted application for attested copy on 16.09.2024 which was delivered to him on the same day, hence preferred the instant restoration application on 25.09.2024. The application is well within time and learned Additional Advocate General has got no objection on restoration of appeal. The application for restoration of service appeal is supported by duly sworn affidavit. Law also favours adjudication on merit by avoiding technicalities.

3. The restoration application in hand is, therefore, accepted and the appeal is restored to its original number. To come up for preliminary hearing on 04.11.2024 before the S.B P.P given to the parties.
