## Comments on behalf of respondent No. 01 to 05

#### Preliminary Objection.

- 1. That the appellant has got no cause of action to file instant appeal.
- 2. That the appellant is stopped by his own conduct to file instant appeal
- 3. That the appellant has not come to the court with clean hands.
- 4. That the appellant is misconceived and based on malafide.
- 5. That with the utmost respect this Honorable Service Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to adjudicates upon the subject matter.
- 6. That the appeal is barred by law.
- 7. That the relief as claimed by the appellant has no sanctity in the eye of law.

- The appellant was appointed as Forest Guard BPS-02 in Malakand Social Forestry Project vide office order No.33 dated 8/10/1992 and reported arrival for duty on 31-10-1992 (Annexure-I&II), specifically for the project period.
- 4. Incorrect. Services of the appellant were terminated on winding- up of the said project vide letter No.459/PSF dated 28/1/1998 with effect from 31/1/1998 (Annexure-III) as per terms and conditions of his appointment order.
- 5. Correct to the extent that in light of decision of the Service Tribunal dated 9/12/2010, the appellant was adjusted against the vacant post of Forest Guard in Working Plan Unit-III Peshawar office order No.3 dated 24/2/2011 and his intervening period from the date of his termination till his arrival for duty was hereby treated as extra ordinary leave without pay on the basis of no work no pay policy. (Annexure-IV).
- 6. Pertains to record hence needs no comments.

- 7. Correct to the extent that the appellant was transferred from Demarcation Forest Division to Malakand Forest Division vide CF Malakand East Circle office order No. 68 dated 21/2/2018 and reported his arrival for duty on 6/3/2018 in Malakand Forest Division. (Annexure-V).
- 8. Pertains to record hence needs no comments.
- 9. Incorrect. As already explained in Para-5, in light of Service Tribunal judgment dated 9/12/2010 the appellant was re-adjusted in service and further transferred from Demarcation Forest Division to Malakand Forest Division on 21/2/2018 (Annexure-V). The appellant was placed at Serial No.10 of the tentative seniority list stood on 01/07/2022. However, from scrutiny of the record he was placed at the Serial No. 16 i.e. on his proper place in the final seniority list dated 07.12.2022 on merit basis as per relevant law and rules. (Annexure-VI). It is pointed out that the post of Forest Guard is Forest Division cadre and their seniority is maintained on Forest Division basis. There is no provision in the service rules for transfer of Forest Guard from one Forest Division to another Forest Division. However, on transfer his seniority will be maintained according to rules 8(2) of the Appointment, Promotion and Transfer Rules 1989, which stipulates that a person so transferred shall be placed at the bottom of the cadre strength, which he join for the purpose of determining his seniority vis-à-vis other member borne in the cadre (Annexure-VII).

11. As per preceding Paras, the action of the respondents is in line with the relevant laws and rules, therefore, the appeal being baseless and without any ground and is not maintainable and may kindly be dismissed, on the following grounds.

#### **GROUNDS:**



(3) Persons passessing such qualifications and fulfilling such conditions as from vill lay down for the purpose of promotion or transfer to a post shall be considered P-14 by The Departmental Promotion Committee or the Provincial Selection Board for  $0^{-15}$ promotion or transfer, as the case may be.

- (4) No promotion on regular basis shall be made to posts in Basic Pay Scale 18 to 21 unless the officer concerned has completed such minimum length of service. as may be specified from time to time.
- \*(5) If an an order of promotion or before promotion any civil servant declines in writing, to accept promotion, such civil servant shall not be considered for such promotion for the next (04) years following the order:

Provided that if he declines to avail the benefit of promotion for the second time, then he shall stand superseded permanently for such promotion, \*Subrule (5) of Rule 7 added by Notification No. SOR-VI (E&AD)1-2/2009/Vol-VIII Dated 22-10-2011

Inter-Provincial Transfer: -(1) Persons holding appointment in BPS 1 to 15 under Federal Government and other Provincial Government may, in deserving cases, be transferred to equivalent posts under these rules:-

Provided that:-

- the Federal Government or the Government of the Province concerned, us the case may be, has no objection to such a transfer, tir
  - the person seeking transfer possesses the requisite qualification and experience and the post to which his transfer is intended can, under the (ii) · rules, be tilled by transfer;
    - the person concerned holds appointment to the post in his parent (iii) Department on regular basis;
    - the person concerned is bonafide resident of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. (iv)
    - a vacancy exists to accommodate the request of such a transfer; and (v)
    - provided further that in most deserving cases, the merit of which shall be determined on case to case basis and the decision of the Competent (vi) Authority in that behalf shall be final, Government may allow transfer of a civil servant in BPS-16 and above, subject to the aforesaid conditions.
- A person so transferred shall be placed at the bottom of the cadre strength, which he joins for the purpose of determining his seniority vis-a-viz other members borne on the cudre,

It will be the sole discretion of the appointing authority to accept or refuse a request of transfer under this rule and any decision made in this behalf shall be Oil Cine final and shall not be quoted as precedence in any other ease.
