Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Asif Masood Ali Shah, Deputy District Attorney for the respondents present.

Learned counsel for the appellant contended that the appellant was appointed as a Primary School Teacher (PST) on May 19, 2020, however her appointment order was illegally withdrawn on 23/04/2022. He further argued that her batch mates, who have been appointed alongwith the appellant on same date, have been regularized, thus conferring upon her the status of a civil servant and entitling her to the same relief.

Conversely, the learned Deputy District Attorney for the respondents stated that the appellant's appointment was on an adhoc/contractual basis and her appointment order has been withdrawn, rendering her outside the purview of a civil servant, therefore, this Tribunal lacks jurisdiction over the matter.

In order to ascertain the matter, we would like first to determine that whether the Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear this appeal and whether the appellant, qualifies as a civil servant under the pertinent legal framework. The respondents are directed to produce comprehensive records concerning appointment, extension and the regularization of the appellant's batch mates. Learned counsel for the appellant is also directed to assist the court by providing relevant law/legal precedents regarding the jurisdiction of the Tribunal over the matter in hand.
