Appellant alongwith his counsel present. Mr. Muhammad Farooq, Naib Reader alongwith Mr. Asif Masood Ali Shah, Deputy District Attorney for the respondents present.

Learned counsel for the appellant asserts that the reversion of the appellant from the rank of S.I to C-II/HC is illegal as the appellant was not promoted out of turn, but rather on his own merit and turn.

Confronted with the claims of the appellant, the learned Deputy District Attorney has contended that the appellant's reversion was based on an order from the Supreme Court of Pakistan, which addresses out of turn promotions. It is claimed that the appellant's initial promotion was indeed out of turn, necessitating his reversion. Learned counsel for the appellant has presented a copy of the judgment of this Tribunal dated 29.11.2005 passed in Service Appeal No. 941/2003, which is handed over to the learned Deputy District Attorney for review. Respondents are directed to produce the complete record, including the seniority list and any relevant documents pertinent to the appellant's promotion and subsequent reversion. Adjourned. To come up for record of seniority of the appellant and arguments on 22/11/2024_before the D.B. Parcha Peshi given to the parties.
